ARE WE HOME YET?: After dropping two straight, the FredNats need a Sunday win to secure a series split in the finale of the first 12-game road trip of the year. Today, RHP Travis Sthele will try to end the road trip strong with a bounce back start against the Pelicans after he struggled last Sunday in Charleston. He faces Myrtle Beach righty Alfredo Romero, who has struggled on the mound this year for the Chicago Cub-affiliated Pelicans. The FredNats continue to lead the league in runs scored (216) and run differential (+52), and are still within a half game of first place in the North Division heading into play today. Fredericksburg will try to salvage a split today, which is the first time in four series FXBG hasn't won the series outright. Myrtle Beach has split three straight series heading into today's finale.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Pelicans got to Marc Davis early, scoring four runs in the second inning and never looking back on the way to an 8-4 victory over Fredericksburg on Saturday night at the beach. The Freddies officially only made one error, but several defensive mistakes behind the pitching staff extended innings and allowed the Pelicans to add on runs to keep it comfortable throughout the game. FXBG punched back with three runs in the 5th inning with the big swing being a two-run homer by Gavin Dugas, but MB's Ty Johnson got the final 12 outs in a row for a save to close out the FredNats.

**BULLPEN WORK**: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. After allowing just five runs in 20 IP this series, the bullpen has pitched 194 innings this year and allowed just 48 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.23. The Freddies are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit has also danced out of trouble time and time again on this road trip. Last night's win over MB was the first drama-free win on this road trip. In all five wins this trip prior to yesterday, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (18-0), and 8 (20-0) innings.

**HE'S NASTY:** Jeremy De La Rosa has dominated on this road trip while rehabbing a shoulder injury suffered in Spring Training. In 10 games on this rehab assignment, De La Rosa is 11-for-35 (.314) with five doubles, two triples and a home run for an OPS of .990. Defensively in this series alone, he's also robbed two home runs in left field. Both clips were featued on the main MiLB social media accounts.

NICE TO HAVE HIM BACK: Gavin Dugas has returned from his brief absence after a minor hamstring injury in a big way. In two games back for Fredericksburg, Dugas has driven in four runs, and last night hit his third home run of the year, a no-doubter to left field. Dugas has driven in a run in his last four games he's played, and he's slashing .363/.452/.575 for an OPS of 1.027 in 21 games this season.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 17-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 out of the last 15 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday, and Tuesday night against Myrtle Beach was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

**FORMULA CONTINUED**: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 24 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .247 with RISP, compared to .123 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs, and then followed it up with an 10-for-40 (.250) performance in the first five games of this series with the Pelicans.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 165-133 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TODAY'S START:** Travis Sthele makes his seventh start of the year this afternoon, against the Charleston RiverDogs. A 12th round pick by the Nats in 2023, Sthele joined the FredNat rotation late in the 2023 campaign.

A YEAR AGO: Sthele took his lumps after joining Fredericksburg last season. He posted a 7.36 ERA over four starts, to go along with a 1.82 WHIP. Travis struck out six hitters over 11.0 IP but showcased strong command, walking just three men.

**HOOK** 'EM: Travis spent two years at the University of Texas, working mainly as a relief pitcher. 23 of his 36 appearances came out of the Longhorns bullpen, where he worked to a 5.85 ERA across 95.1 innings of work. Sthele 98 batters in that span, while opponents hit just .265 against the righty.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sthele battled some command issues last start, agains the Charleston RiverDogs. He walked three men in 3.2 innings and allowed six base hits, but limited the damage to three earned runs.
