DRILLERS SCORE SIX IN EIGHTH, TAKE SERIES FROM FRISCO: The Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series finale to the Tulsa Drillers 8-7 on Sunday night from Riders Field. Frisco starter **Trey** Supak earned his third quality start, allowing just two runs across six innings, matching a season-high with eight runs. Tulsa (4-2, 30-45) struck first in the top of the fourth when Taylor Young drilled a two-run double to pull the Drillers ahead 3-2. Frisco (2-4, 40-34) then answered in the bottom of the second when **Marcus Smith** crushed a three-run home run to take a 3-2 lead. In the bottom of the seventh, Josh Hatcher lined a two-run single, **Frainyer Chavez** smashed an RBI single and **Jax Biggers** stung an RBI fielder's choice to give Frisco a 7-2 lead. Tulsa then batted around and tallied six runs in the top of the eighth. Griffin Lockwood-Powell ripped a two-run double, Young drew an RBI walk, Kole Myers clipped an RBI single and John Rhodes laced a go-ahead single to regain an 8-7 lead. In the bottom of the ninth, Drillers reliever Antonio Knowles (3-1) retired the Riders in order to secure the victory, ending with 2.2 hitless frames. Frisco reliever **Gavin Collyer** (4-4) took the loss, striking out three while allowing one run over 1.2 innings.

<u>NEW FACES</u>: OF Keith Jones II joins the RoughRiders from High-A Hub City while 1B Jake Burger is slated to start his rehab assignment tonight. RHP Skylar Hales and OF Aaron Zavala have been promoted to Triple-A Round Rock.

JUNE GLOOM: The RoughRiders struggled in the month of June, going 10-15 overall. Their 3.4 runs per game in the month marked their single worst month in runs per game since June of 2019, when they scored just 3.1 runs per game (and went 6-18). Their 10-15 record was their worst month since they went 9-16 in May of 2023. On the positive side, the Riders owned a 3.96 ERA in June, which was sixth in the Texas League. Frisco played 10 one-run games in the month, going just 3-7 in those games.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS: After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league, com-mitting just 32 errors in their last 51 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 49 double plays turned since May 1st also paces the league. Their 48 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

NO SWING AND A MIESES: Riders outfielder Luis Mieses has showed off the power this year. He is on pace to set a career-best in home runs as he has 11 so far. His career-best is 15 (in both 2022 and 2021). He is tied for third in the Texas League with his 11 home runs while his .450 slugging percentage is eighth in the Texas League.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES: Despite allowing 17 combined earned over their last four starts, RoughRiders starting pitchers are still third in the Texas League over the last 18 games with a 3.55 ERA. In addition to pitching well, they are also pitching deep into ballgames. They are averaging 5.0 innings per start, the third-most in Double-A and first in the Texas League. Josh Stephan threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time in his career over the last two weeks while he and Kohl Drake threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time since 2019 bart work. 2018 last week.

OFFENSIVE WOES: Frisco struggled on offense in their last 18 games, batting just .215/.302/.298/.600 with 3.2 runs per game, which are the fewest in the Texas League during that stretch. Their eight home runs are tied for the fewest in the league while their 181 strikeouts are the most as well.

SAVE TONIGHT: The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accom-plish the feat this season. Gavin Collyer are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fourth in the Texas League. Their 24 saves are tied for the fifth-most in Double-A. Their 4.23 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA is fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WORLD

WALLY'S WORLD: Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239. but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.9 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.7 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits are second in the league. In his last 21 games, he is hitting .237 (21-for 77).374/.312/.686 with three doubles, six RBIs, 13 walks, 19 strikeouts and seven stolen bases. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 131 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

NO LONGER DOUBL-A RON:

NO LONGER DOUBL-A RON: Aaron Zavala has been promoted to Triple-A Round Rock! After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he hit .277 (53-for-191)/.390/.440/.830 over his last 52 games. He finished tied for first in the Texas League in walks (47) and is sixth in OBP (.389). In his Frisco career, he has earned 201 walks over four seasons (302 games), which is second in franchise history. He was just four walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by Guilder Rodriguez with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games). His seven home runs this season are his most since his career-best of 16 in 2022.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

-Finished May with a 3-0 record and 1.37 ERA over 5G/4GS, 26.1 IP, 21 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 12 BB, 11 K. His 1.37 ERA was second among Texas League starters with at least four games started.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.
