### Final Week

Reading continues its final series of the season at Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies clinched the season-series over Reading and lead it 11-2.

### Looking Back

Binghamton rolled to an 8-1 win over Reading last night. Zach Haake suffered the loss over 4.1 innings pitched. Offensively, Reading was held to just two hits, with two of them coming from Marcus Lee Sang. Carlos De La Cruz drove in Lee Sang for Reading's lone run, with a sac fly in the sixth. Binghamton had two hits from Drew Gilbert, Jett Williams, Kevin Parada and JT Schwartz, while Blade Tidwell stuck out nine over five.

### He Dunn Gets on Base

With a single last night, Oliver Dunn extended his on-base streak to 17 games. If Dunn can reach base in every remaining game, he will match his season-high on-base streak of 22 games. He currently leads the league with a .405 on base percentage and an OPS of .925. Last week, the R-Phils named Dunn as their Team MVP and Most Clutch Player, as he also leads the team with a .316 on base percentage.

### A Final Look at Abel

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel makes his final Double-A start of 2023. Abel is on track to finish this season on a strong note, as he's allowed just five hits and two-earned runs over 18 innings across his last three starts (1.00 ERA). Unless Abel makes one more start in Triple-A, he will finish 2023 with one less start than 2022, but needs to go 4.2 inning tonight to match last season's inning total of 108.1. Abel is also currently 12 strikeouts shy of his 2022 mark as well. He ranks tenth in the league in strikeouts at 118 and after tonight will be amongst the qualified league leaders in opponent's batting average, WHIP and ERA.

### Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering picked up his sixth Double-A save Friday night, as he threw a scoreless ninth inning. Kerkering has now converted on his last six save opportunities and hasn't allowed a run in his last six outings and 13 of his last 14. Dating back to July 26 (14 appearances) Kerkering is 6/6 in saves, with a 1.29 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Braves in ten innings last night after battling back from down 6-1 earlier in the contest. Lehigh Valley fell 6-4 at Rochester last night Matthew Kroon had two hits. The IronPigs now sit three-games back of Durham with 11 games left to play. Jersey Shore beat Hudson Valley 2-1 to take a 1-0 lead in the playoff series. With the BlueClaws down 1-0 in the eighth, Caleb Ricketts homered to give Jersey Shore the lead. They'll go for the sweep Thursday at Hudson Valley. Clearwater beat Lakeland 1-0 in game one of the postseason as Jean Cabrera went 6.1-shutout innings. The Threshers will go for the sweep on Thursday at home in Clearwater.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

### Playoff Bound Ponies

Binghamton enters tonight with a 36-25 record in the second half and 71-59 overall this season. The Rumble Ponies clinched the second-half title on Sunday and will match up with Somerset next week in the playoffs. Last week, Binghamton went 4-2 on the road at Hartford. The Ponies have the following Mets prospects ranked within their top 30: Luisangel Acuna (1), Drew Gilbert (2), Jett Williams (3), Kevin Parada (5), Blake Tidwell (10), Christian Scott (12), Dom Hamel (16), Tyler Stuart (17), Jeremiah Jackson (22), Matt Rudick (27) and Coleman Crow (29).

### Dog on the Bump

Mets No. 12 Prospect Christian Scott gets the start tonight for the Rumble Ponies. Overall, Scott is 4-3 with a 2.58 ERA (59.1 IP, 41 H, 8 BB, 72 SO) over 11 appearances with Binghamton this season. Scott is striking out 10.9 hitters per nine and has a 9/1 strikeout to walk ratio. Scott started against Reading on July 29 and threw six innings of one-run ball, with five hits and seven strikeouts in a no decision. He threw just two innings at Hartford on Sept. 6 in his first start since Aug. 12. He's also pitched for Single-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn, where he had a 2.28 ERA over six appearances this season. The Mets selected Scott in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of Calvary Christian in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Appeared in and started All-Star Futures Game and went one inning with two strike outs in Seattle. Third start against Binghamton, went five innings on June 9 and allowed one run on one hit. Earned first win since May 5 on Aug. 4, throwing 5.1 shutout innings at Hartford. Pitched five shutout innings against Altoona on July 20, which was first start in 21 days. From June 2 through July 20, pitched six-straight starts of more than five innings. First two wins came in back-to-back strong starts. Six-innings of one run ball on Apr. 29 against Altoona, and followed with six-innings with one-run allowed on May 5 at Hartford. Went career-high seven innings Aug. 23 at Harrisburg, allowing just two hits and striking out three Senators hitters. Followed with five-shutout innings against New Hampshire on Aug. 30. Followed with six-shutout inning in no decision against Portland last time out.

## BIO

**2022:** Split season between high-A Jersey Shore and double-A Reading. Started 18 games for Blue Claws, going 7-8 with a 4.01 ERA. Had 103 strikeouts over 85.1 innings and just 38 walks. Struck out 10.9 hitters per nine innings. Promoted to double-A Reading on August 20. Made five starts for Reading, going 1-3 with a 3.52 ERA. Formed rotation with Phillies' top-prospects Andrew Painter and Griff McGarry. Struck out season-high ten hitters on July 29 at Wilmington, while still with Jersey Shore.

**Career:** Began pro career with single-A Clearwater in 2021. Made 14 starts for Threshers and went 1-3 with 4.43 ERA. Struck out 66 hitters over 44.2 innings (13.3 K/9) and hel opposing hitters to a .174 average. Made debut on May 5 and threw last game of 2021 on July 21. Was placed on 7-day IL on August 3 and would miss rest of season with shoulder troubles.

**Draft/Prep:** Selected by Phillies in First Round (No. 15) in 2020 Draft out of Jesuit High School in Portland Oregon. Missed most of Senior season due to Covid. Abel was ranked as the top high school pitcher in the 2020 Draft class. Barely pitched at Jesuit, but showcased on summer showcase circuit in high school. Growing up, helped Cedar Mill Little League Team win a state title. Played 1B and pitcher for Jesuit High School. Sophomore season cut short due to injury to non-throwing shoulder that required surgery. Junior Year, went 10-0 with 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts over 72.1 innings. Led team to State Title and was named Oregon Gatorage Player of the Year and Junior All-American by Max Preps in 2019. Also in 2019, was selected for U-18 USA Team and going into 2020. Abel was selected a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America. Ranked as fourth-best collegiate prospect in nation. Committed to Oregon State after Freshman Year of high school.

**Scouting Report:** With a tall frame, Abel projects as a right-handed starter. Has a quick arm and fastball sits in mid-to-upper 90s. Also showcases a mid-80s slider, which is a plus pitch for Abel. Has a slower curveball and changeup. As Abel develops, scouts look for him to hone in on his command and improve strike throwing. Growing in that area could help him reach ceiling as front-half of the rotation big league starter.
