LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (May 5, 2023) - Los Viejantes de Scranton/Wilkes-Barre fell 4-1 to the Cocos Locos de Rochester on a Copa de la Diversión night. Copa de la Diversión is an initiative by Minor League Baseball to promote the sport and connect its teams to their Hispanic/Latino communities. Kole Calhoun had another two-hit night while Jesus Bastidas batted in the only run.

Rochester got one on in the first. Darren Baker leadoff with a walk and trotted home on a double from Matt Adams.

In the second, the Red Wings tacked on another. Jeter Downs was hit by a pitch and scored on Richie Martin's double for a 2-0 lead.

The Red Wings added a run thanks to an RBI single from Downs to plate Travis Blakenhorn. The visitors led 3-0.

The RailRiders chipped away with one in the seventh. Back-to-back walks issued to Billy McKinney and Rodolfo Duran put two on. Jesus Bastidas RBI double brought a runner home to make it 3-1.

Randy Vasquez (L, 0-4) took five innings of work allowing three runs on six hits. He recorded a season-high eight strikeouts. Barrett Loseke tossed two clean innings of work. Aaron McGarity had a 1-2-3 eighth, but gave up a solo shot in the ninth.

Paolo Espino (W, 1-1) got the start going five scoreless. He allowed two hits and struck out six. Luis Reyes left after one inning letting up one run on four walks. Gerson Moreno pitched two frames clean. Jordan Weems (S,2) tossed a three out save.

NEWS & NOTES

THEME JERSEYS - Tonight is Star Wars night at PNC Field. The RailRiders will wear their first theme jersey for the night as they change jersey's for the game. The top is straight out of The Mandalorian, a Disney+ series created in 2019, and the Book of Boba Fett. It is a dark navy jersey with dark gold numbering and a white SWB on the front. It depicts the Mandalorian holding Din Grogu, or Baby Yoda as he is colloquially referred to. He is a toddler member of the same species as the Star Wars characters Yoda and Yaddle, with whom he shares a strong ability in the Force. Din Djarin, the Mandalorian, is his adoptive father. Din Grogu is 53 years old, while Yoda is about 900 in age. Grogu can heal himself or other sentient beings from physical injuries.

BULLPEN IS BEST - The RailRiders bullpen has dropped its ERA to 3.59 in the last few weeks. Deivi Garcia has the most innings with 18.2, while Matt Krook has the lowest earned run average at 1.54. Aaron McGarity and Krook both have a team-high 23 strikeouts. Greg Weissert leads with four saves in five attempts. The relievers as a team have recorded 130.1 innings, one more frame than the combined starters. DJ Snelten is currently the only active southpaw in the 'pen.

CHALLENGE FAILED - The home team utilized all three challenges in yesterday's contest. All three calls stood made by home plate umpire Ryan Wills. Randy Vasquez made the first challenge in the second on a ball called to Darren Baker. The call stood but Vasquez ended up recording the strikeout. Barrett Loseke made the second in the fifth on a ball called to Derek Hill. The call stood and the result of the play was a walk. Wilmer Difo utilized the final one in the seventh up at the plate. Difo challenged a called strike three, but it was correct and he headed back to the dugout.

GETTING HIT HURTS - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's pitching staff has hit 26 total batters this season, the most in Triple-A. With one last night, Sean Boyle has recorded eight hit batters, tied for the most in Minor League Baseball.

CALHOUN CAN HIT - Veteran outfielder Kole Calhoun was added to the RailRiders roster on Tuesday, getting the call up from the Florida Complex League. Calhoun was signed by New York on April 20th after spending Spring Training with the Seattle Mariners. He has had two multi-hit games and a home run in the contest last night that helped SWB win. He also made two starts in three field. Calhoun was drafted and spent the majority of his Major League career (2012-2019) with the Los Angeles Angels. He also played for the Diamondbacks and the Rangers.

MOVING OVER TO FIRST - The RailRiders have used three different first basemen in the four games this week against Rochester. Billy McKinney has played at the corner twice while Mickey Gasper and Andres Chaparro each started one contest.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - On Thursday Andres Chaparro turned 24 years old and the RailRiders will celebrate five more birthdays to come this May. Mitch Spence turns 25 on 5/6. Deivi Garcia turns 24 on 5/19. DJ Snelten turns 31 on 5/29, while Elijah Dunham turns 25 the same day. Matt Bowman turns 32 on 5/31.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#18 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

EXCELLENT EXPERIENCE: Weber has pitched as a Major Leaguer in eight consecutive seasons prior to 2023. He has appeared in Major League games for Seattle, Atlanta, Boston, Tampa Bay, New York (AL), and Milwaukee.
