ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Behind more stellar pitching, the Cyclones toppled the Dash 3-1 on Seinfeld Night, pushing the winning streak to three consecutive games. RHP **Junior Santos** spun seven innings of one-run ball, while INF **Gregory Guerrero** mashed a two-run home run to break a 1-1 tie in the bottom of the second. RHP **Daison Acosta** earned another save, tossing two scoreless innings of relief. The Cyclones pushed over .500 for the first time since being 11-10 on May 1. Brooklyn goes for the series victory on Sunday.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn leads the North Division with a +27 run differential and leads both Aberdeen and Hudson Valley by 1.5 games heading into Sunday. The Cyclones have allowed just 121 runs over 35 games (3.5 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.4 runs per game in the second half.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .860 over his past 21 games. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 19 of the past 21 games, hitting .303 with a .386 OBP.

GADDIS GETTING IT DONE: Since June 21, Mets 2019 draftee C/INF **Nic Gaddis** has been on base in 29 of his past 34 games, posting a .394 OBP and a .798 OPS. For his career, Gaddis has a .360 OBP and a .738 OPS.

RA-RA RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor league players with 106 hits. With St. Lucie, Ramirez posted a .802 OPS through 67 games. In just 23 games at High-A, Ramirez has a .875 OPS. The 19-year-old Dominican is two years younger than league average.

CALIFORNIA DREAMING: With Tuesday's trade

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox affiliate comes to Maimonides Park for the first matchup in history. The Dash host White Sox No. 1 prospect SS Colson Montgomery, No. 8 INF Bryan Ramos, and No. 10 RHP Matthew Thompson. In total, the Dash is home to seven of Chicago's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Winston-Salem ranks seventh with a .741 OPS and eighth with a 4.68 among the 12-team South Atlantic League.

between the Mets and San Francisco Giants, Brooklyn LHP **Nick Zwack** and RHP **Carson Seymour** were sent west along with INF **J.D. Davis** and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** for Giants 1B/OF **Darin Ruf**. The Cyclones have received Double-A RHP **David Griffin** and Low-A LHP **Keyshawn Askew** as reinforcements to the arms.

CLONES FLEXING THEIR MUSCLES: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 55 home runs in the past 67 games (0.8 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects. OF Alex Ramirez ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF Jaylen Palmer, No. 19 prospect 1B JT Schwartz, and No. 29 prospect INF Jose Peroza. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP Dominic Hamel, No. 16 prospect RHP Junior Santos, and No. 21 prospect Mike Vasil.

MLB DRAFT: With Monday's deadline of signing 2022 MLB Draftees, the Mets announced the signing of 19 of their 22 picks, including their first four selections: C Kevin Parada (1st round - GA Tech), SS Jett Williams (1st round - Rockwall-Heath HS), RHP Blade Tidwell (2nd round - Tennessee), and OF Nick Morabito (2nd round comp - Gonzaga College HS).

WEEK: Moreno allowed a career-high-tying nine hits in Brooklyn's 4-2 loss on Tuesday to Winston-Salem.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and I pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
