Last Night: Cedar Rapids 8, Lansing 5. The Kernels beat the Lugnuts by an 8-5 score for the second consecutive night, and for the second straight night it came via bringing an 8-3 lead to the bottom of the ninth and withstanding a Lansing rally. The notable exception: Alerick Soularie hit for the cycle for the Kernels, finishing with a home run in the eighth inning. It was the first cycle in Michigan's state capital since Ryan Gold's Golden Cycle against Dayton on April 18, 2019.

On Deck: The Nuts take a day off tomorrow, travel to archrival West Michigan for a six-game series beginning Tuesday, and then return home to open a 12-game, 13-day homestand against Fort Wayne and Beloit on June 14.

**Matinee Notes:** The Lugnuts' offense slashes .213/.317/.380 in day games this year compared to .244/.320/.373 at night. Specific players who have excelled in day games include **Tyler Soderstrom** (12-for-41, 4 2B, 5 HR, .293/.370/.756) and **Joshwan Wright** (7-for-22, .318/.400/.364). Lugnuts pitchers have a 5.58 ERA in day games compared to 5.12 at night.

Amongst the Leaders: 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom is tied for 4th in the Midwest League in home runs (10) and tied for 5th in RBIs (32). Reliever Kumar Nambiar is tied for 2nd in appearances (17) and relievers Angello Infante and Trayson Kubo are tied for 4th in saves (5)

What's in a Name? Speedster Drew Swift did not run much at Arizona State by coaching design; he stole three bases as a freshman at Arizona State, one base as a sophomore, one base as a junior and six bases as a senior... last year, he nabbed 12 bases in 13 attempts for Lansing in 32 games in his professional debut... after going without a steal in his first 11 games this year, he has seven steals in his last 14 games, including a stolen base each of the last three nights against Cedar Rapids.

Starter Lineup: With Shohei Tomioka receiving the start today, the Lugnuts have now used 12 different starting pitchers: Jeff Criswell (9), Osvaldo Berrios (8), Joey Estes (7), Hogan Harris (6), Mac Lardner (4), Grant Holman (3), Blake Beers (2), David Leal (2), James Gonzalez (1), Diego Granado (1) and Tomioka.

**Old Friend:** Lugnuts outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** spent part of 2018 and 2019 and the entire 2021 season with Cedar Rapids, notably hitting a walkoff grand slam to beat the Nuts and David Leal last June. In all, Maciel played 148 games with the Kernels over three years, collecting 137 hits, 14 doubles, eight triples, four homers, and 27 stolen bases. 14 active Kernels played with Maciel last year in Cedar Rapids, with manager **Brian Dinkelman** returning as skipper and **Mark Moriarty** and **Richard Salazar** returning as dual pitching coaches.

**167 Major League Nuts:** Pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019 in Lansing) made his MLB debut on May 28, starting for the Boston Red Sox and allowing four runs on six hits and three walks in three innings with four strikeouts. In the process, Winckowski became the 167th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the sixth this year, joining Oakland A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes**, Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** and Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young**.

# 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

2009: The Lugnuts and TinCaps were tied at 1-1 going to the 8th in Fort Wayne but the Lugnuts scored four runs in the 8th (including a Justin McClanahan two-run homer) and four more in the 9th (including a Chris Emanuele two-run homer) for a 9-2 victory. CF Emanuele finished 4-for-5.

2019: Five Lugnuts - pitchers Cobi Johnson and Josh Winckowski, starting first baseman Jake Brodt, catcher Ryan Gold and infielder Nick Podkul - were named Midwest League Eastern Division All-Stars. In the matinee game that afternoon, Hagen Danner, Griffin Conine and Nick Podkul all homered, but the Lugnuts lost at Great Lakes, 6-5.

**Personal:** Began pitching at age nine, when he was ordered out to the mound by a youth baseball coach... learned his curveball at age nine as well... chose to attend Toyo University specifically for baseball, but only made six appearances at the college level.

**Talented Staff:** Shohei pitched on a talented Toyo University staff, evidenced by how the 2018 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft was loaded with his teammates, with **Hiroshi Kaino** selected 1st overall by Fukuoka, **Taiga Kamichatani** going later in the 1st round to Yokohama, and Chunichi drafting **Kodai Umetsu** in the 2nd round.

**The Road to MLB:** After not being drafted, Tomioka pitched for VITAL-NET in the amateur Industrial League, a level in which Hideo Nomo, Jun Tazawa and Kosuke Fukudome all first made their names before joining the higher ranks... tried out for the Athletics with 27 other pitchers in Autumn 2019, hit 95 mph with his fastball, and was signed in February... scout: Toshiyuki Tomitsuka... 2021 marked his pro debut.
