**FISHER CATS WALK OFF SEA DOGS IN SERIES OPENER TUESDAY:** LJ Talley delivered a bases-loaded single in the bottom of the 10<sup>th</sup> inning, as the Fisher Cats mounted an impressive comeback to defeat the Sea Dogs in extra innings. After the Fisher Cats tied the game up at seven in the bottom of the seventh, the Sea Dogs plated two runs in the top of the 10<sup>th</sup>. Chris Bec singled home a run, Otto Lopez drew a game-tying RBI hit-by-pitch, and LJ Talley completed the comeback with a single to center field. Brody Rodning picked up the win in relief, following solid outings from Fitz Stadler and Kyle Johnston. The Fisher Cats did not lead in the game until the final pitch.

**O, TANNER-DA:** Tanner Kirwer homered on his first swing at Delta Dental Stadium, notching his first long ball at the Double-A level. Kirwer, a native of Alberta, also delivered a sacrifice fly, for his first multi-RBI game with New Hampshire as well.

**IT'S SAMAD WORLD:** Samad Taylor finished June with nine homers, tying the franchise record for most in a calendar month. Taylor slashed .359/.473/1.212 in June, going 33-for-92 with eight doubles, nine homers, 21 RBI, 18 walks, two HBP, and seven stolen bases.

**SEA YOU LATER:** The Fisher Cats and Portland Sea Dogs are facing off for games 19-24 on the season. The teams will meet a whopping 36 times over the course of this season, accounting for 30% of the games each team will play on the year. The Fisher Cats have won five straight against Portland, one short of the franchise record of six (May 14-June 26, 2011). Portland won seven in-a-row earlier this year, and once won 14 straight games against New Hampshire (July 11-August 28, 2005).

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** July 1, 2015- Three Fisher Cats pitchers combined on a seven-hit shutout, 2-0, at Hadlock Field. John Anderson (6.2 IP) started before Chad Girodo and Wil Browning finished up. Dalton Pompey drove in the first run with an RBI single in the third inning, and Dwight Smith knocked in the other run with a single in the top of the fifth. Pompey is hitting .265 for Double-A Rocket City (Angels) and Smith Jr. was hitting .220 for Triple-A Louisville before being released.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays battled back twice to force extra innings, but lost 9-7 in ten to Seattle (in Buffalo). Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit his ninth home run in the eighth inning to tie. Fisher Cat alums figured in the decision on both sides. Kendall Graveman earned the win in relief for the M's and Patrick Murphy took the loss...Logan Warmoth and Kevin Smith hit homers in Buffalo's 10-9 win over Lehigh Valley...Everett edged Vancouver 2-1...Dunedin dropped a doubleheader to Palm Beach 5-3 and 7-6. The FCL Jays had a day off.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats will spend two weeks on the road after this series. The Fisher Cats will head to Mirabito Stadium to take on the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets) next week before a week at Hartford July 13-18. The only other home series this month begins July 20 against Reading (Phillies).

**ROSTER MOVES:** June 30: Gabriel Moreno placed on IL and Rodrigo Vigil added from Triple-A Buffalo.

**STARTERS:** Elvis Luciano will make his third start since his injury this evening. His last outing against Bowie, Luciano went three innings, allowing one hit and one walk with two strikeouts. He is holding opponents to an average of .203. In the nightcap, Maximo Castillo looks for his sixth win.

For Portland, Brayan Bello gets the start this evening. He has only surrendered four runs in his 11 innings at the Double-A level since his promotion from Greenville in early June. This will be his fourth start of the season, and his second against the Fisher Cats. A J Politi is the Portland starter in the second game.

**2019:** Luciano was selected in the Rule 5 draft in December 2018 from the Royals, and spent all of 2019 with the Blue Jays. Made his MLB debut on March 31, 2019. Appeared in 25 games, all out of the bullpen, going 1-0 with a 5.35 ERA.

**2018:** Was in the Royals system, appeared in 13 games – 2 with Pioneer League Idaho Falls – and 11 (all starts) with Burlington, NC (Appy League). KC had acquired Luciano as part of a trade which sent OF Jon Jay to Arizona.

**2017:** In Arizona's system, pitched for Arizona League Diamondbacks and Pioneer League Missoula.

**Career/Personal Notes:** On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time. Although he has pitched in the Majors, has not pitched higher than Rookie League level prior to this season.

**Obtained:** Signed by Arizona as a non-drafted free agent in 2017. Traded to Kansas City, and picked up by Toronto in the Rule 5 draft 12/12/18. On Toronto's 40-man roster.

Maximo Castillo starts the second game for the Fisher Cats.

Castillo, a native of Caracas, Venezuela, earned his team-leading fifth win at Bowie last Friday night. He allowed four runs in 5.2 IP in New Hampshire's 10-8 win. Among Castillo's wins are two against Portland in four starts this season.

The 22-year old is pitching at the Double-A level for the first time. He has spent his entire career in the Blue Jays organization after signing with them on 9/25/15. Was named a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star in 2019 after going 11-5, 2.69 ERA in 24 starts (7 quality starts).
