LEITER WHIFFS SEVEN, RIDERS HANG ON LATE IN WIN:

In his professional baseball debut, **Jack Leiter** struck out seven batters in three innings at Riders Field to power Frisco to an 8-7 win over Arkansas. Facing a four-run deficit, the Travs knocked three consecutive home runs in the top of the ninth before **Jordan Procyshen** recorded his first save of the season. Leading 5-4 into the seventh inning, the Riders stretched their lead with three consecutive run-scoring hits from **Blaine Crim**, **Ezequiel Duran** and **J.P. Martinez**. Catcher **David Garcia** fashioned his Double-A debut with four runs driven in, featuring a double with the bases loaded in the bottom of the sixth. Frisco scored six of their eight runs after the fifth inning. Garcia's first RBI came to plate the first run of Saturday's game in the bottom of the second. **Josh Stowers** hit his second double of the season with one out before Garcia drove him in on a hard-hit grounder through the right side of the infield. The Travs began their scoring when Matt Scheffler walked to lead off the third, followed up by an RBI from Cade Marlowe as the only earned run allowed by Leiter. Arkansas utilized five walks in the seventh inning when Matt Scheiner singled to score the third run of the inning, drawing it to a run before Frisco's three-run seventh. Following Leiter's three frames, the Riders used a barrage of six arms out of the bullpen. **Tai Tiedemann** (1-0) didn't allow a run in two quiet innings of relief. Frisco right-hander **Luke Jacobsen** struck out two in 1.1 scoreless innings in his first recorded appearance since 2019. After the 2020 off-year, Jacobsen missed last season with an injury. Arkansas flirted with overcoming a four-run deficit in their final frame, bringing the tying run to the plate after three consecutive solo home runs from Zach DeLoach, Jake Scheiner and Joe Rizzo all went deep to cut the Riders' deficit to one.

OUT OF THE GATES:

In 2021, the RoughRiders began the season 3-0 and raced to a 14-6 record through their first 20 games. After starting the year 2-0 in 2022, the Riders have a chance to tie the best start in a season since 2016 when Frisco jumped out to a 5-0 record. That 2016 squad started 9-1 through 10 games, 17-4 through 21 games and 23-7 through 30 games. After that, they struggled, going 40-69 the rest of the way, finishing the season in third place in the Texas League South.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

CATCHERS? MORE LIKE HITTERS:

Riders catcher **Matt Whatley** went 2-for-3 with a double in the Opener on Friday. In 2021, Whatley got off to a fast start as well, hitting safely in his first three games and four of his first five (.400/.526/.467). **David Garcia** then followed that up with a career day, matching a career-best four RBIs in a 2-for-4 night, including a three-run double.

VS. THE TRAVS:

In 2021, pitching fittingly dominated the head-to-head meetings between the RoughRiders and the Travelers. The two teams finished first (Frisco, 3.98) and second (Arkansas, 4.13) in the Double-A Central in team ERA, but both just missed the playoffs on the last day of the season. Head-to-head, in 12 games, the RoughRiders went 4-8, despite owning a 2.50 ERA as a team against the Travs and holding them to a .187 average. Frisco also hit 10 home runs to Arkansas five in the meetings. In their history, this is the fourth time that the Riders and Travs have opened the season against one another, with the most recent game being a 8-4 win for Arkansas on April 9th, 2015.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. A pair of returners from 2021's team round out the prospects in LHP **Cody Bradford** and RHP **Zak Kent**. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).

LOTS OF FAMILIAR FACES:

The RoughRiders welcome 13 returners back from 2021 this season. Frisco is led by six players who were with the Riders from the beginning of 2021 (RHP **Fer Ozuna**, C **Jordan Procyshen**, C **Matt Whatley**, INF **Dio Arias**, OF **J.P. Martinez** and OF **Josh Stowers**). The other returning arms include LHP **Cody Bradford**, LHP **Cole Ragans**, RHP **Grant Anderson**, RHP **Tai Tiedemann**, RHP **Zak Kent** and RHP **Chase Lee**. UTL **Blaine Crim** is the other returner for the Riders as the only position player who is back, but did not start with Frisco.

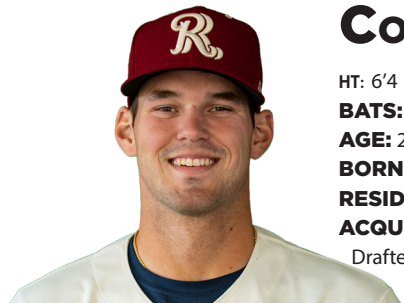

ABOUT COLE

-Selected by the Rangers with the 30th overall pick in the 2016 draft. Highest high school lefty taken by the Rangers since they took Matt Purke with the 14th overall pick in 2009 (Purke did not sign). Before that, Kasey Kiker, who was selected with the 12th-overall pick in 2006 was the highest drafted high school lefty by Texas.

-Originally committed to Florida State University before being drafted, Ragans was ranked as the 12th-best high school pitcher in the draft and the 6th-best left hander by *Baseball America*.

-At North Florida Christian High School, was 9-2 as a senior with a 0.90 ERA. He struck out 104 batters over 90.0 innings while holding opponents to a .122 batting average.

-Ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole Hamels. After being drafted by the Rangers, Hamels, who was a member of the Rangers at the time, took Ragans under his wing. He shadowed him for an entire day, following him around during 2017 Spring Training and learned everything he could from him. Most of all, he learned about what it took on the mental side to be a starting pitcher. When he was first promoted to Frisco in July of 2021, Hamels happened to be throwing a bullpen for scouts at Riders Field and Ragans had the opportunity to reconnect with the veteran lefty.

-Ragans was selected to play in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game in Denver, along with teammate RHP Cole Winn. After receiving that news, he was informed a few days later that he would join the RoughRiders and be promoted to Double-A right after the game. He called it, "an unbelievable moment given what he had been through." He enjoyed the emotional moment with his wife over the phone.
