AFC Richmond: The Somerset Patriots take on the Richmond Flying Squirrels in game two of six tonight. Somerset won the series opener 3-2. The Patriots took five of six against the Flying Squirrles in Bridgewater in the middle of June. Richmond feature a pair top-15 San Francisco Giants prospects with outfielder Heliot Ramos (No. 3, Baseball America) and RHP Sean Hjelle (No. 13, Baseball America).

Got Junk: RHP Janson Junk takes the mound tonight for Somerset. Junk owns the lowest qualified ERA (1.08) among minor league pitchers at the full season level. His ERA ranks over two runs better than the next closest qualified pitcher in the Double-A Northeast League (Akron's Thomas Ponticelli, 3.10 ERA). He also ranks third in batting average against (.164) and fourth in WHIP (0.82) across all MiLB levels.

Locked In: Outfielder Brandon Lockridge blasted a solo home run in his Patriots debut last night. The 24-year old hit .256 with three home runs and 22 RBI with High-A Hudson Valley over 32 games to begin his 2021 season.

Post Milone: Outfielder Thomas Milone extended his on-base streak to 27-straight games with a walk last night. The streak dates back to May 11th, the longest such streak for the team this year. Milone is hitting .300 (27-for-90) over this streak with four home runs, 11 RBI, 14 runs and a .385 OBP.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has the lowest ERA (2.89) among all of Minor League Baseball (full season) and is the only team with a sub-three ERA. The staff is also tied for the lowest batting average against (.202) has the second-lowest WHIP (1.12).

Whizz Kid Waldichuk: Starting pitcher Ken Waldichuk had a career day in last night's victory. The left-hander recorded a career high in innings (6.1), strikeouts (11) and pitches (97). Waldichuk is now 3-0 with a 3.08 ERA over five Double-A starts this season. Additionally, Somerset has won each of the five games in which Waldichuk started.

More Marinaccio: RHP Ron Marinaccio has not allowed a run over his last seven appearances, spanning 12.0 innings of work. He's allowed just two hits and five walks while striking out 18 over this stretch. He's also recorded a pair of saves and has lowered his ERA from 3.60 to 2.00 this year.

On The Move: Prior to Tuesday's game in Richmond, the New York Yankees announced that RHP Glenn Otto had been transferred to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and that INF Brandon Lockridge had been transferred from High-A Hudson Valley to Somerset. Otto marks the fourth pitcher to get called up to Triple-A this season.
