In It To Win It... The Bowling Green Hot Rods' secured the South Atlantic League South Division's First Half Title with an 11-0 win over the Rome Emperors. 2026 marks the 12th season that Bowling Green will compete in a postseason, looking for their fifth league championship. The Hot Rods boast the best record in the SAL in 2026.

Home Field Advantage... The Hot Rods go for another series victory at Bowling Green Ballpark on Sunday afternoon. Bowling Green has won each of their first five home series during the 2026 season. Bowling Green holds a 24-7 record and leads the South Atlantic League with a 77.4 win% in home games this year. The Hot Rods have blasted 43 home runs in 31 home games and posted .834 team OPS.

Gillen's Going Off... Theo Gillen's 4-for-4 performance on Friday night marked the fifth four-hit game by a Hot Rods player in 2026. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 1 prospect delivered a solid encore Saturday night, going 2-for-3 with an RBI. Gillen leads the South Atlantic League with a .333 batting average and has reached base in each of his last 15 games dating back to May 24. Gillen ranks in the league's Top Five in six major metrics, including OPS (1.020, 2nd), OBP (.443, 3rd), stolen bases (25, 3rd), hits (63, T-3rd) and runs scored (45, 5th).

Raking Vs. Rome... Carlos Colmenarez, Marshall Toole and Aidan Smith have each hit their first 2026 Bowling Green home runs over the last two wins on Friday and Saturday. The Hot Rods have cracked 17 home runs in their 17 matchups against the Emperors this season. Gillen (5), Nathan Flewelling (3) and Angel Mateo (2) have all hit multiple home runs against Rome.

Dominic's Doing His Thing... Southpaw Dominic Niman makes his third start on the mound for the Hot Rods on Sunday afternoon. Niman has thrown 9.0 consecutive scoreless innings as a starter, striking out nine and allowing just four base runners against the Wilmington Blue Rocks and the Emperors. The left-hander had made just one professional start prior to the 2026 MiLB season.

Tony's Terrific Return... Third baseman Tony Santa Maria tied his career-best five RBI on Thursday night. He clubbed a three-run home run to left-center field in the bottom of the sixth inning and had a two-run single in ninth. Santa Maria has driven in 29 RBI in 37 games as a Hot Rods player this season.
