Clean Slate

The Fightin Phils continue the first week of the season's second half with game two of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox at home. It is the fifth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and second-of-six in Reading. The teams saw each other the first weekend of the season from Apr. 5-7 in Bowie. Reading won the first game, then dropped the final two contests at Prince George's Stadium. The season series is currently tied at two.

Strong Start to the Week

Strong pitching and three home runs lifted the Fightin Phils to a 8-4 win over the Bowie Baysox on Tuesday night. Carson Taylor hit a two-run homer in the first inning, then Caleb Ricketts hit a solo shot in his first game off the IL in the seventh, and finally Robert Moore blasted a two-run shot into the right field pool in the eighth. Taylor had three RBI, while Moore had two. Carlos De La Cruz, Taylor and Trevor Schwecke each had two hits as well. Lachlan Wells stated and went seven innings, allowing three runs and five strikeouts. It was the second time this season a Reading pitcher went seven innings in a start, with the last being Robinson Pina's complete game on June 8 against Harrisburg. Reading has now won four games in a row, tying a season high from Apr. 21-25.

Carson Crushing It

Carson Taylor stayed red-hot with two hits, a run, a home run and three RBI on Tuesday night. Since June 18, Taylor is slashing .409/.458/.591, with a 1.049 OPS. He added five runs, one double, one home run and seven RBI. Last week was highlighted by a four-hit perfommace on Friday night, which was the second four-hit game of Taylor's career, with the last coming on June 22, 2021, when he was with Great Lakes in the Dodgers' organization. Taylor's 53 RBI on the season lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A. His other Eastern League ranks are: 4th AVG (.304), 4th OBP (.395), 2nd SLG (.526) and 2nd OPS (.921).

Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz continued his mid-season turnaround with two hits and a run scored in Tuesday's win. After hitting just a combined .213 through April and May, De La Cruz has been impressive in June. For the month, he is slashing .313/.402/.600, with a 1.002 OPS. De La Cruz has added 20 runs, five doubles, six home runs and 15 RBI on the month. He's struck out just 23 times in 92 plate appearances, after striking out 36 times in 89 plate appearances in May. He sits third on Reading in home runs at eight on the season.

Bombs Away

After hitting three more home runs on Sunday afternoon, Reading has set a season-high with home runs in 10 games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 17-of-18 games. The 10-game home run streak is Reading's longest such streak since homering in 11-straight games from July 30-August 11 of last season.

Pitching Powers

Last week, was a strong week for Fightin Phils pitching, as they posted a 3.20 ERA for the week, which was tied for fourth in the Eastern League. Much of the success came via control, as Reading pitchers have issued just eight walks, dating back to June 18. That mark is not just the lowest in the Eastern League and Double-A, but in all of Minor League baseball for that span.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 26, 2015: At Reading, in game 2 of a double-header, Andrew Knapp goes 1-for-4 with a walk and an RBI in his Double-A debut. His hit comes with one out in the bottom of the 9th, driving in Kelly Dugan with the game-winning run in thr victory over Akron. It started a 17-game hit streak for Knapp.

The Book on Bowie

Bowie enters tonight after finishing in fifth place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison for the first half with a 32-36 record. They are tied for third in the Southwest Division with an 0-1 record in the second half of the season. Bowie most recently dropped five-of-six at home against the Altoona Curve. Following this week, Bowie heads home for three against Richmond, then three at the Flying Squirrels. Bowie's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Baltimore Orioles' top-30 prospects: Samuel Basallo (2), Dylan Beavers (7), Seth Johnson (10), Jud Fabian (12), Max Wagner (14), Trace Bright (16), John Rhodes (23), Alex Pham (24) and Frederick Benscome (27).

On the Mound for Bowie

Righty Kyle Brnovich makes the start tonight for Bowie. This season, Brnovich is 4-2, with a 3.91 ERA over 13 games and eight starts (53.0 IP, 36 H, 24 BB, 62 SO). He last pitched on June 20 against Altoona in a no-decision. Brnovich went 4.2 innings, allwoing four hits, one run, walking two and striking out a pair. He faced Reading on Apr. 6 and allowed one run on two hits, with five strikeouts, in a 4.2 inning no-decision. Brnoch made eight appearances across four levels last season, going 0-2, with a 4.50 ERA. He was limited to just two starts with Triple-A Norfolk in 2022 and underwent Tommy John Surgery in May of 2022. He began his pro career in 2021 between High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. The Angels drafted Brnovich in the eighth round of the 2019 draft out of Elon. He was then traded from the Angels to Baltimore in December of 2019 in a deal that sent Dylan Bundy to the Angels.
