YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 10-4. In the first, Tsung-Che Cheng hit a solo homer to lead off the game and Sammy Siani added an RBI groundout to open a 2-0 lead for Altoona. In the bottom of the first, the Flying Squirrels responded with three runs to take a one-run lead. **Victor Bericoto** hit an RBI double, **Will Wilson** scored on a wild pitch and **Andy Thomas** added a sacrifice fly. Thomas extended the lead to 4-2 with a solo homer, his second of the season, in the bottom of the fourth inning. The Curve scored five runs in the fifth to take a 7-4 lead. Cheng hit an RBI double, Jase Bowen brought in a run with a sac fly, Seth Beer hit an RBI triple and Siani hit a two-run homer. In the seventh, Beer hit an RBI single, Siani singled in a run and Wyatt Hendrie added an RBI single to extend the Curve lead to 10-4. **Nick Sinacola** made his Double-A debut as the Flying Squirrels' starter and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts. **Tyler Myrick** worked the final two innings and did not allow a run. Altoona starter Braxton Ashcraft struck out 12 batters over seven innings of work, one shy of matching the Altoona franchise record. He was the first Curve pitcher to strikeout 12 in a game since Tyler Glasnow in 2015.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the fourth of a six-game series at The Diamond. This series marks the first meetings between the two teams this year. The Curve return to Richmond for a six-game series from Aug. 20-25. The Flying Squirrels play two six-game sets in Altoona this year, the first from July 30-Aug. 4 and the last to close the regular season from Sept. 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-7 in their last 21 games, the second-best record in the league over that span, after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond last week. They are 2-1 in this week's series against the Curve.

THE CURVE are in last place in the Southwest Division. They snapped a five-game losing streak with Thursday night's win. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 19) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26). There are seven Altoona players on Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects list, including Chandler (No. 3), Solometo (No. 5), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 7), Ashcraft (No. 10), Bowen (No. 26) and Gonzalez (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Dylan Cumming** makes his first Double-A start. Tonight marks his first start at The Diamond since March 15, 2022, when he threw 4.1 scoreless innings for Liberty against VCU. He made his Double-A debut last Thursday against the SeaWolves out of the bullpen and struck out seven batters over four innings, allowing one run. Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. In his final start for the Emeralds on May 22 against Spokane, he set a career high with nine strikeouts over five innings in a win. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. **For more on Cumming, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Po-Yu Chen makes his ninth start of the year and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday against the Sea Dogs and allowed one run over six innings, tied for his longest start this year. Chen, a native of Taiwan, signed with the Pirates as an international free agent on October 7, 2020. He spent the 2023 season with High-A Greensboro, going 5-8 with a 4.44 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). He was a member of the 2019 U-18 Chinese Taipei national team that won a world championship, starting games against Panama and Korea before picking up the save in the gold medal game with two innings against the United States. His father, Ping-Nan Chen, played in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,012).

TAKE IT FOR GRANTED: In his last 21 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .348 (24-for-69) with two homers, nine doubles, three triples, nine walks, 10 RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .220. McCray is tied for second in the Eastern League in triples (3), tied for third in doubles (14) and tied for fourth in extra-base hits (23). Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the previous weeks' series in Bowie. Prior to going 0-for-1 on Friday night, McCray had reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which was tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .327 (18-for-55) over his last 17 games since May 15 with two homers, five doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .245. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. On Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season.

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.48 ERA (5 ER/30.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings last week against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on Friday against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on Tuesday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 65 Double-A games, combining for a 3.33 ERA (35 ER/94.2 IP).

SETTING THE TABLE: Over his last six games since May 31, **Carter Howell** is batting .400 (10-for-25) with two doubles, a triple, two walks, two RBIs and two runs scored. He has picked up two hits in four of those six games. In his 21 games batting first in the Flying Squirrels' lineup this year, Howell is batting .306 (26-for-85). He is also batting .348 (16-for-34) when leading off an inning. This season, he is batting .458 (11-for-24) in the first inning.

BLANK SPACE: Three of the Flying Squirrels' last four wins have been shutouts. They shut out the SeaWolves twice last week. Last Tuesday, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings before **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On Friday night, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 3.1 innings. Myrick threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. On Tuesday to begin this series, **John Michael Bertrand** pitched six innings, **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless seventh and Gates retired the final six outs in a 1-0 win over the Curve. The Flying Squirrels' seven shutout wins this season are tied for second-most in the Eastern League with Harrisburg, trailing only Akron with eight.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

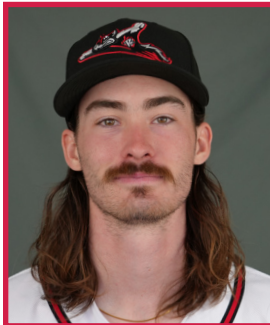
