LAST TIME OUT: The Saints led 1-0 and 2-1 in Saturday's game at Columbus, but it would not stay that way as the Clippers would go on to win 8-3. Columbus scored three runs in the third and sixth innings, hitting three home runs on the day. DaShawn Keirsey Jr. tied Yunior Severino for the team-lead and franchise record with his 76th RBI, driving in a run in the third. Brent Headrick made his first relief appearance of the season, throwing 2.0 shutout innings and striking out three.

DOBNAK KEEPS THEM DOWN: Randy Dobnak has always been known as a ground ball pitcher, and has lived up to that role this season. He is the Triple-A leader in ground ball rate (per FanGraphs) at 57.3%. He is second among all qualified full-season pitchers, trailing only Modesto's (A - SEA) Elijah Dale, who sits at 59.0%. Dobnak's current ground ball rate is the highest since he was in the Big Leagues in 2020, working a 62.1% rate.

NOT-SO-FREE PASSES: Saints pitchers have been able to limit walks as of late, issuing 39 walks in September, the third-fewest in the IL. They have not walked more than four batters in each of their last seven games. The Saints have issued the 501 walks this year, the fewest in the International League. Saints starters have walked just 203 hitters this year, the fewest in Triple-A. Meanwhile relievers have walked 298, ranking eighth in the league.

BULLPEN BACKFIRE: Late-game home runs have come to hurt the Saints over the the last two weeks. Over the Saints' last 11 games (dating back to September 2), Saints relievers have surrendered a Triple-A-high 14 home runs, five more than any other Triple-A bullpen in that span. The 26 runs that have scored as a result of those home runs is also the most in Triple-A, nine more than the next-closest team. Over the last 11 games, 27 of the 43 runs (62.7%) scored against the Saints bullpen have come on home runs, the highest rate in Triple-A.

HUNTINGTON HOUSE OF HORRORS: Huntington Park has historically been a difficult place for the Saints to play, going 12-29 since joining the International League in 2021. The Saints' .293 winning percentage at Huntington Park since 2021 is the worst of any road venue they have played in. Below is how the Saints' offense has fared at each road stadium (min. two series) since 2021, sorted by batting average:

WILLIAMS WARMING UP: Chris Williams has found his stride in the month of September, collecting hits in six of seven games, reaching base in eight straight games. In that stretch, he's gone 8-for-22 (.364), sporting a 1.000 OPS. Williams has also drawn a walk in five of the seven, drawing six free passes, surpassing his five walks drawn in 12 August games.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: Yunior Severino has had an incredible turnaround this season and now finds himself in position to set several franchise single-season records. He has set a new single-season RBI record with 76 and collected 119 hits on the season, the fourth-most in a the single-season. He also ranks second in the single-season home run charts with 20, trailing the 21 long balls that Jair Camargo and Chris Williams hit last season.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins were beat 11-1 by Cincinnati last night. The Reds scored nine runs in the fourth inning, with six coming against Louie Varland. The Twins were out-hit 15-5 and look to avoid the sweep this afternoon.

LAST APPEARANCE: 9/10 @ COL...made fourth relief appearance of the season with St. Paul, threw 5.0 innings, allowed two runs on four hits, two walks and four strikeouts...entered the game in the entered the game in the fifth inning, threw clean innings in the fifth and the seventh innings...allowed two hits in the sixth and eighth innings, allowing a run in each frame...first time allowing multiple earned runs in St. Paul in relief...received 12th win in 7-4 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 9/4 v IOW...made third Triple-A relief appearance, piggybacking Brent Headrick...allowed two hits, one run on a solo home run, one walk and struck out six...allowed solo home run to Chase Strumpf in the fifth inning and walked the next batter, facing the minimum to finish the game...retired final 11 batters of the game, a Saints single-game high in 2024...received 11th win in a 2-1 game...retired Saints victory.

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus. Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his flancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.
