LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Sunday's series finale at Greenville, 9-8...Drive took the lead for good with 3 runs in the bottom of the 8th...Cyclones smashed 3 home runs...2B **D'Andre Smith** blasted a solo shot and 1B **Ryan Clifford** tacked on a 3-run blast in the 5th...SS **Jett Williams** added a solo home run in the 9th...LF **Nick Decker** posted a 2-run home run for Greenville in the 6th...Clifford tallied 3 hits, while Williams and C **Drake Osborn** posted multi-hit nights, as well...SS **Eddinson Paulino**, RF **Bryan González**, and 1B **Tyler Miller** composed multi-hit games for the Drive.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 34-26 in the second half and tied with Jersey Shore (34-26) atop the North Division of the SAL with 6 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on Saturday and is 2 home runs (20) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Tuesday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.479), 5th in home runs (20), and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (39), and 9th in total bases (162)...Over his last 16 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .258/.333/.645 with a .979 OPS, adding 16 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, and 19 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (6), RBI (19), extra-base hits (10), and total bases (40) in addition to being tied for the lead in runs scored (16) and triples (2).

JETT THE MET: INF **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .313/.474/.585 with a 1.059 OPS, 33 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs, 20 RBI, 43 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 43 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 190 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.474) and OPS (1.059)...He is also tied for 1st in walks (43)...On the season, Williams is tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in walks (97)...Among teenagers, Williams leads MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.455), OPS (1.003), and walks (28)...He is also tied for 1st in stolen bases (10), 2nd in slugging percentage (.548) and batting average (.298), tied for 3rd in hits (31), and tied for 4th in extra-base hits (14) and doubles (8)...Among SAL players with at least 120 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in walk rate (20.9%), OBP (.455), and 5th in wRC+ (175), wOBA (.452), and OPS (1.003).

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old reached base safely in all 12 games of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 31 fewer games (27 to 58) and 130 fewer plate appearances (120 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Tuesday 2nd in the SAL in slugging percentage (.490), tied for 3rd home runs (21), tied for 4th in OPS (.833), and 10th in RBI (62)...Clifford is also 2nd in isolated power (.245) to teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.246), and 8th in wOBA (.371) and wRC+ (124).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo has reached safely in 10 consecutive games and is 13-for-38 at the plate (.342) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, and 4 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .333/.386/.444 with a .830 OPS...Lugo has also scored 7 runs, picked up 4 doubles, a triple, and 13 RBI in 17 games...The Dominican native is tied for 2nd in the league lead in hits (21) and tied for 5th in RBI (13) in that span.

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in hits (161) and is just 1 behind INF **José Peroza** (162) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (85) and RBI (86).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.48 ERA (316 ER in 817.1 IP) over their last 94 games, holding a 51-43 record, which is the 2nd

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: 3B **Yohandy Morales** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (13), OF **Daylen Lile** (14), OF **T.J. White** (16), RHP **Andry Lara** (19)...De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 24 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 12-12 against Wilmington, including only 5-7 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 38-36 all-time against the 'Rocks.

lowest in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 2nd most in MiLB...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.650), and 4th in hits-per-9 innings (7.36) and batting average against (.221).

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn collected its 11th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking at Greenville on Saturday...RHP **Robert Colina** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Rodríguez** (3.0) combined on the blanking...With Saturday's performance, the Cyclones have set a new franchise record for single-season shutouts...Before 2023, Brooklyn had accrued 10 shutouts in a season that happened on 4 separate occasions...It previously happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 11 shutouts are tied for the 4th-most in all of Minor League Baseball and tied for first among South Atlantic League squads with Hudson Valley and Bowling Green.

GRAB A SEAT: RHP **Robert Colina** became the 6th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 10 Drive batters on Saturday night...He joins RHP **Joander Suárez** who whiffed 11 vs. Aberdeen on August 11...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has as many pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frias** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

THE ROCO SHOW: RHP **Robert Colina** registered one of the best performances of his career on Saturday at Greenville...The Venezuela native set a career-high in innings pitched (6.0) and tied a career-best in strikeouts (10) in a 6-0 shutout...Since his 7-strikeout performance vs. Hudson Valley on June 21, Colina holds a 4-3 record with a 3.30 ERA (16 ER in 43.2 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 41 hits and walked 7 with 55 strikeouts over his last 12 appearances (7 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 6.7 percent (31.1 K%) and the walk rate is down 7.0 percent (4.0 BB%) from his first 7 appearances (1 start).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 106 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second loss with Brooklyn last Tuesday night at Greenville...Permitted 5 runs (3 earned) on 2 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked 5 and struck out 3...Charged with a balk...Tossed 75 pitches and 42 strikes (56.0%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** with runners at 1st and 3rd and 1 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn trailing 3-0... Both bequeathed runners scored on a pair of errors...Game was delayed for 74 minutes in the top of the 6th due to rain...Cyclones broke up the shutout in the 8th, but fell to the Drive, 6-1.

VICIOUS VENTURA: Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Briam Campusano** tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018.

AIR JORDANY: Ventura joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 14...In 15 appearances (13 starts) in the Florida State League, the 23-year-old registered a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP)...Issued 50 walks and struck out 60...Has struggled in a starting role in 2023...In 13 starts, holds a 3-3 mark with a 6.70 ERA (33 ER in 44.1 IP)...Is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (1 ER in 9.2 IP) in a pair of relief outings...Tossed his first career complete game in a 5-inning loss at Palm Beach on June 16...Yielded 1 run on 3 hits over 4.0 innings.

TOP PROSPECT: Ventura is ranked as the Mets' No. 29 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball America*...The right-hander was deemed the organization's No. 19 farmhand entering 2022 and No. 20 before 2021 by *Baseball America*.

ON THE MEND: Ventura is in the midst of his first full professional season since 2019...The Dominican native missed the entire 2021 season and most of 2022 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

2022: Started the campaign on St. Lucie's 60-day injured list...Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on June 5...Tossed a pair of perfect innings on June 6 vs. the FCL Astros Orange, striking out 3...Reinstated from the IL on June 12...Made 3 starts in the Florida State League...Did not receive a decision and posted a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on June 29.
