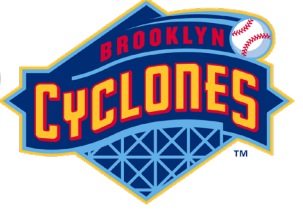

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its second-straight victory with a 7-1 win vs. Wilmington on Saturday...Cyclones took the lead for good in the 3rd on solo home runs by SS **Jett Williams** and RF **Stanley Consuegra**...2B **D'Andre Smith** collected a game-high 3 hits, adding a 2-run double in the 5th...Williams also reached base 3 times on 2 hits and a walk...RHP **Saúl García** tossed 5.0 innings of 2-hit ball to earn the win in his Maimonides Park debut...The 20-year-old allowed just 1 unearned run...RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (2.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** (2.0) combined for 4.0 innings of shutout relief to close out Brooklyn's 4-hitter.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 38-27 in the second half and are a game ahead of Jersey Shore (37-28) atop the North Division of the SAL with 1 game left to play...Brooklyn can clinch the North Division crown with a win or a Jersey Shore loss on Sunday...The Cyclones can also be eliminated with a loss and a BlueClaw victory...After winning the season series (15-11), Jersey Shore holds the tiebreaker over Brooklyn.

JETT THE MET: INF **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .317/.470/.605 with a 1.075 OPS. 37 runs scored, 13 doubles, 4 triples, 9 home runs, 22 RBI, 46 walks, and 17 stolen bases in 48 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 215 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.470) or OPS (1.075)...On the season, Williams is tied for 4th in Minor League Baseball in walks (100)...**With his walk on Saturday, the former first-round pick became the 2nd teenager in MiLB to reach the century mark in free passes since the stat portal started in 2005...** Greensboro's INF **Termarr Johnson** also reached the century mark on Friday...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.452), OPS (1.033), walks (31), and extra-base hits (18)...He is also 2nd in hits (38) and slugging percentage (.581), tied for 2nd in doubles (9) and stolen bases (11), and 3rd in batting average (.306)...Among SAL players with at least 150 plate appearances in 2023, Williams leads the circuit in OBP (.452), and ranks 2nd in walk rate (19.7%), wRC+ (180), wOBA (.460), and OPS (1.033).

KING STANLEY: With his solo home run in the 3rd inning on Saturday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** tied C **Francisco Alvarez** for the Cyclones' single-season home run record with 22...He also broke a tie with Alvarez for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He and Alvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Sunday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.483), tied for 4th in home runs (22), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (41), and 8th in total bases (171)...Over his last 20 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .244/.306/.628 with a .934 OPS, adding 19 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs, and 21 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (8) in addition to being tied for the lead in triples (2).

THE GUI-EST OF HONOR: INF **Luis Guillorme** joined the Cyclones on Friday to start a Major League rehab assignment...The 28-year-old has been on the Mets' 10-day injured list since July 22 with a right calf strain...He went 0-for-3 with 3 strikeouts in 5 innings during his first contest on Friday...Guillorme has appeared in 50 games at the Major League level this year, posting a .238/.304/.347 slash line with a .651 OPS, adding a home run and 9 RBI...The left-handed swinger started the year on the Mets' Opening Day roster before being optioned to Triple-A Syracuse on May 17...He was recalled back to New York on June 9...In 331 MLB games with the Mets since 2018, Guillorme is a .263 (188-715) lifetime hitter with a .683 OPS in addition to 5 home runs and 48 RBI...The Venezuelan-born infielder appeared in 125 South Atlantic League games with Single-A Savannah in 2014 and 2015, composing a slash line of .319/.391/.354 with a .745 OPS.

TOP OF THE LADDER: With his leadoff double in the bottom of the 6th on Thursday vs. Wilmington, OF **Alex Ramírez** broke a tie with INF **José Peroza** (162) for the Cyclones' all-time hit record...He added to his record with a single on Friday and is at 164 all-time...The 20-year-old is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native also surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in walks (72) and runs scored (88), 3rd in RBI (87) behind OF **Stanley Consuegra** (89) and Peroza (91), and 3rd in total bases (242).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: Brooklyn earned its 7th walk-off victory of the 2023 season with 1B **Drake Osborn**'s 9th-inning sacrifice fly on Friday night...The triumph marked the first walk-off win for the Cyclones since RF **Omar De Los Santos** scored on a wild pitch in the 9th in a 2-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 25...The 'Clones also earned game-ending wins on June 7 vs. Greenville (DH **Kevin Parada** single), May 26 vs. Winston-Salem (1B **José Mena** single), May 2 vs. Aberdeen (LF **Omar De Los Santos** single), April 22 vs. Wilmington (LF **Alex Ramírez** single), and April 7 vs. Jersey Shore (1B **Chase Estep** walk)...Friday's win also marked Brooklyn's 28th come-from-behind victory and 13th win in their final at-bat.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: 3B **Yohandy Morales** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (13), OF **Daylen Lile** (14), OF **T.J. White** (16), RHP **Andry Lara** (19)...De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 29 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 16-13 against Wilmington, including 9-8 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 42-37 all-time against the 'Rocks.

DON'T TREAD ON US: Brooklyn's outfield has done a marvelous job neutralizing runners on the basepaths in 2023...**The Cyclones have set a franchise record for outfield assists in a single season with 41 dating back to the start of MiLB's stat portal in 2005...**The previous franchise high was 30 set back in the 2006 season...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn leads all High-A teams in outfield assists and has 6 more than the squad with the second-most (Asheville, 35)...Among all MiLB teams, the Cyclones' 41 outfield assists are tied for 7th...In addition, **Stanley Consuegra** and **Alex Ramirez** are tied for the team's single-season franchise record for individual assists with 11...That mark is tied for 2nd in the SAL this year behind Greensboro's **Sammy Siani** (12)...Before 2023, the previous single-season high for Brooklyn was 9 held by 6 different players.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 16 straight games dating back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 27 fewer games (31 to 58) and 114 fewer plate appearances (136 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Sunday ranked 2nd in the SAL in slugging percentage (.492), tied for 4th in home runs (22), 5th in OPS (.834), and tied for 6th in RBI (66)...Clifford is also 3rd in isolated power (.248) and is 8th in wOBA (.371) and wRC+ (124).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo has reached safely in 15 consecutive games and is 18-for-53 at the plate (.340) with 9 runs scored, 5 doubles, 10 RBI, and 9 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .333/.411/.449 with a .860 OPS...Lugo has also scored 11 runs, picked up 7 doubles, a triple, 16 RBI, and 10 walks in 22 games...The Dominican native is tied for 2nd in the league in doubles (7), tied for 3rd in hits (26), 8th in RBI (16), and tied for 8th in batting average (.333) in that span.

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.41 ERA (327 ER in 862.1 IP) over their last 99 games, holding a 55-44 record, which is the lowest in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 3rd most in MiLB...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.645), and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.31) and batting average against (.219)...For the entire season, Brooklyn holds the 5th-lowest ERA in MiLB (3.73).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 37 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 107 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in the opening game of the series on Tuesday night vs. Wilmington...Allowed 2 runs (1 earned) on 5 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked 4 and struck out 4... Charged with a balk and tossed a pair of wild pitches...Made 81 pitches and 46 strikes (56.8%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** with runners at the corners and 1 out in the top of the 5th and Brooklyn leading 4-2...Both bequeathed runners were stranded aboard... Hall went 3.2 innings out of the bullpen and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** recorded the final 3 outs for the save, as the Cyclones won 4-2.

VICIOUS VENTURA: Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Briam Campusano** tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018.

AIR JORDANY: Ventura joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 14...In 15 appearances (13 starts) in the Florida State League, the 23-year-old registered a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP)...Issued 50 walks and struck out 60...Has struggled in a starting role in 2023...In 13 starts, holds a 3-3 mark with a 6.70 ERA (33 ER in 44.1 IP)...Is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (1 ER in 9.2 IP) in a pair of relief outings...Tossed his first career complete game in a 5-inning loss at Palm Beach on June 16...Yielded 1 run on 3 hits over 4.0 innings.

TOP PROSPECT: Ventura is ranked as the Mets' No. 29 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball America*...The right-hander was deemed the organization's No. 19 farmhand entering 2022 and No. 20 before 2021 by *Baseball America*.

ON THE MEND: Ventura is in the midst of his first full professional season since 2019...The Dominican native missed the entire 2021 season and most of 2022 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

2022: Started the campaign on St. Lucie's 60-day injured list... Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on June 5...Tossed a pair of perfect innings on June 6 vs. the FCL Astros Orange, striking out 3...Reinstated from the IL on June 12... Made 3 starts in the Florida State League...Did not receive a decision and posted a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on June 29.
