YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 4-3. In the first inning, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run homer. **Carter Aldrete** extended the lead to 3-0 with a sac fly in the third inning. Bowie's **Silas Ardoin** hit an RBI single in the fourth. In the fifth, **Cedric Mullins** brought in a run with a groundout and **Jackson Holliday** brought in a run on a fielder's choice to tie the score, 3-3. In the top of the eighth inning, **Ardoin** gave the Baysox a 4-3 lead with an RBI single. Richmond reliever **Ben Madison** struck out five batters over 2.2 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 26-16 in their last 42 games since June 18. They went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona and have split the first two games of this series against the Baysox. Over the last 47 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.02 ERA (60 ER/179.0 IP) and have allowed 13 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.81 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 380.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 514.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.58 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE BAYSOX went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS **Jackson Holliday** (No. 1), OF **Dylan Beavers** (No. 10), 3B **Max Wagner** (No. 12), OF **Jud Fabian** (No. 15), OF **John Rhodes** (No. 17), and C **Silas Ardoin** (No. 28). **Holliday** is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in baseball.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his fifth Double-A start. He last pitched on Friday at Altoona and threw five scoreless innings, allowing two hits with four strikeouts. He has allowed two-or-less earned runs in three-of-his-four Double-A starts. Bertrand did not allow an earned run over his final two starts for the High-A Eugene Emeralds, spanning 10 innings of work. In his last five High-A starts, Bertrand went 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP). During his time with the Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (.196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander **John Means** makes a rehab start, his first live-game action since April 13, 2022. He has missed nearly 16 months after suffering an elbow injury and eventually undergoing Tommy John surgery. Means also made a rehab start against Richmond on July 9, 2021 in Bowie while working his way back from a shoulder strain. In that outing, he worked three innings and allowed four runs (two earned). Means was selected by the Orioles in the 11th round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of the West Virginia University. He first reached Double-A with the Baysox in 2016, going 4-8 with a 4.69 ERA in 18 starts. He returned to the Eastern League for the entire 2017 season, posting a 9-9 record with a 4.11 ERA. In his third season pitched for the Baysox in 2018, he made eight appearances, going 1-4 with a 4.30 ERA, before being promoted to Triple-A Norfolk and reached the majors for the first time later that year. In the majors, Means has pitched 70 games (65 starts) since his debut in 2018, going 20-24 with a 3.81 ERA. He was selected as an American League All-Star during his rookie season in 2019.

STARTING STRONG: In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. On Tuesday, **Carson Seymour** held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. **Spencer Bivens** threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start on Wednesday night. On Thursday, **Wil Jensen** allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. **John Michael Bertrand** threw five scoreless innings in his start on Friday night. **Hayden Birdsong** made his Double-A debut on Saturday and threw two scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the third. **Ryan Murphy** allowed two runs in his three innings on Sunday afternoon. To open this week's series, Seymour picked up a win, allowing one run over five innings. On Wednesday, Bivens allowed one run over 3.1 innings. Richmond starters have a 2.20 ERA (8 ER/32.2 IP) in eight games since August 2.

BERICOTO BASHING: Over his last seven games since August 2, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, a triple and three RBIs. He has multiple hits in four-of-his-last-seven games, including five hits across Sunday and Tuesday. In Tuesday's series-opener, Bericoto had a Double-A-high three hits, including a double, and drove in a run. On the season, he leads all Giants organization hitters with 18 home runs, including 16 with High-A Eugene and two with Richmond.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base 35 times in his last 14 games since July 25 (17 hits and 18 walks), hitting .378 (16-for-43) with two homers, four doubles, one triple and nine RBIs adding a .547 on-base percentage. On July 30 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored last Wednesday night against the Curve. He added two doubles and two RBIs in Sunday's game at Altoona. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer and walked twice. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 126 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 17 games since returning from the IL, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .323 (21-for-65) with two doubles, seven walks and nine RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in the last home series against the Sea Dogs. He hit .227 (5-for-22) in last week's series against the Curve but picked up three walks in the Sunday finale. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 25 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .302 (26-for-86) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .353 (6-for-17) in his last five games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs. On Sunday, he went 2-for-4 with a double and four RBIs.

LOGAN'S LIFTOFF: On Tuesday night, **Logan Wyatt** drove a three-run, go-ahead homer. It was his 12th-overall home run of the season, which is the seventh-most in the Giants minor leagues. It was also his first home run since he went deep three times in a five-game stretch from June 23-30, snapping a 26-game homerless drought. Over a 21-game stretch from July 6-August 5, Wyatt hit .156 (10-for-64) with eight walks and four RBIs. In his last two games, he is batting .273 (3-for-11) with a homer and four RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 4 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 5), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 13), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 14 - on IL), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 24) and RHP **Jose Cruz** (No. 26). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Brown (No. 5), Roupp (No. 10), Seymour (No. 14), Murphy (No. 23), Birdsong (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 26).
