LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones outlasted the Blue Rocks, 1-0, on Thursday Interest at Framer Stadium...Brooklyn produced the game's only run with 2 out rally in the 6th...CF Carson Benge doubled to left and scored on 3B Jesús Báez's single to center...RHP Nate Dohm tossed 5.0 innings of 2-hit shutout ball, earning his 1st win with the Cyclones...The 22-year-old walked 1 and struck out 6...RHP Noah Hall piggybacked off his effort and tossed 4.0 frames of scoreless 1-hit ball for his 1st professional save...He walked 3 and punched out 6, recording an immaculate inning in the 7th.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Thursday, Brooklyn holds a 2.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 12 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 11...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half... Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

THE MANAEALATOR: LHP Sean Manaea joins the Cyclones on Friday for his first Major League rehab start...The 33-year-old has been on the New York Mets' injured list since March 27 with a right oblique strain...Manaea was transferred to the 60-day II. on April 29...Manaea re-signed with the Mets on a 3-year, \$75 million deal on December 27, 2024...In 2024, the Indiana State alum posted a 12-6 record with a 3.47 ERA (70 ER in 181.2 IP), 63 walks, and 184 strikeouts... Manaea set career highs in innings (181.2) and tied career bests in wins (12) and starts (32)... The southpaw made his professional debut with the Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2014 and made 29 starts for the club between 2014 and 2015...Manaea went 8-8 with a 3.18 ERA (50 ER in 141.1 IP), 58 walks, and 168 strikeouts in those 29 starts.

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on Thursday night at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Friday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.42), tied for 5th in batting average against (194), and 6th in innings pitched (52.0).

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 4 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP) with 11 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 22 strikeouts...Santucci has also thrown 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.44), is tied for 1st in wins (3), 2nd in innings pitched (20.2), 3rd in batting average against (.153) and WHIP (0.82), and 8th in strikeouts (22).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 54 games of the 2025 season with last Friday's win over Aberdeen, clinching another series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 9 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-2 in a series of any length... Additionally, the Cyclones' 37-16 record is the franchise's best record through 53 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 36-17 mark through 53 games in 2007 is tied 2nd-best.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park last Sunday with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Thursday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...No one else in the league has more than 18 home victories (Greenville)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied for the 3rd most in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Triple-A Toledo and Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville are 1st (23)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.792) is 2nd.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Thursday, Reimer is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (47) and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (27)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (47), slugging percentage (.572), OPS (.984), extra-base hits (27), and doubles (16), and is tied for 1st in hits (57)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in batting average (.317) and total bases (103), tied for 2nd in RBI (36), 6th in on-base percentage (.412), and tied for 10th in home runs (8)... Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit. 647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (.739), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (.739), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had a 24-game on-base streak since May 3 vs. Wilmington snapped on Wednesday...During that time, Báez hit .367/.475/.544/1.019 with 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 23 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 17 walks to 11 strikeouts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.443) and RBI (27), is 2nd in batting average (.340), 3rd in OPS (.964), tied for 4th in hits (32), 8th in slugging percentage (.521), tied for 8th in total bases (49) and walks (17), and tied for 9th in runs scored (200).

vs. WILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home series, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking a 4-of-6 games in Wappingers Falls against Hudson Valley...The Blue Rocks are 13-14 at home this season...Brooklyn is 8-2 in 10 contests against Wilmington in 2025...The Blue Rocks boast 9 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Travis Sykora (1), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), RHP Andry Lara (16), LHP Jake Bennett (17), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (22), OF Sam Petersen (26), OF Brenner Cox (28)...Green is currently on the development list...Lara is on a rehab assignment and Bennett is on the injured list...In 119 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 66-53 (.555)...Brooklyn is 28-31 (.475) in 59 games at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting. 412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored. 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25...The 2024 first-round pick enters Friday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (40), 4th in batting average (.302), on-base percentage (.420), and OPS (.911), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (20) and doubles (12), tied for 5th in hits (51) and walks (33), 7th in slugging percentage (.491), and tied for 7th in total bases (83).

hits (51) and walks (33), 7th in slugging percentage (.491), and tied for 7th in total bases (83). **EWING-ING IT:** IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Friday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in stolen bases (40) and 5th in batting average (.350)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (26), is 2nd in hits (38), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 5th in runs scored (24), 6th in batting average (.322), 7th in on-base percentage (.409), and 10th in total bases (52)... Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (25)...The 2023 4th-round pick had a 33-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Sunday...During the on-base streak, Ewing hit .359/.450/.500/.950 with 27 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 triples, a home run, 18 RBI, 21 walks, and 30 stolen bases.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Friday with 126 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (135)...The 126 steals are tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads Mills (155)...Brooklyn already has 5 players with 10-or-more steals on the season...The 126 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 54 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 46 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 80 steals through 54 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate... The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 6, 2024, RHP Edwin Diaz earned the win in a Major League rehab appearance for the Cyclones, striking out 2 in a scoreless 5th inning, as Brooklyn won 13-3 vs. Aberdeen...3B Jefrey De Los Santos collected 3 hits and a solo home run in a 2 RBI night...18 Chris Suero doubled, homered, and drove in 5 in the win...Aberdeen used 2 position players to pitch in the contest televised on SNY.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America..The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

COMEBACK REPORT: Manaea will make his first Major League rehab start on Friday night...The 33-year-old did not pitch in Spring Training and was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on 3/27 (retro 3/24) with a right oblique strain...He was transferred to the Mets' 60-day injured list on 4/29...Manaea signed a 3-year, \$75 million deal with New York on 12/27/24...This came after Manaea opted out of his 2-year deal with the Mets on 11/4/24.

2024: Spent the entire season with the Mets...Collected a 12-6 record with a 3.47 ERA (70 ER in 181.2 IP), 134 hits allowed, 63 walks, and 184 strikeouts...Set a career-high in innings pitched (181.2 IP) and tied a career-high in wins (12) and starts (32)...Manaea's 184 strikeouts were the 2nd-most in his career and 9th most in the National League...Registered the lowest full-season ERA of his career (3.47)...1 of 8 pitchers who made 32 or more starts and accrued an ERA below 3.50...Held opponents to a .190 average, the 4th-lowest in MLB...From 7/1 until the end of the season, Manaea was 1st in the majors in innings (105.1), 2nd in quality starts (12), and 6th in strikeouts (108) and WHIP (0.93)...Composed a 2-1 record with a 4.74 ERA (10 ER in 19.0 IP), 8 walks, and 19 strikeouts in 4 postseason starts...1st Mets pitcher to throw 7.0 or more innings and record 10 or more strikeouts in back-to-back starts since RHP Max Scherzer (4/19 (2)-25/22)...Joined RHP Dwight Gooden (2x) and RHP Tom Seaver (3x) as the only pitchers in franchise history to post consecutive starts of 7.0 or more scoreless frames and double-digit strikeouts...7th left-handed pitcher in franchise history with 4 or more double-digit strikeout games in a season joining LHP Sid Fernandez, LHP Jerry Koosman, LHP Johan Santana, and LHP Jon Matlack...His 11 K's vs. Minnesota on 7/30 were the most in a game by a Mets' left-hander since Steven Matz struck out 11 on 9/1/18 at San Francisco and the most by a Met at Citi Field since Johan Santana vs. Miami (4/24/12)...Became the first Met since RHP Jacob deGrom (9/30/22 at Atlanta) to record 11 or more strikeouts without issuing a walk...Did not allow a hit over first 5.2 innings in his Mets debut on 4/1 vs. Detroit...Longest no-hit bid by a Mets pitcher in their team debut...Joined LHP Kenny Rogers (7/28/99) as the only Mets pitchers to allow 1 hit and throw 6.0 or more innings in their team debut...His 8 K's were tied with Johan Santana (3/31/08) for most punch outs by a Mets' left-hander in their team

MAGNIFICENT MANAEA: On April 21, 2018, Manaea threw the 12th no-hitter in Athletics franchise history when he no-hit the Boston Red Sox...He struck out 10 and walked 2 in the 3-0 victory...The no-hitter was the earliest by date (RHP **Catfish Hunter**, 5/8/68 vs. Minnesota) and 2nd earliest by game number (RHP **Chief Bender**, 5/12/10 vs. Cleveland, game 18)...It was the 10th no-hitter in Coliseum history...It was the A's first no-hitter since LHP **Dallas Braden**'s perfect game on 5/9/10 vs. Tampa Bay...3rd Oakland pitcher to strike out 10 or more in a no-hitter (RHP **Dave Stewart**, 12, and RHP **Catfish Hunter**, 11).

BACK WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: Manaea will return to the site of his professional debut on Friday...Originally a first-round pick of the Kansas City Royals in 2013, the 33-year-old started his first career game as a member of the Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2014...In 29 starts with the club between 2014 and 2015, Manaea accumulated an 8-8 record with a 3.18 ERA (50 ER in 141.1 IP), walking 58, and striking out 168...During the 2014 Carolina League season with Wilmington, the southpaw led the circuit in strikeouts (146) and ranked 3rd in batting average against (.228), 4th in ERA (3.11), tied for 5th in games started (25), and 7th in WHIP (1.28)...Friday will mark Manaea's first start at Frawley Stadium since his final outing as a member of the Blue Rocks on 7/15/15 vs. Frederick (5.0 IP, 2 H, R, 2 BB, 5 K)...On 7/28/15, he was dealt with RHP **Aaron Brooks** to the Oakland Athletics in exchange for UTL **Ben Zobrist** and cash considerations...Zobrist would go 6-for-23 (.261) at the plate against the New York Mets in Kansas City's World Series victory that October.
