#### Final Week

Reading continues its final series of the season at Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies clinched the season-series over Reading and lead it 11-3.

Reading won 3-1 last night, thanks to three runs in the sixth inning. Oliver Dunn and Jhailyn Ortiz each doubled, then Rixon Wingrove hit a goahead two-run homer to put Reading ahead. Mick Abel started and went five innings, with eight strikeouts. Cristian Hernandez tossed two-scoreless frames, then Orion Kerkering earned a six-out save to give Reading its first win of the week and even the series up at one.

#### He Dunn Gets on Base

With his double last night, Oliver Dunn extended his on-base streak to 18 games. If Dunn can reach 20 games, it will mark his second on-base streak of 20-plus games in 2023, with his other coming from May 26 to June 23 (22 games). Dunn leads the team and Eastern League in on base percentage at .404 and also leads the league in OPS at .924.

#### Abel Finishes Strong

Mick Abel tossed five-strong innings last night, striking out eight hitters. Over his final four starts this season, Abel tossed 23 innings, allowed just eight hits and three runs, with 23 strikeouts, which is good for a 1.17 ERA. Abel holds the following Eastern League ranks: T8th SO (126), 9th ERA (4.14), 1st BAA (.188) and 5th WHIP (1.24).

#### Road Success

With last night's win, Reading has guaranteed a winning record on the road in 2023, with a 35-30 record and four games to play. The R-Phils were just 23-44 at home this season. Their winning percentages are .538 on the road and .343 at home in 2023.

#### Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering earned the first six-out save of his career last night, as he struck out a season-high five hitters. He has now converted on his alst seven save oppurtunities and has not allowed a run in his last seven outings and 14 of his last 15 appearences.

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell 4-1 to the Braves last night and are off tonight. Lehigh Valley beat Rochester 10-5 as Matthew Kroon had three hits and a homer. The IronPigs remain three-games back of Durham with 10 games left to play. Jersey Shore will look to clinch its playoff series tonight at Hudson Valley after a 2-1 win at home on Tuesday. Clearwater returns home, looking to clinch a spot in the Florida State League Championship after a 5-0 win at Lakeland on Tuesday.

Joander Suarez gets the start tonight for Binghamton, his first start against Reading this season. He's making his third start for Binghamtonn, after his call up from High-A Brooklyn on Aug. 29. Suarez is 2-0 with no-earned runs allowed over 13 innings so far, with two walks and 10 strikeouts. Last Thursday, Surarez tossed a seven-inning no hitter at Hartford. He has not allowed a hit over the first 13 innings he's pitched in Double-A. Suarez made 21 appaearences/19 starts with Brooklyn this season, going 5-9 with a 5.08 ERA over 90.1 innings. This season is the most appearences for Suarez in a season, with his previous high being 11, as he had dealt with injuries. The Mets signed Suarez as an International Free Agent in 2018 out of Venezuela at 18-years old.
