LAST TIME OUT

Beloit prevailed in a pitchers duel, defeating Lake County 3-1 in 10 innings. Neither team scored until the 10th, thanks to a rock solid pitching effort from both sides. While Mason Hickman tossed 5 one-hit innings against Beloit, Pat Monteverde matched with 6 frames of shutout ball, working around 5 hits. The Sky Carp got a boost from approximately 45 of Monteverde's friends and family sitting behind home plate. After Robinson Martinez and Chandler Jozwiak got the game to extras, Beloit's bats woke up in the 10th, as Kyler Castillo poked an RBI single to get the scoring started and Dalvy Rosario provided insurance with a 2-RBI single. In the bottom half, Jozwiak allowed the automatic runner to score but shut things down from there to end the game.

FLYING HIGH

The Sky Carp have won 10 of their last 14 games. Beloit has won three straight series, and could clinch at least a split with a victory tonight. Across their last four sets, the Sky Carp own a 15-5 record. The Sky Carp are now 5 games under .500 after being 15 games under on May 20th.

EXTRA, EXTRA!

With last night's victory, Beloit is now 5-1 in extra inning contests. The Sky Carp have outscored their opponents 11-4 in extra frames this season.

MESS WITH THE BULL[PEN]. GET THE HORNS

The Sky Carp bullpen has proved to be among the best in the league, ranking second in ERA with a 3.35 mark. The 'pen has been especially good as of late, as Beloit relievers haven't allowed an earned run this series in 9.2 innings.

STUMBLING AT THE START

After back-to-back strong starts from MD Johnson and Pat Monteverde, Dax Fulton takes the ball today looking for a bounceback. In his last two starts, Fulton has allowed 10 earned runs in 8 innings. Of those 10 runs, 6 of them have come in the first three innings of the game.

OUR FEARFUL TRIP IS FAR FROM DONE

Beloit is embarking on their second two-week road trip of the season - first with 6 games at Lake County, followed by 6 in Lansing. The 456 mile trek from ABC Supply Stadium to Classic Park is the Sky Carp's longest this season. The team went 3-9 on their previous 12 game road trip, losing 5 games at Great Lakes and 4 at West Michigan.

IN THE ZONE

Beloit's 3.15 K/BB ratio leads the Midwest League. Across the last two games, Beloit hurlers have just 2 walks to 22 Ks. The Sky Carp bullpen has been especially in command - leading the league in K/BB ratio (3.94) and K/9 (11.25).

COMEBACK CARP

The Sky Carp collected another comeback win last Friday - their fourth comeback win after trailing by two runs or more in the final 3 innings since May 29. On Tuesday, Beloit scored three in the 8th inning to win 6-4. On 5/29, Beloit scored 4 in the 9th to walk-off Lansing. On 6/2, the Sky Carp scored 8 runs in the 9th to comeback from down 6 runs to defeat Quad Cities 13-11.

STILPS ESREVER

An astounding number of Beloit lefthanded hitters have posted reverse splits this season, hitting significantly better against left handed throwers than against righties. Davis Bradshaw is batting .409 vs LHP and .283 vs RHP. Cody Morissette is batting .320 against lefties and .195 against righties. Tanner Allen has posted a BA of .286 vs lefties and .195 vs righties. Victor Mesa Jr. is hitting .319 against southpaws and .228 against righties. As a team, Beloit is hitting .251 against lefthanded pitchers and .225 vs righthanders.

- Injured elbow while throwing to Lansing catcher Tyler Soderstrom in Team USA workout in 2020, leading to TJS.
- Features Low-Mid 90s fastball, with a power curveball and changeup.
- Focused on developing changeup over the offseason.
- Highest ranked pitcher on Beloit's Opening Day Roster
- Curveball is best among Marlins prospects, according to Baseball America's 'best tools'

2022 SEASON

- Allowed 3 ER on 4 hits in last outing vs WIS on 6/9. Received the loss in a 3-1 defeat.
- Has allowed 10 ER in 8 innings between last two starts.
- Collected first win of the season on 5/27 vs Lansing. Tossed 5 innings of one run ball while striking out 7.
- Struck out a tied for career-high 10 batters on 5/19 vs Peoria
