vs. the Nashville Sounds (Milwaukee Brewers). It is the 11th of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the fifth of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Nashville.

VS. NASHVILLE: The Stripers saw their two-game winning streak in Nashville snapped last night, dropping their alltime record at First Horizon Park to 5-11 (.313) and overall record vs. the Sounds to 15-24 (.385). In six series against Nashville since 2021, Gwinnett is 1-4-1. Their only series win was 6/15-21, 2021 at Coolray Field (won 3-2).

KINGS OF THE "K": The Stripers' pitching staff leads Triple-A in strikeouts with 718 in 70 games (10.26 SO per game). That's nine more than Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 709 SO in 70G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (teamrecord 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 92), Tucker Davidson (6th, 66), and Huascar Ynoa (10th, 59) all rank in the International League top 10 in strikeouts.

**MULLDOZING:** Tonight's scheduled starter Kyle Muller enters play riding a four-game quality start streak. He is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (5 ER in 26.2 IP), 1.12 WHIP, .221 BAA, and 12.15 SO/9.0 IP ratio (36 SO) during that stretch.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (92) and is among the top 10 in WHIP (4th, 1.12), ERA (5th, 3.00), BAA (5th, .221), and innings (5th, 69.0).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.21 ERA (53 ER in 148.2 IP), .222 BAA, and 185 strikeouts (11.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 29 starts.

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters went 2-for-4 with an RBI triple last night, his third multi-hit effort over his last seven games since 6/17. He's batting .345 (10-for-29, 1 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1.045 OPS) in that span. In 36 games overall, Waters is batting .264 (37-for-140, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 19 R, 14 RBI, 1 SB, .745 OPS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .250 (163-for-651, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 106 R, 62 RBI, 32 SB, .718 OPS) in 165 games.

KRAMER SAYS "GIDDY UP": Kramer Robertson enters play with an eight-game hitting streak, batting .355 (11-for-31, 2 2B, 1 HR, 8 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, .975 OPS) since 6/12. The streak is tied for the second-longest on the club this year (Phil Gosselin had 8G streak from 5/8-5/20), trailing only Chadwick Tromp's 13-game streak from 4/24-5/12. Since joining Gwinnett on 6/7, he's batting .298 (14-for-47, 3 2B, 1 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 4 SB, .826 OPS) in 12 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake is riding a season-best seven-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .385 (10-for-26, 2 2B, 1 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, .991 OPS) in that stretch. In 50 games overall on his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett, he's batting .276 (51-for-185, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 26 R, 12 RBI, 5 SB, .735 OPS).

**<u>JOLTIN' JOE DUNAND:</u>** Joe Dunand capped a near-cycle (3-for-4, 1 2B, 1 HR, 2 RBI) on Thursday with his first homer as a Striper, a 428-foot solo shot to left off RHP Alec Bettinger. In 14 games with Gwinnett, he is batting .300 (15-for-50, 3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 R, 7 RBI, .835 OPS).

**TONIGHT:** The Stripers play game five of a six-game series **ROSARIO ON REHAB:** Today, the Atlanta Braves assigned OF Eddie Rosario to rehab with Gwinnett. He is on the 10-day Injured List following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player (.560, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 1.647 OPS in 6G vs. the LA Dodgers), is set to rehab with the Stripers for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2021).

> **DESHIELDS STREAKING:** Delino DeShields Jr. saw his seven-game hitting streak and seven-game run scoring streak ended on Thursday (0-for-1, BB), but extended his on-base streak to 11 games. He's batting .414 (12-for-29, 1 2B, 1 HR, 10 R, 5 RBI, 5 SB, 10 BB, 1.113 OPS) on the streak since 6/3. Overall with Gwinnett, DeShields has reached base safely in 41 of 48 games (85.4%), batting .281 (38-for-135, 5 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 15 RBI).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-8th, 15) and walks (T-11th, 35).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel lifted an oppositefield two-run homer (#6) to right off RHP Alec Bettinger on Thursday, snapping a 1-1 tie in the seventh. Of Casteel's 15 hits this season, 10 have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers). For his Gwinnett career, 48.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (24 of 50), including nine doubles, one triple, and 14 homers.

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading fifth save on Thursday (5-for-6, T-12th in IL). Over seven June outings, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R, 0 ER in 7.1 IP), .120 BAA, and two saves (2-for-2). In 21 games overall. Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.57 FRA (6 FR in 21.0) IP), .190 BAA, and 14.57 SO/9.0 IP ratio (34 SO).

**DOMINANT NIGHT FROM DAVIDSON:** Tucker Davidson logged 6.2 scoreless IP (6 H, 0 BB, 9 SO) on Wednesday, improving to 2-3 with Gwinnett this season. It was his second scoreless start this year, first since 5/17 with Atlanta at Milwaukee (5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 SO in 3-0 win).

• IL Leaderboard: Davidson has fanned 32 batters over 26.1 IP (10.94 SO/9.0 IP ratio) over his last four starts, and now ranks sixth in the IL in strikeouts (66).

**DEMERITTE RETURNS:** Travis Demeritte is batting .147 (5for-34, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in nine games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 168 of 198 games (84.8%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (190-for-685, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .919 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

**Matt Tuiasosopo** is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.
