ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians dropped the first game of their series with the Spokane Indians (Rockies) 5-4 Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro.

Vancouver started the scoring with single runs in the first and second. Rafael Lantigua worked a lead-off walk, stole two bases then scored on an errant throw from the catcher to make it 1-0. A hit batter, a walk, a Trevor Schwewe single and a sacrifice fly off the bat of Zac Cook doubled the advantage to 2-0.

A four-run third put the Indians ahead for good. Spokane used four hits - including a double and a triple - to go up 4-2 and got help from an error to make two of those runs unearned.

The C's got lone runs in the fifth and sixth. A two-out single from Lantigua, his third stolen base of the night - which matched a C's single-game high - and an RBI single courtesy of Tanner Morris drew the Canadians within a run but Spokane got it back in the top of the sixth on three consecutive hits to start the inning. Phil Clarke - the High-A West Player of the Week for August 31-September 5 - hit his third home run in as many days and his fifth of the season in the bottom of the sixth to make it 5-4. That would be the last man to reach for Vancouver. The Tribe set down the next 11 batters to hand the Canadians a series opening loss and officially eliminate them from playoff contention.

THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE: The Canadians welcome the Indians to Ron Tonkin Field for their third visit of the year and the last of five series between the two clubs this season. These two teams last met July 27-August 1 at Avista Stadium in Spokane; that week, the C's lost four of six and were outscored 50-32. Despite those struggles, Vancouver leads the season series 14-11 and needs to win two games to take the set.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: September 8, 2005 - The C's beat Spokane 7-1 at Avista Stadium to take game one of the Northwest League Finals. Vancouver scored three in the fifth and added four in the sixth thanks to a home run from Haas Pratt and a bases-clearing double off the bat of Chad Boyd. Joey Newby earned the win with seven innings in which he allowed one run on six hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. Danielin Acevedo worked the last two frames to secure it.

RAZOR'S EDGE: The last seven C's games have been decided by three runs or less, the longest stretch of close contests for Vancouver this season.

KEEP 'EM COMIN': The C's have homered in 12 of their last 13 games and hit 15 over their last seven.

BMOC: Phil Clarke has been named the High-A West Player of the week for August 31-September 5. In five games at Everett, the Franklin, TN native went 13-for-25 (.520) with four doubles, two home runs (in consecutive games), six runs scored, seven RBI, a walk and racked up 23 total bases. He is the third C's player to win the award in the last four weeks (Sebastian Espino, August 10-15/Spencer Horwitz, August 17-22).

ON THE VERGE OF HISTORY: Spencer Horwitz has a hit in 25 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any player in the High-A West this year. Horwitz has gone 43-for-101 (.426) with 12 doubles, seven homers, 21 runs scored, 28 RBI and 19 walks. The league record is 26, set in 1962 by Gary Johnson of the Tri-City Braves amidst a season in which he hit .341 in 135 games. Coincidentally, Johnson was the scout who signed C's manager Donnie Murphy to the Kansas City Royals in 2002.

ACE OF ON BASE: Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 32 consecutive games since July 25. He's 43-for-138 (.312) with eight doubles, a triple, two home runs, 17 runs scored, 21 RBI and 14 walks. In an even greater accomplishment, he's reach in 50 of his last 52 starts.

RUN RAFA RUN: Rafael Lantigua matched a C's single-game high this year with three stolen bases in last night's game, the first time since Cameron Eden swiped three on June 29 in Everett. Lantigua now has 26 bags on the season, good enough for fourth-most in the league.

ON THE HILL: #8 Blue Jays prospect Adam Kloffenstein gets the nod for the C's. He last worked on September 2 in Everett and was superb; that night, the right-hander worked five and two-thirds with two hits and two earned runs, three walks and five strikeouts. He wrapped up August with a 2-1 record and a 5.70 ERA in 23.2 innings across five starts, walked 11, K'd 31 and held opponents to a .242 batting average. Kloffenstein, 21, is 4-0 with a 3.71 ERA in five starts against Spokane.

14th-ranked Rockies prospect Helcris Olivarez goes for the Indians. His last turn was on August 29 in Everett when he got the loss with six innings in which he gave up three runs on five hits a walk, seven strikeouts and four hit batters. Olivarez, 21, is 0-3 with a 13.08 ERA in five starts against the C's.
