- The Captains overcame an early deficit to defeat the Sky Carp 5-2 on Thursday at Classic Park.
- For the second straight game, Beloit struck first in the top of the first, as Zach Zubia belted a solo homer.
- After two scoreless innings, Sky Carp starter Cade Gibson allowed RBI singles in the third and fourth that put the Captains in front.
- Lake County scored twice in the fifth once on a Joe Donovan solo shot (his second of the series) and once on a throwing error.
- Beloit got a run back in the sixth as Joe Mack scored Zach Zubia on a ground out to make it 4-2. The Captains quickly got the run back in the bottom half on a Junior Sanguintin RBI double.
- Beloit threatened in the seventh, loading the bases with one out, but Alaska Abney induced an inning ending double play. Davis Bradshaw singled in the eighth, but he too was erased on a double play.
- The Carp went down quietly in the ninth as Tyler Thornton struck out the side swinging to end the game.

### **SECOND HALF SWINGING**

Beloit's .274 batting average in the second half is tops in the Midwest League, 12 points higher than the next closest team (Lansing, .262). Their .767 OPS ranks 3rd. Through 27 games, the team is averaging 5.6 runs per game and 10 hits per game. In the first half, the Sky Carp averaged 4 runs and 7.4 hits per game.

### **EIGHT IS GREAT**

In four of Beloit's last five wins, the team has scored 8 or more runs. In each four losses, the team has scored 2 or fewer.

## **MISSED OPPORTUNITIES**

In the Sky Carp's two losses this week, the team has gone a combined 1-11 with runners in scoring position.

### **WELL ABOVE AVERAGE**

With a 2-4 performance last night, Davis Bradshaw increased his hit streak to five games and boosted his league-leading batting average to .326. Bradshaw is also fourth in the MWL with a .392 OBP.

### **STAYING UP LATE**

In each of Beloit's last 13 wins, the team has scored at least one run in the seventh inning or later. Tanner Allen's 2-run double in the seventh inning Wednesday gave Beloit insurance in a 3-run win.

## **PLAYING LONGBALL**

With Zach Zubia's first inning homer last night, the Sky Carp have homered in four straight games. All four homers belong to different players. Beloit has homered 25 times in the second half through 27 games. In the first half, the Sky Carp went yard 38 times in 65 games.

## **NICE AND CLOSE**

17 of Beloit's first 27 games in the second half have been decided by 3 or fewer. The Sky Carp have gone 10-7 in those contests. The Sky Carp's record in games decided by three or fewer is 27-24.

### THE BIG (FIRST) THREE

The Sky Carp have allowed at least one run in the first three innings in 11 of their last 13 games. Of Beloit's 506 runs allowed this season, 39% [199] have come in the first three innings. When the Sky Carp keep the opponent scoreless through 3, they are 20-6.

# **LEFTY ON LEFTY**

Entering today's matchup with LHP Parker Messick, many of Beloit's lefthanded batters have hit well against southpaws. Tanner Allen is hitting .308 with a .924 OPS vs lefties. Davis Bradshaw boasts a .389 average and .907 OPS. The Sky Carp are hitting .240 as a team against lefties.

## HELLO, OHIO

Beloit will spend their entire 12 game road trip in the state of Ohio, marking the team's only two-week road trip of the 2023 season. The Sky Carp's 460 mile trip to Eastlake from ABC Supply Stadium marks their longest road trip by distance of the season.
