TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints bounced back with an 11-5 victory over Gwinnett on Friday. Adam Plutko threw a season-high 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on six hits. Gwinnett took a 3-0 lead in the second inning, but the Saints rallied in the bottom of the inning with a three-run triple from Anthony Prato. The Stripers took the lead again in the third inning, but Chris Williams hit the first of his two home runs in the fourth to tie the game at 4-4. The Saints took their first lead in the fifth inning on a Williams two-run single. The Saints would rattle off eight unanswered runs from the fourth to the eighth innings. Edouard Julien smacked an

RBI single in the sixth, followed by Williams' second homer of the game in the seventh, giving the Saints an 8-4 lead. Julien struck again in the eighth, clubbing his third Triple-A homer of the season. Matt Bowman allowed one run over 2.0 innings in his return to the Saints bullpen, finishing off the 11-5 victory.

WILLIAMS WARMING UP: Chris Williams delivered his seventh career Helman's five games with multiple home runs. Over his last seven games, Williams is hitting 8-for-24 (.333) with a double, five home runs and eight RBI.

SELDOM SOUTHPAW STARTERS: The Saints are getting just their sixth start from a left-handed pitcher today. Their five starts from lefties this season are tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A. Beyond that, the Saints have hardly had southpaw pitching in 2024, getting just 39.2 innings from lefties this season, the fewest in Triple-A and sixth-fewest innings among full-season minor league teams. The next-fewest innings in Triple-A are Charlotte's 83.0 innings from left-handers this season. El Paso has gotten the most innings in Triple-A from lefties, who have thrown 303.1 innings for the Chihuahuas.

NO WALKS FOR YOU!: Saints pitchers have limited walks all season long, issuing a Triple-A-best 297 walks this season. Their 2.64 strikeouts per walks is good for second in the circuit, trailing Durham's 2.69 K/BB

SINGLES NIGHT: The Saints were limited to eight singles on Thursday night, snapping a streak of 62 consecutive games with an extra-base hit, their third-longest streak in franchise history and the second-longest streak in the International League this season. The Saints did not draw a walk either, the 12th time in franchise history they did not draw a free pass. It is the first time in franchise history the Saints did not record an extra-base hit or draw a walk in a game.

RECORD WATCH: Matt Wallner is closing in on the Saints' singleseason home run record, hitting 19 long balls this season. He is tied for the second-most homers in the IL in 2024. He is currently tied for the fourth-most in a Saints' single season with Jimmy Kerrigan (2021). He trails: Brent Rooker (20, 2021), along with Jair Camargo and Chris Williams (21, 2023).

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 35 games since May 21, he has hit .383 (49-for-128), with nine home runs, drawing 27 walks to 35 strikeouts, owning a 1.115 OPS. Since June 1, Severino leads the IL in batting average (.409) and on-base percentage, sporting a .521 clip. He's second in OPS, at 1.166, ranking four in slugging percentage at .645. His 22 walks since the start of June are tied for the the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins made a late comeback, but it was not enough in a 13-12 loss to Houston. Jose Miranda went 4-for-4, getting a hit in 10 consecutive at-bats, setting a new club record. Minnesota trailed 13-5 in the ninth, scoring seven runs in the inning, getting a grand slam from Carlos Correa. Brooks Lee went 3-for-5 with a double and two RBI in the loss.
