SHOREBIRDS WIN BACK-AND-FORTH BATTLE: The Delmarva Shorebirds began the second act of their 12 game road trip with an exciting, 8-7 win over the Columbia Fireflies. After both teams scored in the first, the Shorebirds went ahead to start the second inning with a solo home run by Stiven Acevedo, making it 2-1 Delmarva. The Fireflies would respond with two runs in the bottom of the third to take a one-run lead. The night of Jake Cunningham began in the third inning as he put Delmarva back in front with a two-run single, to give the Shorebirds a 4-3 edge. The offense struck for two more runs in the fourth on an RBI double by Angel Tejada, he would score moments later on a wild pitch to give the Shorebirds their largest lead at 6-3. Columbia would answer with two runs of their own in the bottom of the fourth and then took the lead with two runs in the sixth to make it a 7-6 game entering the seventh. But that's when Jake Cunningham delivered again as he put the Shorebirds ahead with a two-run homer to make it 8-7. The Fireflies would load the bases with nobody out, but Kelvin LaRoche would pull off an incredible escape act and allow no one to school, helping Delmarva win 8-7.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan De Los Santos gets the start on Thursday night in game two of the series against the Columbia Fireflies against **Henry Williams** for the Fireflies. Williams was selected in the third round by the San Diego Padres in the 2022 draft but was dealt to the Royals at the 2023 trade deadline for RHP Scott Barlow. In three starts with the Fireflies, he's allowed just 3 earned runs in 15 innings. He made 12 starts with Lake Elsinore, the Single-A affiliate for San Diego and had a 1-5 record with a 5.74 ERA.

SPEED, I AM SPEED: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has made his presence felt since he's joined the Shorebirds as the 1st round pick from Vanderbilt has 17 steals in his 14 starts as a Shorebird. He swiped 4 bases against the Carolina Mudcats on August 13 the most by a Delmarva player in a single game this season. More impressively, Bradfield has reached base at a .532 clip so far thanks to 17 walks he's drawn in his brief Single-A tenure. Bradfield has reached base 13 of 14 games as a Shorebird.

STREAKING: Some of the latest additions to the Shorebirds have put together some impressive on-base streak, led by **Jalen Vasquez** who has reached base in all 15 games he's played in with his current streak being tied for the third longest on the team this season behind **Trendon Craig** who had separate streak of 18 and 16 games. **Tavian Josenberger** and **Matthew Etzel** are both currently riding a 9 game on-base streak.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 67 steals in the month of August, which is the most in the league. The most stolen bases they've had previously in one month is 30 and that was achieved in July.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 292. They are top five in the league doubles (180), triples (32), and home runs (83).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: The newest additions to the Delmarva bullpen have impressed as **Blake Money, Ty Weatherly, Jack Maruskin, Braxton Bragg, Teddy Sharkey,** and **Zane Barnhart** have collectively given up just 4 runs in 15 combined innings with 20 strikeouts. Bragg and Sharkey recorded six out saves in their Single-A debuts.

FINAL ROAD SERIES OF THE SEASON: The Shorebirds continue their final road trip of the season as they begin a six-game series against the Columbia Fireflies after a series split last week in Lynchburg. Delmarva faced Columbia last season just one time and split their lone series with the Kansas City Royals affiliate. The playoffs remain a long shot for the Shorebirds as they enter tonight's game with an elimination number of 5 with 12 games left to play.

TODAY'S STARTER: Juan De Los Santos gets the start in Game 2 against the Columbia Fireflies, making his 23rd appearance and 14th start of the season.

LAST OUTING (8/24 @ LYN): De Los Santos took the loss in his last start on Thursday against the Lynchburg Hillcats as he surrendered 3 runs on 4 hits in 3 innings of work. Delmarva would lose the game 4-3.

vs. COLUMBIA: This will be the first time this season De Los Santos pitches against Columbia but the second time in his career as he made a start against the Fireflies last season on May 4. In that start, De Los Santos struck out 6 across 4 innings allowing just 1 run on 2 hits. He would not factor into the decision in a 5-1 win for the Shorebirds.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

REVERSE SPLITS: Despite a tougher outing last time out, De Los Santos has enjoyed his best month of the season as he owns a 2.08 ERA in four August appearances that have covered 21.2 innings. This month features his longest start of the season, which was 5.2 innings on August 1 against Lynchburg. He also tossed 5 perfect innings
