HAPPY HOMESTAND: The Omaha Storm Chasers smacked five home runs—two from **OF Bubba Starling**, two from **INF Gabriel Cancel**, and one from **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** en route to an 8-3 win over Iowa to finish a six-game series and 12-game homestand. The Chasers took five-of-six from the I-Cubs after sweeping Indianapolis to finish the homestand with an 11-1 record.

HOME RUN HEROES: Following Sunday's 10-hit, five-homer effort, the Storm Chasers offense has recorded 13 games with 10+ hits and 12 games with 2+ home runs this season (29 games). Of Omaha's 12 multi-homer games, two have been four-homer games and three have been five-homer games, including two in the last three games. Omaha recorded at least one home run in 13 straight games from 5/16-6/1, has at least one home run in 17 of the last 18 games (with a league-best 41 home runs in that span), and currently leads Triple-A East with 52 total home runs this season. The Chasers also rank second in Triple-A East and first in Midwest Division in AVG (.270) and OPS (.831) while ranking third in the league and first in the division in steals (36).

HOME COOKIN': The Chasers' 11-1 homestand from 5/25-6/6 was the best in Werner Park history. Now 15-3 overall in games at Werner Park in 2021, Omaha averages 5.6 runs/game at home, batting .284/.352/.509 with 25 doubles and 34 home runs while posting a 3.22 team ERA. In 11 road games, Omaha is 6-5 while averaging 5.4 runs/game, batting .247/.333/.450 with 18 doubles and 18 home runs with a 5.46 team ERA on the road.

RED HOT RYAN AND RIVERA: **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** has reached safely in all eight games he's played with Omaha since being optioned on May 28, batting .323/.400/.806 with five home runs and 11 RBIs. He went 8-for-24 (.333) during the six-game series against Iowa from June 1-June 6, going 8-for-24 (.333) with five home runs, including a walk-off, two-run homer on June 1 and a 3-for-4 performance with two home runs and five RBIs on June 4. **INF Emmanuel Rivera** is batting .464 (13-for-28) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs during a six-game hitting streak from May 30-pres., including three games with at least three hits.

STAFF SUCCESS: While the Chasers' ERA sits at 4.04 for the season—9th in Triple-A East and 3rd in the Midwest Division—the team's ERA for the last two weeks (from May 25-pres.) has been the best in the league at 2.92 across 108.0 innings in the last 12 games. Relievers **LHP Gabe Speier**, **RHP Grant Gavin**, and **RHP Eddie Butler** have shined out of the bullpen, combining for a 0.99 ERA in 45.2 innings (32 appearances)—about a third of the team's relief innings—with 52 strikeouts and nine walks. Speier has not allowed a run in 13 appearances (14.2 IP) while Gavin leads relievers in innings (19.2) and strikeouts (26) in 11 appearances. Butler is slated to start Wednesday's game.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 21-8 (.724), the Omaha Storm Chasers are tied for the third-best record in all of Minor League Baseball and are one of eight teams with 20+ wins. The Bowie Baysox (Double-A, BAL), currently have the best record in Minor League Baseball at 21-7 (.750) while the Tampa Tarpons (Low-A, NYY) currently have the most wins (22-8, .733). As an organization, the Kansas City Royals minor league affiliates have the second-best record in baseball at 71-43 (.623), which includes Triple-A Omaha (21-8, 1st, AAA-E Midwest), Double-A Northwest Arkansas (13-14, 3rd, AA-C North), High-A Quad Cities (19-10, 1st, A+C West), and Low-A Columbia (18-11, 1st, A-E South).

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Carlos Hernández** makes his team-leading sixth start of the season after tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball against Iowa in his most recent start on June 3, striking out six and walking one. **Hernández** has issued just six walks against 107 batters (24.1 IP) for a 5.6% walk rate, tied for fifth-best in Triple-A East. He faced St. Paul in his season debut, allowing a career-high eight runs (six earned) on a career-high 10 hits in 4.0 innings. The right-hander was recently at Target Field, striking out a career-best six batters across 4.1 innings of relief for Kansas City against Minnesota on May 29.

FOR IOWA: **LHP Charlie Barnes** makes his sixth start of the season for St. Paul. He turned 6.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts and two walks on June 2 at Louisville after tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball with a season-best seven strikeouts on May 26 at Iowa. Barnes faced Omaha on May 5, allowing a season-high three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings.

DOPPLER RADAR: Royals No. 4 overall prospect **RHP Jackson Kowar** made his Major League debut on Monday at Los Angeles (AL), allowing four runs on three hits while walking two with zero strikeouts in 0.2 innings.
