NOTES

RETURN OF THE JETT: Mets No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 56 overall prospect **Jett Williams** was activated off the 60-day IL on Friday at Hartford and went 1-for-5 with a single on the first pitch of the game. The 20-year-old underwent wrist surgery on June 6 and missed 109 Double-A games. Williams was the Mets 2023 Minor League Player of the Year. The 14th overall pick in 2022 became the first position player drafted by the Mets out of high school to reach AA in the following year, since Gregg Jefferies in 1986.

TONG TERRIFIC: Mets No. 10 prospect RHP **Jonah Tong** was promoted to Double-A Binghamton today. The Mets' 7th-round pick in 2022 out of Georgia Premier went 5-4 with a 3.71 ERA and 110 strikeouts in 19 starts for High-A Brooklyn, leading the South Atlantic League in strikeouts since he made his High-A debut. The 21-year-old ranks seventh among full-season Minor Leaguers with 100+ innings pitched with 146 strikeouts this season. Tong is originally from Markham, Ontario, Canada, which is outside of Toronto.

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Hartford Yard Goats, 7-6, in 10 innings on Saturday at Dunkin' Park. Hartford won the series, taking four of the first five games. **Ryan Clifford** recorded the second four-hit game of his career. **Drake Osborn** and **Alex Ramirez** both recorded three-hit games. **Matt Rudick** hit a leadoff home run to start the game. **Joshua Corniello** threw two hitless and scoreless frames in relief.

CLIFFORD THE BING RED DOG: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 82 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** went 4-for-5 with an RBI double on Saturday at Hartford, which marked the second four-hit game of his career. Clifford's other four-hit game also came at Dunkin' Park against Hartford on July 4. Clifford now has 13 multi-hit games and four games with 3+ hits for Binghamton. The 21-year-old is now riding a 14-game on-base streak, slashing .340/.466/.511/.976 with 16 hits, two home runs, two doubles, seven runs batted in, six runs scored, and 10 walks in that span. Clifford ranks top 15 in the Eastern League in BB (T-7th), HR (T-8th), OPS (9th), SLG (9th), and OBP (11th). Clifford is tied for third in Minor League Baseball with 87 walks, across High-A Brooklyn (32) and Double-A Binghamton (55).

YOUNG NEVER GETS OLD: Infielder **Wyatt Young** had his 24-game on-base streak snap on Saturday, when he recorded a pinch-hit sacrifice bunt in the 10th inning at Hartford. Young's 24-game on-base streak spanned July 31 to August 30 and was the second-longest streak in the Eastern League this season. Young slashed .390/.495/.455/.949 with 30 hits, five doubles, nine RBIs, 11 runs, 17 walks, and five stolen bases over the streak. Young is hitting .331 with a .430 OBP, 44 hits, eight doubles, and 14 runs batted in over his last 44 games, since the start of July. The 24-year-old ranks T-1st in the Eastern League with a .394 OBP and sixth with a .288 batting average.

RUDY: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** belted a leadoff home run to begin Saturday's game at Hartford. It marked his sixth home run of the season. Rudick is riding a four-game hit streak, hitting .333 (5-for-15) with a 1.007 OPS, one home run, one run batted in, one run scored, and three walks in that span. Rudick ranks among the Eastern League in BB (T-5th) and 2B (T-6th).

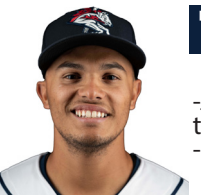
