The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are scheduled for game two of their six-game series tonight at Dell Diamond. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m. CT. Express RHP Johnny Cueto is slated to face Chihuahuas RHP Adam Mazur.

ALL EL PASO ON WEDNESDAY

The Chihuahuas barked their way to an 8-0 win over the Express on Wednesday night. A two-RBI single by LF Tirso Ornelas got the scoring started for El Paso in the top of the first inning. 3B Matthew Batten and 2B Graham Pauley scored on the play to make it a 2-0 lead for the Chihuahuas. El Paso put up a four-spot in the second inning to grow the lead to 6-0. Three consecutive doubles by Pauley, DH Oscar Mercado and Ornelas brought home the quartet of runs with Pauley plating two. Batten drew a bases loaded walk in the fifth to grow the El Paso lead to 7-0. The Chihuahuas plated another on a sacrifice fly by C Brett Sullivan to make it 8-0 and they ran away with the shutout victory.

SHIMMY TIME

Express RHP Johnny Cueto is expected to shimmy tonight at Dell Diamond. The 38-year-old is slated to make his third start of the year and has a 4.00 ERA (4 ER/9.0 IP) with zero walks and five strikeouts for the E-Train. The right-hander collected his 2,300th strikeout in his last start at Sugar Land with 1,851 coming in the Major Leagues and 459 coming in the minors.

PCL LEADERS

Express C Andrew Knapp leads the PCL in batting average (.347) while OF Sandro Fabian checks in at sixth on the list (.329). Knapp is fifth in on-base percentage (.424) while INF Jax Biggers is eighth (.407). Fabian is currently third in doubles (17), seventh in RBI (38) and ninth in slugging (.555).

FABIAN STILL FEELING IT

OF Sandro Fabian went 3-for-4 with two doubles yesterday. It was his 19th multi-hit game and his fourth three-hit game of the season. He is 5-for-9 with two doubles, a home run, an RBI and a run scored in the first two games of the series. He set a career-high with 78 RBI last season and is nearly halfway there with 38 in just 45 games. He is also seven home runs away from 100 for his career with 33 coming for the E-Train.

OFFENSE AS OF LATE

Round Rock was shut out for the second time in the last three games after they had not been shut out for the first 49 games of the season. In the last nine games, Round Rock is averaging 3.0 runs per game and they are slashing .220/.299/.321. The 27 runs scored are the least in the last nine games among PCL clubs with Reno as the next lowest at 45. They have hit just seven home runs over the past nine games with three coming in the series opener on Tuesday night against El Paso.

CHIHUAHUAS QUIET E-TRAIN

El Paso collected their first shutout of the season yesterday and their first since September 17, 2022 which also came against Round Rock. OF Sandro Fabian and INF Davis Wendzel were the only two Express players in the lineup for both games.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

With 22 games remaining in the first half of the season, Round Rock is 5.5 games back of first-place Sugar Land in the overall standings. The winner of the first half gets home field advantage in the PCL Championship Series.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

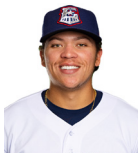
