### WICHITA DOWNS FRISCO 4-1, EVENS SERIES AT A GAME APIECE:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Wichita Wind Surge 4-1 on Saturday evening from Riverfront Stadium. Frisco (12-8, 56-33) started the scoring against Wichita (6-14, 37-52) starter Andrew Morris (5-2) when **Abimelec Ortiz** plated **Alejandro Osuna** with a groundout to give the Riders an early 1-0 lead in the top of the first. The Wind Surge evened the score at 1-1 in the bottom of the first inning against **Emiliano Teodo** (5-3) on a fielder's choice back to the mound that allowed Jake Rucker to cross the plate. Wichita took the lead in the bottom of the third inning with a two-run double by Andrew Cossetti, giving the Wind Surge a 3-1 advantage and forcing Teodo to throw 32 pitches in the frame. Teodo took the hill in the fourth, but issued a leadoff walk which led to him being pulled after 3.0 innings. The righty allowed three runs (one earned) on two hits and four walks with two strikeouts. The RoughRiders got a combined 4.0 scoreless innings from **Reid Birlingmair** and **Andy Rodriguez** with three strikeouts. In the bottom of the eighth inning **Bryan Chi** issued a leadoff walk to Tanner Schobel who later scored on an RBI fielder's choice by Ben Ross to extend the Wind Surge lead to 4-1. Offensively, the Riders out-hit Wichita four to three but were unable to score after the opening frame.

### THANK YOU, KELLEN:

On Saturday, **Kellen Strahm** was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock after spending the last two and a half years in Frisco. The outfielder finished his RoughRiders career ninth in franchise history in games played (294), ninth in hits (279), second in runs scored (197), T-10th in 2B (44) and second in walks (174). Over his time with Frisco, he slashed .265/.371/.373/.744.

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 31-13 at Riders Field this season. Their 31 wins and .705 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +71 run differential, a 3.70 ERA and is averaging 5.7 runs per game with a .749 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-20 with a 3.44 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .634 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .340/.388/.573/.961 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .340 batting average is the best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium.

### OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

**Alejandro Osuna** has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 15 games, he is hitting .317 (19-for-60)/.388/.583/.971 with six doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBIs. Over his last 12 games, he is batting .340 (16-for-47)/.426/.638/1.064 with four doubles, two triples, two home runs and 11 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .417 (5-for-12) with three doubles and a 1.200 OPS for the Riders.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 12 games, he is hitting .298 (14-for-47)/.358/.447/.805 with four doubles, a home run, 10 RBIs and four runs scored. This season, he has a career high in average (.276), slugging percentage (.455) and OPS (.786) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (72) and home runs (17).

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.05 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. In that series against Northwest Arkansas, Frisco had a bullpen 4.99 ERA while their 4.07 ERA out of the bullpen in July is their highest out of a single month all season.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

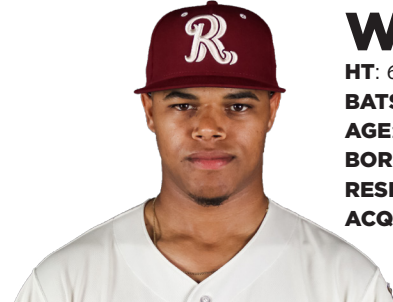

### ABOUT WINSTON

- Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.
- Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.
- Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.

### 2024 SEASON

- After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.
- Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.
- After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.
- Poured in best Double-A start in second outing against Arkansas, allowing one unearned run over five innings with seven strikeouts in a win.

- 3.38 SO/BB figure was 2nd-best in TEX org. (3.84-Jose Corniell) and 9th-best in SAL (min. 75.0 IP).
- Placed on the 7-day I.L. on 5/10 with hamstring tightness; activated 5/16.
