Minor League Totals **LAST OUTING:** Rodriguez pitched in his second relief outing this season at Jacksonville on June $\breve{29}.$ He allowed five earned runs across 4.0 innings and was charged with the loss.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's third career appearance against Memphis. He picked up the loss on April 12 and again on May 30. In his first outing, he allowed six earned runs in 5.1 innings. In his second outing, he allowed two earned runs in a season-high 6.2 innings.
