RHP Bradley Blalock (1-3, 9.38) vs. RHP Miguel Ullola (5-4, 3.83)

TODAY'S GAME: The Space Cowboys hold a 1-0 series lead after a 6-4 come-from-behind victory last night ... Bradley Blalock is expected to start for Albuquerque while Miguel Ullola is slated to take the hill for the Space Cowboys.

NOW THAT'S QUALITY: Last night, Gabriel Hughes posted the 10th quality start of the season for Albuquerque (last: Mason Albright, Aug. 8 at Round Rock) ... It was also the ninth time an Isotopes hurler lasted at least 5.0 innings while giving up one run or fewer (last: Anthony Molina, July 29 vs. Sacramento – 5.1 scoreless frames).

-Additionally, Hughes' outing marked the sixth occurrence an Albuquerque pitcher worked a minimum of 5.0 innings with three or fewer hits relented (last: Andrew Quezada, June 1 vs. Sugar Land – 5.0 frames of three-hit ball with a career-high 11 strikeouts).

OPPOSING STARTER: Luis Garcia delivered the 20th quality start of the year by an opponent last night, after Mitch Spence accomplished the feat on Sunday for Las Vegas. It is the second instance of it happening in back-to-back contests (also: Shaun Anderson and Chase Silseth, May 2-3 vs. Salt Lake).

-Tuesday was the second time in 2025 both starting pitchers in an Isotopes game recorded a quality start (also: May 3 vs. Salt, Carson Palmquist (Albuquerque) and Chase Silseth (Salt Lake).

AGAINST SUGAR LAND: Tuesday was the second time in 2025 Sugar Land defeated Albuquerque in their final at-bat, also scoring two runs in the eighth inning for a 6-5 victory on April 8.

-The Isotopes have dropped 75 of their last 102 games on the road against Houston's affiliate (OKC, Fresno, Sugar Land) dating back to April 2012. Additionally, in 20 series against the Space Cowboys (home and road), Albuquerque has won the opening game just six times.

SWIPES: The Isotopes stole three bases last night, their 16th time with at least a trio, and 10 of the instances have come since Ward's promotion from Double-A on July 1.

-Since July 1 (46 games, Braiden Ward's promotion to Albuquerque), the Isotopes have stolen 69 bags, tied for seventhmost in Triple-A and third-most in the PCL after swiping just 56 bags in their first 80 contests.

XBH: The Isotopes held their opponent to one extra-base hit for the 16th time this season. Four of the occurrences have come at Constellation Field (also: April 8-10).

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson doubled twice yesterday, the fourth time this year with multiple two-baggers (last: June 15 vs. Oklahoma City) ... His 14 dingers on the year ties a career-high set in 2023 with Spokane (7) and Hartford (7).

-Extended his on-base streak to 18 games, slashing .411/.529/.732 with four doubles, one triple, four homers, 11 walks and 12 RBI.

Over his last 72 games, is slashing .338/.433/.598 with 19 doubles, seven triples, 12 homers and 46 RBI, increasing batting average from .178 to .292.

-In the PCL, is 2nd in triples (8), 4th in XBH (46), 7th in OPS (.901) T-9th in runs (69) and 10th in slugging (.512), total bases (191) and OBP (.389).

-Needs one double, two triples, one homer and one stolen base over the final 23 games to tally 25+ doubles, 10+ triples, 15+ home runs and 10+ steals for the campaign, only accomplished by seven Triple-A players since 2005. Sam Hilliard is three doubles and one long ball away from joining the list.

SPEEDSTER: Braiden Ward connected on just his second home run of the season last night (other: June 12 vs. Akron) in 263 at-bats between the Yard Goats and Isotopes.

-Has 23 steals with the Isotopes, the most in the PCL since July 1 (second-most in Triple-A). Has 196 swipes since the beginning of 2022, third-most in MiLB during span (Chandler Simpson, 225 and Jonatan Clase, 200).

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia went 0-for-3 with a walk yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 14 games, slashing .396/.492/.717 with three doubles, a triple, four homers, 13 RBI and 10 walks.

CRIM DE LA CRIM: Blaine Crim belted his second homer with Albuquerque yesterday (20th of the season), a three-run shot ... First game with at least three RBI since June 25 vs. Tacoma, four... Over last nine games, is slashing .387/.524/.548 with 12 hits, two doubles, one home, six RBI and nine walks after going 2-for-22 in his first six games with the club.

-Is one of two players to tally 20+ homers in the Minor Leagues in every season since 2021 (also: Ryan Ward, Oklahoma City).

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard leads PCL in Triples (11) and 3rd in XBH (47) ... Tied for third in all of MiLB in triples ... Second player in Isotopes history with at least 22 doubles, 11 triples, 14 homers and 11 stolen bases (other: Nick Buss, 2013).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
