RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (15-10) Visalia Rawhide (11-15)





RHP Payton Martin (0-0, 0.00 ERA) vs. RHP Casey Anderson (0-2, 13.50 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes continue a 12-game road trip with game one of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ) at Valley Strong Ballpark. At the completion of this six-game set, the Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 14, hosting the Inland Empire 66ers.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the first of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the first of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. **LAST GAME:** The Quakes split a double-header on Sunday in Modesto, winning game one by a final of 4-0, before dropping game two by a score of 15-4. Game one saw Garrett McDaniels, new-comer Robinson Ortiz (1-0) and Cam Day combine on a two-hit shutout over seven innings. Rancho only mustered three hits in the victory, but that turned out to be enough against Modesto starter Ashton Izzi (1-1). Game two saw Rancho starter Carlos Duran (0-2) struggle in the first inning, as the Nuts erased an early 2-0 deficit, scoring seven times in the first to take the lead for good. Modesto reliever Jack White (2-0) tossed two scoreless frames in the win. Jordan Thompson doubled and homered to lead the Rancho offense. The Quakes dropped five of six in the series overall.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a pair of moves earlier today, as 3B Jake Gelof was promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. Gelof was spectacular to start the year, leading the team in several offensive categories. Taking his spot on the roster will be infielder Oswaldo Ozorio, who opened the year on the Rancho roster, but was sent to Arizona just a few days into the season. On Sunday, the Quakes sent left-handed reliever Felix Cabrera to Arizona. Taking his spot on the roster was left-handed reliever Robinson Ortiz, who joined the team from Arizona. Ortiz got the win on Sunday in Modesto, but prior to that, had not pitched in a live game since 2021, when he played for High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League.

LOSING STREAK ENDS AND POTENTIALLY BEGINS: The Quakes snapped their longest losing streak of the year, ending a four-game skid with Sunday's game-one win over Modesto. The game two loss will hopefully not be the start of Rancho's next losing streak, as they dropped their first six game series of the year by losing five of six. It's only the second series they've lost this year, after dropping two of three at Lake Elsinore to open the season. Despite the tough stretch in Modesto, the Quakes are still four games up on the now second-place Lake Elsinore Storm, after they dropped four of six in San Jose. Visalia is still 4.5 games back, after losing five of six in Stockton.

PAYTON MARTIN: Right-hander Payton Martin makes his second appearance of 2024 and first against Visalia, as he starts for the Quakes today. In his first outing, he allowed just one unearned run on one hit over 2.2 innings in a no-decision at Modesto on May 1. Martin made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Quakes in 2023, going 2-1 with a 2.04 ERA over 39.2 innings, before being shut down with an arm injury in mid-July. Martin was a 17th-round selection by the Dodgers in the 2022 draft, out of West Forsyth High School in Clemmons, North Carolina. Martin is the tenth ranked prospect in the Dodgers' minor league system by mlbpipeline.com.

CASEY ANDERSON: Right-hander Casey Anderson will make his fourth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last start overall, he allowed five runs (four earned) on seven hits over just 2.2 innings in a loss at Stockton on April 30. Anderson was drafted by Arizona in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of Utah Valley University. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2024 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
