

DOMinant Hamel: Rumble Ponies right-hander **Dom Hamel** had a career night in Reading on Wednesday night. Hamel struck out a career-high-tying 11 hitters over a career-high-tying seven innings. He set a new Double-A career high with seven innings pitched. The 24-year-old allowed just one run on three hits and two walks, while retiring 13 batters in a row from the final out of the first inning to the end of the fifth inning.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies won the conclusion of Tuesday's suspended game over the Reading Fightin Phils 5-3 on Wednesday evening. Agustin Ruiz tied the game in the seventh with a solo home run, Wyatt Young hit a game-tying RBI single in the eighth and Rowdey Jordan hit a go-ahead three-run home run in the eighth. Dom Hamel was electric in the regularly scheduled game, but the Ponies fell 2-1 in extras.

Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan crushed a go-ahead three-run homer the opposite way in the eighth inning of the series opener at Reading. In eight games at FirstEnergy Stadium, Jordan is hitting .321 (nine hits) with five home runs, 11 RBIs, 10 runs scored, and six walks. He holds a .457 OBP, .893 SLG, and 1.350 OPS at Reading this season.

Ruiz Rampage: Outfielder **Agustin Ruiz** has come up with several clutch home runs over the past two series. He hit a game-tying home run in the seventh inning of the series opener in Reading. The 23-year-old slugger hit a go-ahead home run against Erie on Sunday and crushed a game-tying three-run homer against Erie last Tuesday. Ruiz now leads the team with 12 home runs. He hit 21 home runs in the 2021 season across High-A and Double-A in the San Diego Padres organization.

Last Start: Stuart tossed a Double-A career-high seven innings on Friday against Erie at home. He was not strikeout dependent but was equally as effective allowing just two runs on eight hits.

Stuart has allowed two runs or fewer in all 16 starts this year, and in both of his Double-A starts. He leads all of MiLB with a 1.62 ERA.

2022: Stuart was drafted by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Southern Miss. Stuart made three total appearances and two starts across the Florida Complex League and Low-A St. Lucie after being drafted.

BACKGROUND: Stuart did not pitch for the first two seasons at Southern Miss, redshirting in 2019 and not seeing action in the shortened 2020 season. He was primarily a reliever, making 35 appearances and four starts across 2021 and 2022. As a redshirt junior in 2022, Stuart pitched to a 4-0 record in 22 appearances and four starts, while holding a 3.38 ERA. He tossed 1.2 scoreless innings against LSU in the Hattiesburg Regional last season, across two outings for the regional champions. Stuart was a three-sport standout in high school in baseball, football, and basketball. He broke Herscher High School's all-time receiving record in football with 2,064 yards, including a 793yard and 10-touchdown senior campaign. Was second on the team in scoring, while leading the team in rebounds and assists as a senior in basketball. He was First Team All-State and a Collegiate Baseball Second Team All-American to end his three-year varsity baseball career.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization.
