Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener of a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lansing is coming off a 5-7 homestand, splitting a six-game series with Dayton and dropping four of six games to South Bend. The Nuts are 2-4 against Great Lakes this season, losing their first home series of the year during the second week of April.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa handle the Nuts' call via StreamGuys, while Brad Tunney and John Vicari have the call on MiLB TV. It's a great day to be an Ithaca Bomber.

Last Game, Sunday: Locos 8, Cubs 7. Lansing scored four runs in the third inning (an Euribiel Ángeles grand slam) and four more runs in the fourth, then held on to beat the Cubs in a Cinco de Mayo Fiesta Locos at Jackson Field.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Loons through Sunday, returning home Tuesday, May 14th, for a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

Lug•Notes

Major League Nut: 2021-22 Lansing Lugnuts infielder **Brett Harris** notched his first two Major League hits on May 4 in his second career MLB game – and they were both home runs in a 20-3 Oakland A's victory over the Miami Marlins. Harris, the 186th Lugnut all-time to reach the Majors, joins **Max Schuemann** as Lugs to make their MLB debut in 2024; Schuemann also homered for his first big league hit.

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 1-for-4 with an RBI single and a walk Sunday; he has reached base in 24 of 25 games and ranks 4th in the Midwest League in batting average (.353), tied for 1st in triples (3), 3rd in walks (25), 2nd in OBP (.496), 5th in slugging (.565), 2nd in OPS (1.061), tied for 3rd in RBIs (21) and 6th in hits (30).

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 21 walks place him 5th in the league; **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 3rd in runs scored (22); and **Henry Bolte** is tied for 4th in stolen bases (11).

Team Effort...: The Nuts lead the league with 11 triples and 134 walks. Lansing is also tied for 3rd with Great Lakes with 50 doubles and tied for 2nd with 345 total bases, ranking 2nd with a .356 team OBP and 3rd with a .740 team OPS.

...Away From Home: The Lansing offense ranks 2nd behind Great Lakes in road batting average (.269 - .263), road slugging pct (.448 - .426) and road OPS (.814 - .779). Lansing has nine home runs in nine games on the road, compared to six home runs in 18 games at home.

A Grand Start: On April 3, Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and made his 2024 Midwest League debut last night; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

2024 vs. Great Lakes

The Lugnuts are 150-151 all-time vs. the Great Lakes Loons, 85-76 in Lansing and 65-74 in Midland. The Nuts went 12-9 vs. Great Lakes last year, including a 7-5 record at home.

2009: When Henderson Álvarez was on the mound, magical things had a way of happening. On this day, the 19-year-old fired a nine-inning complete game against Peoria in two hours and one minute, allowing four hits, one walk, one run, and one strikeout in a Lugnuts 4-1 victory.

2015: The Lugnuts collected seven doubles and one triple – The Great Balbino Fuenmayor had two doubles and one triple by himself – in a 9-4 victory at Fort Wayne. No. 9 hitter Chris Hopkins led a 16-hit attack by going 4-for-5 with a steal. Chad Jenkins tossed seven innings, allowing only Nate Freiman's two-run homer in the 4th.

Minor League Path: Signed at age 18 in 2019 and immediately began his professional career that season with the Dominican Summer League A's... following the pandemic, opened in the 2021 Arizona Complex League before receiving three appearances with Stockton... received emergency start in Midland in 2022, allowing six runs in 1 1/3 innings... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, leading Stockton in starts (18), innings (109 2/3), hits allowed (107), runs allowed (73) and walks (53)... limited RHH to .208 avg./.663 OPS compared to .295/.843 for LHH.... CS/ATT: 6/11... was far better in 2023 as a starter (4.14 ERA, .239 avg. in 91 1/3 IP) than as a reliever (10.80 ERA, .300 avg., 18 1/3 IP)

Twice Honored: Named the California League Pitcher of the Week on May 29-June 4 after tossing 7-inning, 1-hit gem vs. Modesto... named Pitcher of the Week again June 12-18 after tossing 7-inning, 2-hit gem at Lake Elsinore... from June 4-18, fired three consecutive seven-inning quality starts, allowing one total run on eight hits, seven walks, with 17 strikeouts.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... 45-pitch limit today.

Good Company: Shares March 3 birthday with Alexander Graham Bell (1847), Jackie Joyner-Kersee (1962), Herschel Walker (1962), Tone Loc (1966), Jessica Biel (1982), Camila Cabello (1997) and Jayson Tatum (1998).

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.
