WEDNESDAY: The Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 5-1 on Friday night at Hadlock Field. Ponies starter RHP Justin Lasko allowed three runs, two earned, over four and two thirds innings in the loss. Binghamton committed three errors, with two of them coming on the same play in the fourth inning which allowed the go-ahead runs to score. Carlos Rincon accounted for the Ponies lone run, a solo homer in the fourth. The Sea Dogs have taken two of the first three games in the series.

GORDON'S GREAT!: Tonight's Gm. 1 starter Cole Gordon has allowed two hits over his last three starts (going at least five innings in all three). Over that span, he has walked three, struck out 28, with hitters hitting .038 against him. On Aug. 6 vs. Portland, Gordon went a career-high 7 scoreless innings allowing just one hit with a career-high 10 strikeouts.

BUTTO MILB PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Tonights Gm. 2 starter RHP Jose Butto is the reigning MiLB pitcher of the week (Aug 9-15). Gm 1 starter Cole Gordon won it the week prior!(Aug 2-9). Butto has pitched six scoreless frames in each of his last three starts, walking just two batters and striking out 20 over that span, with hitters batting .133 against him.

RINCON ROCKS: OF Carlos Rincon hit his 7th home run of the year with the Ponies Friday night. He now has 19 HR combined between Tulsa (AA Dodgers) and Binghamton this season.

DOUBLEHEADER: The Ponies and Sea Dogs are playing their second doubleheader of the year against each other tonight. The two teams split a twin bill at Mirabito Stadium on August 4, with Portland winning Game 1 5-2, and Binghamton taking Game 2 8-2. The Ponies are 4-4 in doubleheaders this year.

JAKE THE RAKE: Ponies CF Jake Mangum had the night off Friday but went went 1-5 on Wednesday to extend his on base streak to 20 straight games. The outfielder is hitting .425 with a .476 OBP and 20 runs scored during this stretch. He also had an 11-game hit streak and 8 multi-hit games during the on-base streak.

CAN'T CONTAIN CASAS: Portland 1B Tristian Casas is 6-11 (.545) over the first three games of the series with three doubles, three RBI, and two walks. Casas is hitting .310 in eight games against the Ponies this year. Casas was the Red Sox 2018 1st round pick (26th overall) out of American Heritage in Plantation, Florida and was high school teammates with Ponies 3B Mark Vientos.

COMING UP: The Rumble Ponies conclude their 6-game series in Portland with a Sunday matinee, with first pitch at 1:00 before heading to New Hampshire for 6 games starting Tuesday evening. They return home on Monday August 31 to begin a six-game series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels.
