**ZIMM GAME:** LHP Bruce Zimmermann will make his 11th appearance of the season (6th GS) as he looks to help the Sounds even the series against Indianapolis after the off day on Tuesday. Through his 10 games, he carries a 2-3 record a 5.98 ERA. The southpaw is coming off his last two games where he has allowed 17 hits, 12 ER, and four HR in 9.2 IP. Wednesday night will be his first career appearance against the Indians. Nashville is 2-3 in Zimmermann's five starts this season and 4-6 overall in games that he has appeared in.

**ONE AWAY:** Monday's series opener was the fifth Nashville loss this year in a one-run game. The team is 5-5 in one-run decisions (2-4 on the road).

**BEST IN THE MIZ:** Right-hander Jacob Misiorowski tallied eight strikeouts on Monday night to re-take the Triple-A lead over Durham's Ian Seymour. The Brewers' top-rated pitching prospect has 71 strikeouts on the season through his first 11 games (10 GS) and 56.1 IP. Despite seeing his ERA rise to 1.60 after allowing the one earned run over his four innings on Monday, Misiorowski still owns the top ERA in Triple-A. Carlos Rodriguez (1.99) has the forth-best ERA among qualified pitchers in Triple-A this season and is scheduled to start for the Sounds on Thursday coming off his first MLB win against the Pittsburgh Pirates last Thursday. Nashville is the only team with two pitchers in the top five in ERA.

**STILL ON A HEATER:** Anthony Seigler is the first Nashville player to have a 15-game hitting streak since Keston Huiru had one from August 11-31, 2023. Seigler owns the longest active hitting streak in the International League. After last Saturday's game & since starting his streak on May 2nd, Seigler is hitting .404 (21-for-52) with three home runs, three doubles, 11 RBIs, 10 walks, and 10 runs scored. He ranked fourth among full-season minor leaguers with his 1.212 OPS, sixth in SLG (.712), and tied for sixth with his .500 OBP during the streak that has seen him reach base in a team-high 21 straight games. His OBP is tops in Triple-A during the span while his OPS and AVG are second-best; third in SLG.

**STREAKY GOOD:** Bobby Dalbec (4 G) and Oliver Dunn (4 G) each collected a hit on Monday night to extend their current hitting streaks. After having his 20-game streak in Triple-A without an earned run allowed (13 G in 2025) snapped his last appearance, Brewers' no. 18-rated prospect Craig Yoho looks to begin a new streak after working another scoreless appearance on Monday. Yoho owns a career 0.87 ERA through 28 Triple-A appearances and has allowed 18 hits and three earned runs over 31.0 IP with Nashville since a late-season promotion in 2024. He has 38 strikeouts and 16 walks and holding opponents to a .167 BAA to start his Triple-A career.

**FOUR MORA THEM HITS:** Freddy Zamora tied his career-high with his four-hit game on last Saturday night and it was his first career four-hit game in Triple-A. He set his career-high with four hits on August 14, 2021, while playing with Low-A Carolina in his first season. Since April 19th, Zamora is hitting .400 (24-for-60) with a home run, five doubles, 10 RBI, 12 runs, and carries a 1.004 OPS over a 19-game stretch.

**SUPER FOOD:** Nick Kahle continued his hot stretch at the plate with his first home run of the season and his first career home run at First Horizon Park with a two-run blast to left field in the second inning on Saturday night. It was his first home run since July 21, 2024, with Double-A Biloxi. His last Triple-A home run came on May 12, 2024, on the road in Durham. He made it consecutive multi-hit and multi-RBI games after finishing the night 2-for-4 with three RBI. He hit .500 (4-for-8) last series with the home run, six RBI, two walks, two runs, and a strikeout. He has a hit in four of his last five games after not having a hit in his first five games of the season. Saturday night's home run was the 20th of his minor league career.

**TOP DOWN:** Saturday night was the first time this season all nine of the Nashville starters had a hit in the same game. Adam Hall was the last to record a hit but did so with his third triple of the year - second of the series - in the bottom of the seventh and tied Anthony Seigler for the team-lead in triples. Nashville finished with 15 hits and it was the second-highest hit production of the year and fourth 14+ hit game of the season. The team set the season-high with 16 hits on April 20th in Charlotte.
