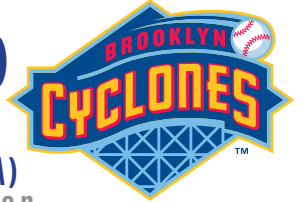

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones snapped their season-high-tying five-game losing streak on Friday against the Renegades, winning, 4-3, in eight innings... The game was delayed by two hours due to rain and shortened to a seven-inning contest with a 9 p.m. start time...Hudson Valley carried a 3-0 lead into the sixth inning before a LF **Chris Suero** sacrifice fly in the sixth and a two-run double from 3B **Mateo Gil** in the seventh tied it...The Cyclones took the lead for good in extras, scoring in the eighth on a 1B **Nick Lorusso** fielder's choice... RHP **Jake Stevenson** stranded the bases loaded in the eighth, striking out CF **Cole Gabrielson** for the final out of his first save since 2022...RHP **Victor Castañeda** struck out a season-high five over 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, earning his fourth win...The 2-hour and 37-minute contest was Brooklyn's longest seven-inning game of the year.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra had a 12-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday, but has a hit in 19 of his last 23 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .305/.420/.610 with a 1.030 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 13 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 59 points (.171 to .230) and his OPS by 226 points (.519 to .745) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (13), tied for fourth in home runs (6), and fifth in slugging (.610) and OPS (1.030)...Consuegra set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (39) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (180) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), RBI (119), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

**MARVELOUS MORABITO:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (30), tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.456), and 12th in batting average (.342)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (19) with Aberdeen OF **Matthew Etzel**, tied for sixth in hits (37), tied for seventh in runs scored (25), and 10th in on-base percentage (.404).

**CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED:** RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones on Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

**JUNIOR MINTS:** INF **Junior Tilién** enters play with the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 22 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .284/.378/.420 slash line with a .798 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, and 13 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilién also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

**SUERO SUAVE:** C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 19 of 20 games, hitting .294/.442/.485 with a .927 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 19 runs with a double, four home runs, 16 RBI, and 17 walks...

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley possesses four of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)... The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 145-149 (.493).

Since that date, Suero is tied for third in the SAL in walks (17), sixth in runs scored (19), and seventh in on-base percentage (.442).

**JOLTIN' JEFREY:** IF/OF **Jefrey De Los Santos** has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old had a seven-game hitting streak since the beginning of June snapped on Wednesday...He has also tallied multiple knocks in six of his last 11 games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting .349/.417/.721 with a 1.138 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, and five walks...Since the start of June, De Los Santos is second in the circuit in slugging (.714), tied for second in triples (2), third in OPS (1.150), ninth in batting average (.371), tied for ninth in extra-base hits (6), and 10th in on-base percentage (.436).

**FETTUCINE WILFREDO:** INF **Wilfredo Lara** has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 22 games and tallied a .301/.422/.466 line with a .888 OPS...Lara has scored 17 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, 13 walks, and four stolen bases...Lara is also had a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley snapped on Wednesday...He hit .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen... The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**THE CENTURY MARK:** RHP **Michel Otañez** became the 100th player in Brooklyn Cyclones history to make the trip from Coney Island to the Major Leagues, making his Major League debut for the Oakland Athletics on Monday night... The 26-year-old threw 0.2 scoreless innings in San Diego allowing a hit and a walk...Otañez made seven starts for Brooklyn in the 2019 season and 35 relief appearances during the 2021 campaign...In 42 appearances (seven starts), the right-hander held a 5-2 record with a 4.20 ERA (33 ER in 70.2 IP), one save, 58 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Otañez is the second former Cyclone to make his Major League debut in 2024...RHP **Christian Scott** (2022-23) was the first to do so for the New York Mets on May 4.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 59 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.43 ERA (26 ER in 96.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 84.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)... Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his first South Atlantic League defeat, and fourth of the year, last Saturday vs. Aberdeen...Permitted a career-high seven runs on a career-high nine hits in 4.0+ innings...Walked two and struck out four...Plunked a batter and was charged with a balk...Issued a solo home run to RF **Mac Horvath** in the top of the first...Threw 75 pitches and 50 strikes (66.67%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** with runners at second and third and nobody out in the top of the fifth and Aberdeen leading, 5-1... Both bequeathed runners scored...IronBirds went on to defeat the Cyclones, 14-6.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

**2024:** Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shut-out innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

**2023:** Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17... Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
