TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue their longest road trip of the season on Thursday night with game three of a six-game series in Birmingham. The road trip will include 12 games: six against the Barons at Regions Field, April 16-21, and six against the Montgomery Biscuits, April 23-28. 2023 Southern League Postseason All-Star LHP Luis De Avila makes his third start of the year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Ian Mejia logged his second-straight quality start, striking out a career-high nine batters over 6.0 innings of one-run baseball in a 5-3 win in Birmingham on Wednesday night. The victory snapped a four-game losing streak and was the first road win of the year. Justin Dean hit his first home run of the season and went 1-for-3 with two RBI. Nacho Alvarez Jr. was 2-for-4 with an RBI and stolen base, and Yolbert Sanchez was 2-for-4 with the game-winning two-run double in Wednesday's sixth inning. Mississippi was 3-for-4 in stolen base chances. Birmingham grabbed two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning after a 19-minute rain delay, but Jorge Juan got the final out to earn his first save.

FINAL TRIP TO BIRMINGHAM: This week's six-game road series marks the Mississippi Braves' final trip to Birmingham. Since 2005, the M-Braves are 135-122 against the White Sox affiliate, including 62-66 in Hoover or Birmingham. The Barons moved from Hoover to downtown Birmingham in 2013.

NEED FOR SPEED: The M-Braves lead all of Double-A baseball with 29 stolen bases (29/32) through 11 games. Midland and Hartford are second with 25. Justin Dean and Cody Milligan are T-2nd with eight each. Mississippi had 157 (1.1 per game) stolen bases last season and is on pace for 359 (2.6 per game) in 2024.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Justin Dean ranks among the league leaders in stolen bases (T-2nd, 8), batting average (4th, .346), runs (T-5th, 7), OPS (6th, .938), and OBP (T-6th, .438). Dean has also reached in eight of his nine games. Nacho Alvarez Jr. ranks among the circuit leaders in walks (T-1st, 9), hits (T-2nd, 13), batting average (5th, .325), OBP (5th, .449), and steals (6th, 5).

THERE'S JUST SOMETHING ABOUT THE NAME NIEKRO: JJ Niekro, the son of Joe Niekro and nephew of Phil Niekro, is trying to create his legacy. Our Farm Bureau Pitcher of the Week, Niekro, made his first two Double-A starts during the opening homestand and went 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2), two walks, and eight strikeouts. Niekro won during the home opener on April 9 with 6.0 shutout innings in the 2-0 weather-shortened contest. The Plant City, FL native ranks among the Southern League leaders in WHIP (8th, 0.84), ERA (9th, 1.69), and opponent's batting average (9th, .179).

GIVE ME FIVE: The M-Braves are 4-0 when their starters go 5+ innings and 0-7 when starters go less than 5.0 innings. In the three games with 5+ innings, they combined for a 0.78 ERA (2 ER/23 IP). In the seven losses, the starter ERA is 8.52 (24 ER/25.1 IP).

MR. MEJIA: After struggling in his first start, Ian Mejia has allowed just one run over his previous two quality starts, including 12 innings, one run allowed, four walks, and 13 strikeouts. Mejia set a new career high with nine strikeouts. Mejia ranks among the Southern League leaders in innings pitched (2nd, 13.2) and strikeouts (T-6th, 14).

OPENING DAY ROSTER FEATURES FOUR TOP-20 ATL PROSPECTS/17 RETURNERS: Mississippi returns 17 players from last season's club and four of the Atlanta Braves' Top 20 prospects. The Top 20 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, include RHP Hurston Waldrep (No. 2), INF Nacho Alvarez Jr. (No. 6), C Drake Baldwin (No. 11), and LHP Luis De Avila (No. 20). RHP lan Mejia (No. 28), and INF Keshawn Ogans are part of Baseball America's Top 30 prospects ... The 17 returning players include pitchers De Avila, RHP Domingo Gonzalez, RHP Patrick Halligan, LHP Hayden Harris, LHP Jake McSteen, RHP Trey Riley, RHP Hurston Waldrep, RHP Peyton Williams, and position players Baldwin, C Tyler Tolve, C Javier Valdes, INF Cade Bunnell, INF Cal Conley, INF Bryson Horne, OF Justin Dean, OF Cody Milligan, and OF Brandon Parker.

COACHING STAFF WITH A NEW FLO: After spending one season as manager of the Braves High-A affiliate Rome Braves (Emperors), Angel Flores will take the reins for the first time at the Double-A level, succeeding Kanekoa Texeira. Texeira was promoted to manager of the Triple-A Gwinnett Stripers after Matt Tuiasosopo was named to the Braves' Major League coaching staff for 2024. Flores returns to Mississippi, where he served as bench coach in 2022. Flores took over as interim manager from April 26 to May 15, 2022, while Bruce Crabbe took a leave of absence from the club. During the 18-game stretch, the M-Braves went 10-8. During his first season as a full-time manager last year, Flores led the R-Braves to a 34-32 record in the second half and an overall 64-68 mark. Overall, he holds a 74-76 record as a manager.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: The club finished with a 62-75 overall record, 33-35 in the first half and 29-40. in the second half. The M-Braves were 32-36 at Trustmark Park and 30-39 on the road. The M-Braves went 19-32 in July and August but finished with a franchise record nine wins in September.

FINAL SEASON IN MISSISSIPPI: On January 9, it was announced that after 20 years, 2024 will be the M-Braves' final season in Pearl, MS. As of the start of the 2025 season, the Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves will be relocating to Columbus, GA.



TODAY'S GAME

The 2023 Southern League All-Star makes his third start of 2024, and 28th for the M-Braves. De Avila is in search of his first win.

LAST TIME OUT

 De Avila gave up six runs (four earned) on six hits, walking three, and striking out three in Mississippi's loss at Pensacola last Saturday, 7-6. De Avila struggled with command, throwing 43 of 82 pitches for strikes.

VS. BIRMINGHAM

The southpaw went 1-0 with a 0.73 ERA, seven walks, and 13 strikeouts against
the Barons in 2023. In his lone start at Regions Field last season, De Avila tossed
6.0 shutout innings on June 3rd, allowing only one hit with four walks, and seven
strikeouts.

2023 NOTES

- The two-time Southern League Pitcher of the Week, made a career-high 26 starts in 2023, going 6-10 with a 3.28 ERA over 123.1 innings with 125 strikeouts to 61 walks in 25 Mississippi starts. Was named a Southern League All-Star.
- Combined to make 26 starts between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Finished among the Southern League leaders in ERA (2nd), starts (4th), innings pitched (5th), opponents average (3rd, .223), strikeouts (8th), and WHIP (8th) ... Ranked among the top 10 Atlanta farmhands in starts (1st, 26), ERA (2nd, 3.26), innings (T-2nd, 127.0), BAA (2nd, .224), strikeouts (3rd, 128), and WHIP (8th, 1.32) ...
- Over his final three starts with the M-Braves, he threw 14.0 scoreless innings, striking out 16 and walking just four.
- During the club's successful June, De Avila was somehow denied the Southern League Pitcher of the Month award after finishing 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28 innings over five starts.
