FRES-NOTES

GRIZZLIES FLIP THE SCRIPT: One night after a series-opening loss, Fresno flipped the script in a hurry, scoring in four different innings and cruising to a 10-2 win over Stockton on Wednesday. Sebastian Blanco's two-run homer in the second inning highlighted an 11-hit night at the plate that also featured a four-times-on-base game from Natili (2-for-3, two walks, two RBI) and three walks from Juan Martinez, who also drove in two runs. Ozuna worked four efficient innings to open the game before handing off to a bullpen that allowed just one run the rest of the way, with Davis picking up the win and Cole closing it out for the save. The win pushed Fresno to 62-54 on the season and rebuilt the Grizzlies' season-series lead over Stockton to 11-9.

PORT CLOSURE: A day after a tough outing, Fresno's pitching staff bounced back in a big way in the series' second game, with Sandy Ozuna, Ben Davis, Redinson Gomez and Ethan Cole combining to hold Stockton to two runs on five hits across nine innings. Davis tossed a scoreless inning in his professional debut to pick up his first win of his career, and Cole slammed the door with three shutout innings for his first professional save, giving the bullpen a dominant final two-thirds of the game. That collective effort has been a hallmark of the Fresno staff against Stockton this year, which has limited the Ports to a .242 team average across the season series. With the pitching staff showing it can flip a game around in a single night, the Grizzlies have real momentum heading into the rest of this crucial series.

GRIZZLIES SINKING PORTS FROM THE 'PEN: The clearest advantage Fresno holds over Stockton this season is its relief pitching, and the first two games of this series put it on full display. Hansel worked around an early jam Tuesday and didn't allow another run across 5.2 innings, and Wednesday, Davis, Gomez and Cole combined for five innings of one-run relief to close out a 10-2 win. That group also includes a 0.00 ERA from Olivares and a 1.13 mark from Correa against Stockton this season, giving Fresno a bullpen that has consistently shut the door in this matchup. It's been just as important as the Grizzlies' .278 average and 28 home runs against Stockton pitching in building an 11-9 season-series lead. With four games left in the series — and Fresno still two games back of Stockton for the final second-half playoff spot — that bullpen depth is the most repeatable edge the Grizzlies can lean on to close the gap.
