## **LAST GAME**

The Baysox took down the Akron RubberDucks by a 1-0 final on Saturday night. It was a combined effort for a one-hit shutout amongst four arms on the Bowie staff. Right-hander Alex Pham kicked it off with four hitless frames, walking just two and facing one over the minimum before making way for left-handed Cionel Perez on a major league rehab assignment. Perez went 1.2 innings with three strikeouts and one walk, before passing the baton to right-hander Ryan Long. The first batter Long faced, Jose Tena, blooped a single into shallow left field to break up the no-hit bid, but Long was still masterful, collecting three strikeouts in 2.1 innings, picking up a win in his Double-A debut in the process, before Conner Loeprich tossed a scoreless ninth to notch his first save of the season. Left-hander Doug Nikhazy was handed the loss for Akron, as Billy Cook hit a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first for the second-consecutive game generating the lone run. Jackson Holliday also collected three hits for the Baysox in just his second game at the Double-A level.

## TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter this weekend with a 43-40 overall record - 8-6 in the second half - good for third place in the Southwest division second-half standings, but just a game out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, Akron holds the third-best ERA (3.73) in the Eastern League this season, but has also committed the third-most errors (78), while hitting the fewest home runs (60) through 83 games. The RubberDucks' active roster is headlined by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Angel Martinez (No. 7 CLE), OF Petey Halpin (No. 13 CLE), IF Juan Brito (No. 14 CLE), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 18 CLE), IF Jose Tena (No. 19 CLE), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26 CLE) and RHP Jack Leftwich (No. 28 CLE).

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jack Leftwich is set to receive the ball in the rubber match for Akron. The No. 28 prospect in the Guardians' system, per MLB Pipeline, has pitched to a lot of contact through his 12 appearances (8 starts) in 2023 - 37 hits in 37 innings to be exact, including nine home runs. Leftwich is making just his second start since a stint on the injured list that lasted from mid-June until early July. Leftwich went just two innings in his first start back, Friday, July 7 against Harrisburg, firing 35 pitches in the process. Against Bowie this season, Leftwich is 0-2 with a 7.04 ERA. He allowed four runs on six hits through 4.2 frames most recently on 5/23, including a home run to John Rhodes. Originally a seventh-round selection for the Guardians out of the University of Florida in 2021, Leftwich features a mid-90s fastball, a low-80s slider with depth, and a low-80s changeup with fade

## HAPPY HOLLIDAY

This weekend marks the Double-A debut for the No. 1 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB Pipeline, Jackson Holliday. Last year's No. 1 overall draft pick has soared through the Orioles' system. Entering this weekend, Holliday ranks top five in the system with a .331 average (2nd), .466 on-base percentage (1st), .523 slugging percentage (5th), .989 OPS (3rd), six triples (1st), and 64 walks (1st). Holliday's walk total and on-base percentage also rank fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

## **K'D POVICH**

Baysox left-handed starter Cade Povich continues to pace the Eastern League with 108 strikeouts on the season. Last Saturday was another fine start for Povich, when he tossed five innings of one-run baseball with nine strikeouts against Richmond, However, Povich's numbers do vary outside of contests against the Flying Squirrels. When facing Richmond, Povich is 3-0 with a 0.53 ERA (1 ER in 17 IP) and a .074 opposing average. Against all other opponents this season, Povich is 3-7 with a 6.29 ERA and an opposing average that jumps to .276. Against Akron specifically this season, Povich holds a 4.40 ERA (7 ER across 14.1 innings) through three starts, with 20 strikeouts and six walks.

## ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

Friday was a career night for John Rhodes. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, hit three home runs for the first multi-home run game of his career. The performance was a big slump buster for Rhodes, who had been just 2-for-27 at the plate in the month of July prior. Rhodes has clobbered Akron pitching this season, hitting .302 against RubberDucks arms, with four of his eight home runs on the season. Rhodes' day at the plate on Friday was just the seventh three home run effort in Baysox franchise history.

## **COACHING STAFF**

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving no to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
