LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Akron RubberDucks by a 1-0 final on Saturday night. It was a combined effort for a one-hit shutout amongst four arms on the Bowie staff. Right-hander Alex Pham kicked it off with four hitless frames, walking just two and facing one over the minimum before making way for left-handed Cionel Perez on a major league rehab assignment. Perez went 1.2 innings with three strikeouts and one walk, before passing the baton to right-hander Ryan Long. The first batter Long faced, Jose Tena, blooped a single into shallow left field to break up the no-hit bid, but Long was still masterful, collecting three strikeouts in 2.1 innings, picking up a win in his Double-A debut in the process, before Conner Loeprich tossed a scoreless ninth to notch his first save of the season. Left-hander Doug Nikhazy was handed the loss for Akron, as Billy Cook hit a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first for the second-consecutive game generating the lone run. Jackson Holliday also collected three hits for the Baysox in just his second game at the Double-A level.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter this weekend with a 43-40 overall record - 8-6 in the second half - good for third place in the Southwest division second-half standings, but just a game out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, Akron holds the third-best ERA (3.73) in the Eastern League this season, but has also committed the third-most errors (78), while hitting the fewest home runs (60) through 83 games. The RubberDucks' active roster is headlined by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Angel Martinez (No. 7 CLE), OF Petey Halpin (No. 13 CLE), IF Juan Brito (No. 14 CLE), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 18 CLE), IF Jose Tena (No. 19 CLE), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26 CLE) and RHP Jack Leftwich (No. 28 CLE).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jack Leftwich is set to receive the ball in the rubber match for Akron. The No. 28 prospect in the Guardians' system, per MLB Pipeline, has pitched to a lot of contact through his 12 appearances (8 starts) in 2023 - 37 hits in 37 innings to be exact, including nine home runs. Leftwich is making just his second start since a stint on the injured list that lasted from mid-June until early July. Leftwich went just two innings in his first start back, Friday, July 7 against Harrisburg, firing 35 pitches in the process. Against Bowie this season, Leftwich is 0-2 with a 7.04 ERA. He allowed four runs on six hits through 4.2 frames most recently on 5/23, including a home run to John Rhodes. Originally a seventh-round selection for the Guardians out of the University of Florida in 2021, Leftwich features a mid-90s fastball, a low-80s slider with depth, and a low-80s changeup with fade.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

This weekend marks the Double-A debut for the No. 1 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB Pipeline, Jackson Holliday. Last year's No. 1 overall draft pick has soared through the Orioles' system. Entering this weekend, Holliday ranks top five in the system with a .331 average (2nd), .466 on-base percentage (1st), .523 slugging percentage (5th), .989 OPS (3rd), six triples (1st), and 64 walks (1st). Holliday's walk total and on-base percentage also rank fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

K'D POVICH

Baysox left-handed starter Cade Povich continues to pace the Eastern League with 108 strikeouts on the season. Last Saturday was another fine start for Povich, when he tossed five innings of one-run baseball with nine strikeouts against Richmond. However, Povich's numbers do vary outside of contests against the Flying Squirrels. When facing Richmond, Povich is 3-0 with a 0.53 ERA (1 ER in 17 IP) and a .074 opposing average. Against all other opponents this season, Povich is 3-7 with a 6.29 ERA and an opposing average that jumps to .276. Against Akron specifically this season, Povich holds a 4.40 ERA (7 ER across 14.1 innings) through three starts, with 20 strikeouts and six walks.

ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

Friday was a career night for John Rhodes. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, hit three home runs for the first multi-home run game of his career. The performance was a big slump buster for Rhodes, who had been just 2-for-27 at the plate in the month of July prior. Rhodes has clobbered Akron pitching this season, hitting .302 against RubberDucks arms, with four of his eight home runs on the season. Rhodes' day at the plate on Friday was just the seventh three home run effort in Baysox franchise history.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
- 5/28 Faced the minimum over the first two innings thanks to a double play. Allowed three doubles. First five batters reached safely in the fifth inning.
- 6/3 Gave up a single and home run to the first two batters. Needed 71 pitches for just the first three innings. Allowed a second two-run home run in the fourth. Career high in hits allowed
- 6/9 Gave up a two-run home run to second batter of the second inning. Allowed two more runs in the following innings on three-consecutive two-out hits.
- 6/15 Struck out the first six batters, and seven of the first eight. Carried a perfect game into the seventh inning before allowing a leadoff single. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 6/21 Stranded error at third base in first inning, and threw perfect second. Allowed first five batters of the third inning to reach, including two walks and a hit batter.
- 6/28 Allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and back-to-back home runs to lead off the fourth inning, before walking the next three batters, and failing to escape the frame.
- 7/3 Allowed three runs on back-to-back home runs with two outs in the first inning. Allowed two more base hits in the second, but picked off one runner, and faced the minimum over the next 13 batters.
- 7/8 Only hit over first four innings was an infield single. Allowed a leadoff home run in the fifth.
