Last start came on Wednesday, September 4 at Tulsa when he allowed 2 R (1 ER) on 4 H with 4 K over 3.0 IP...Joined the Missions on August 6 and made his Double-A debut at Hammons Field on August 10... The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **ON VERGE OF FRANCHISE HISTORY:** With their win in the series finale against the Naturals on Sunday evening, the Cardinals inched closer to setting a major milestone in Springfield history. The Birds now have 76 wins this season, one shy of the franchise record of 77 which was accomplished in the Texas League championship season of 2012 and again in 2017.

DN PACE...: With just 6 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » The Cardinals set a new franchise record with their 39th road win last Sunday afternoon at Wichita, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,274, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- » With an average of .333, Bryan Torres is on pace to tie the record held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005.
- » With 25 saves, **Matt Svanson** is within 2 of the franchise record of 27 (**Mark Worrell**, 2006 & **Chris Perez**, 2007).

AWARDS SZN: For the first time in franchise history, the Springfield Cardinals have swept monthly Texas League awards:

OF/INF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League and St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month after a red-hot August. Torres batted .418 with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBIs while compiling a .491 OBP and 1.029 OPS in 23 games in the month. He recorded multiple hits 13 times, including in 10 of his last 14 games in the month. **Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for August 13-18.

LHP **Quinn Mathews** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month despite earning a promotion to Triple-A Memphis on August 28. The Stanford product went 2-0 with a 0.70 ERA and 0.58 WHIP with 40 K across 25.2 IP in the month.

Torres and **Mathews** join **Tink Hence** (Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April) as the only Cardinals to earn a Texas League monthly award. **Nathan Church** was named St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month in April.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 24 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Springfield is 16-8 during that time, and have outscored its opponents 43-15 in the 8th inning or later.

RUN PRODUCER: Through 5 games in the month of September, Cardinals 1B/ OF **Matt Lloyd** is batting .333 (9-for-27) with 2 HR and a league-high 9 RBIs. For the season, the Canadian product has been one of the top run producers in the Texas League. His 75 RBIs ranks 2nd in the circuit behind only **AJ Vukovich** of Amarillo who has 80.

5-HIT TORRES: With a 5-for-5 performance on Friday night, **Bryan Torres** became the first player in Springfield Cardinals history to have 5 hits in two separate games in the same season. The reigning Texas League and Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month also went 5-for-5 on August 14 at Frisco. **Torres** leads the Texas League in batting average (.333), hits (144), and OBP (.417).

CARDS WELCOME BIG BAT BACK INTO FOLD: Cardinals C **Jimmy Crooks** was activated from the IL on Tuesday, putting perhaps Springfield's most productive hitter back into the middle of the lineup. At the time he was placed on the IL August 27, **Crooks** was leading all qualified hitters the Texas League with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs since June 23.

MAKING A SPLASH: In his first game at Double-A on Saturday, 2023 1stround pick **Chase Davis** announced his presence with his very first swing. The 21st overall pick homered on the first swing he took in a Springfield uniform, a solo shot to give the Cards a 1-0 lead in the 2nd inning. In his first two games with Springfield, **Davis** is 2-for-6 with a double and a home run.

SLAM THE DODR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 25-for-25 and his 50 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 15-for-15 in save opportunities. **Svanson** had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 56-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


