### TODAY'S HEADLINES

# **LAST TIME OUT:** Randy Dobnak retired the first nine batters he faced before allowing five runs in the fourth inning as the Saints dropped 8-3. The Saints did not have a hit until Diego Castillo led off the fifth inning with a single. The Mets hit back-to-back home runs in the seventh inning to make it 8-0, but the Saints returned the favor as Michael Helman and Castillo did the same in the bottom of the inning. The Saints had two in scoring position in the eighth and ninth, but could not plate any more runs in the loss.

A RECIPE FOR SUCCESS: On Saturday, the Saints pitching staff threw the 12<sup>th</sup> game in franchise history in which they did not walk a batter and the fifth time that they did not issue a walk and struck out 10-or-more batters. In games the Saints do not walk out a batter and strike out at least 10, they are, oddly enough, 2-3 all-time.

**LOATHING LEFTIES:** Today will be the 16<sup>th</sup> game the Saints have faced a left-handed starter, going 6-9 in games facing a southpaw starter. The Saints are hitting just .209/.301/.346 against left-handers this season, all the lowest in the International League. Their 190 strikeouts against left-handed pitching are the most in the IL. But not all is bad for the Saints, as Diego Castillo is hitting a team-best .375 against left-handers and Will Holland has gone 8-for-21 (.381) as well.

**JUNE HEAT:** Once the calendar flipped to June, the Saints offense has started to click. Their .260 batting average in June is good for sixth in the IL with 12 home runs, tied for the fifth-most in the league. The club's .463 slugging percentage is tied for the seventh-highest in the IL in June and their .817 OPS is the eighth-best in the IL in June.

WALLNER WARMING UP: Since May 28, Matt Wallner has flipped the switch and has been one of the best hitters in the league. Of batters with at least 30 plate appearances, he leads the IL with a 96.9 exit velocity in that span. He also leads the league in home runs (6), extra base hits (9), total bases (33), slugging percentage (.868) and fifth in OPS (1.290).

**KEMP KRUSHING:** Tony Kemp has turned it on over his last 11 games, hitting .357 (15-for-42). In that stretch he has hits in eight of those 11 games, five multi-hit games and a pair of three-hit nights. In his last 44 plate appearances, Kemp has drawn two walks and struck out four times, sporting a .386 on-base percentage and a.548 slugging percentage.

CHECKING ON THE COMPLEX: Jair Camargo continues his minor league rehab assignment, going 9-for-26 (.346) with two doubles, a home run, five RBI and three walks in six games with the FCL Twins and Fort Myers. Camargo was placed on the 7-Day Injured List on May 1 with a right forearm strain.

**NEW OPPONENT, WHO DIS?:** The Saints will face off against the Syracuse Mets for the first time in the club's franchise history. Syracuse is the fourth team from the IL-East to visit CHS Field, joining Rochester, Durham and Scranton W/B. The Saints are 35-24 all-time against the East Division, including going 19-12 at CHS Field.

**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND:** The Saints have played three straight series against New York teams in Buffalo, Rochester and now Syracuse. Michael Helman and Yunior Severino have had sustained success over teams from the Empire State:

S In Severino's 14 games since May 21, he has hit .313 (15-for-48), with three home runs and a .950 OPS. His average exit velocity over that stretch is 93.0 mph, up from his season average of 89.2 mph

**5** Michael Helman has turned it on again, hitting .323 (2`-for-65) over the 17-game stretch. He's reached base in 15 of those 17 games.

**TWINS UPDATE:** The Twins got 6.1 strong innings from Simeon Woods Richardson, but the offense did not back him up in a 4-0 loss to the Pirates. SWR struck out six without walking a batter. The offense managed just six singles in the loss.
