NEWS & NOTES

'GADES ARE HOT: After a 13-0 blowout win on Tuesday, the Renegades have now won 11 of their last 14 games. Hudson Valley hit four long balls in the game. With the victory, Hudson Valley has now set a season-high with eight consecutive wins at Heritage Financial Park. The Renegades have a 15-3 record at home in the second half. Last Sunday, the Renegades set a season-high with their seventh consecutive victory, and their sixth in a row over Jersey Shore. The sweep over the BlueClaws marked the second six-game series sweep in franchise history. Hudson Valley is currently in sitting first place in the SAL North, a 0.5 game ahead of Aberdeen for a playoff spot.

THE NEW GUYS: Since being called up last week from Single-A Tampa, Dylan Jasso and Jackson Castillo have been scorching hot at the plate. On Tuesday, the duo combined for 10 RBIs in the 13-0 win. With a three-run homer and grand slam, Castillo drove in seven runs, matching the single-game franchise record tied by Jared Serna earlier this year. Castillo is 8-for-21 with the Renegades, having reached base in all six games he's played. Jasso was 2-for-4 with a triple, homer, and three RBIs on Wednesday. He has four extra-base hits in six games, and has also reached base safely in all six.

SWAN SONG: This week, Hudson Valley hosts the Hickory Crawdads for the final time. The Rangers High-A affiliate will be joining the Carolina League next season, moving to the Single-A level. The Hub City Spartanburgers will replace the Crawdads in the South Atlantic League. Last season, the Renegades traveled to Hickory, where they won four of six games at L.P. Frans Stadium. In the first game of that series, Hudson Valley was victorious 16-5, featuring three-hit games from Spencer Jones and Christopher Familia.

PITCHING IN: Entering play on Wednesday, the Renegades pitching staff sports a 3.47 ERA, not only the lowest in the South Atlantic League, but the best among all High-A teams. Hudson Valley ranks 8th among all full-season Minor League teams. Since the All-Star Break, the staff has a 2.39 ERA, which is second-best in MiLB, trailing only the Down East Wood Ducks (TEX, A), who have a 2.01 team ERA since the break.

PITCHING REINFORCEMENTS: After being called up early last week, **Josh Grosz** and **Cade Smith** provided stellar performances in Brooklyn on the mound. Grosz was stellar to in his return to the Renegades on Saturday, after making a spot start with the club in May, also in Brooklyn. The right-hander allowed just one hit in six scoreless innings. In his last four starts between Tampa and Hudson Valley, Grosz has been charged with just one earned run in 24 innings, good for a 0.37 ERA during that stretch. In his first career High-A start, Smith retired the first 14 batters he faced, taking a perfect game into the fifth inning. He allowed one hit in 4.2 innings with five punch outs. After winning Florida State League Pitcher of the Month in July, Smith has allowed just six earned runs over his last six starts.

HOME COOKIN': The Renegades are currently in a stretch where they are playing 19 of their next 25 games at Heritage Financial Park. After traveling to Brooklyn for a six-game series last week, Hudson Valley now embarks on a two-week homestand. They host Hickory for six games this week, before playing Wilmington one final time next week. Of their final 25 games, the Renegades will play 19 of them at home.

LIMITING HITS: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 695 hits through 107 games. The Renegades have allowed the fewest hits in MiLB, five fewer than the Down East Wood Ducks (A, TEX) for the best mark. Renegades pitching is holding the opposition to a .210 batting average this season, the best mark in MiLB. Incredibly, the Lansing Lugnuts (OAK, A+) have allowed a staggering 978 hits through 108 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

NEW BEGINNINGS: **Jace Avina** debuted with the Renegades on April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. July was a rough month for the outfielder, where he hit just .096 (7-for-72). However, August has started with a bang for Avina. He is 10-for-31 with two home runs and seven RBIs in eight games so far this month. Last Sunday, Avina was featured as the No. 1 play on Sportscenter's "Top 10 Plays" for a home run robbery of Jersey Shore's Felix Reyes.

WEST COAST ARMS: Starting pitching continues to be excellent for the Renegades. Fifty-five of the last 60 starters have allowed three earned runs

or less in their outings. On Sunday, the streak of no earned runs allowed by **Trent Sellers** came to an end at 30.2 consecutive frames. The right-hander still has a 0.64 ERA in 28.1 innings since June 26th with 32 strikeouts and a .118 opposing average. Last week, Sellers was named South Atlantic Pitcher of the Month for July, holding the best ERA in MiLB (0.00) among qualified pitchers during that span. On Tuesday, **Kyle Carr** allowed just one hit in five scoreless innings while striking out five. Since the All-Star break, Carr has allowed just four earned runs in 24 innings with 25 punchouts, good for a 1.50 ERA. The southpaw has allowed just 10 combined hits in his last five starts.

THE RUNNIN' RENEGADES ARE BACK: After stealing only 13 bases in 27 games in June, the Renegades have been on a stolen base frenzy, going 38-for-43 on stolen base attempts as a team in their last 33 games.

HEATING UP: Antonio Gomez has been excellent at the plate over the last week. The Renegades catcher is currently riding a ten-game on-base streak where he is 13-for-33 at the plate, with six doubles, a triple, a home run, four RBIs, and 13 runs scored. During that stretch, Gomez has a .727 slugging percentage and 1.214 OPS. He has boosted his average from .169 to .228 in the last ten games.

ROAD STRUGGLES: After losing both games of a doubleheader on Sunday Hudson Valley is now 6-13 in its last 19 road games. The Renegades have taken three of the first four games on the road at Maimonides Park this week, but had to settle for a series split. Hudson Valley had just seven combined hits in the doubleheader. In the series, they only scored more than three runs twice, and scored six combined runs over the final three matchups of the set. This season, Hudson Valley is just 23-36 overall away from Heritage Financial Park this season. The 36 road losses are the most in the South Atlantic League this season. Last year, the Renegades were 41-25 on the road.

DOUBLES MACHINES: With 200 doubles in 2024, Hudson Valley has the most doubles in High-A this season, four more than the Everett AquaSox (A+, SEA). Four Renegades have 16 or more doubles, and 10 players have ten or more two-baggers.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Renegades bullpen collectively sports a 3.24 ERA (157 ER/435.2 IP) this season, the best mark in High-A and sixth-best in the minors. Last Wednesday, five Renegades relievers collectively threw five scoreless innings to complete a 7-0 shutout win in game two of the doubleheader. On Tuesday, Hudson Valley's bullpen consisting of Kelly Austin, Mason Vinyard, and Matt Keating allowed just one total hits in four innings, recording seven punch outs.

GADES THROW NO HITTER: History was made on July 19th, as the Renegades completed the third no-hitter in franchise history. It was the first time since July 10, 2021 that the Renegades had thrown a no-no, and the first nine-inning no-hitter since August 10, 2000. With the score remaining tied into the bottom of the ninth, a Roc Riggio walk-off home run sealed the no-hitter and a 1-0 win. Kyle Carr, Trent Sellers, and Hueston Morrill combined to complete the feat.

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH: The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night on August 20 at Heritage Financial Park. The team is currently fundraising to bring over several Bhutanese baseball players for baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York. DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT: In 17 of their last 34 games, the Renegades have played error-free. With no errors in eight of the last 12 games, Hudson Valley is now 28-10 in games this season where they do not commit an error.

PIRATE POWER: **Josh Moylan** has been on a tear over the past two weeks. The infielder had a tremendous series in Wilmington two weeks ago, going 5-for-17 with three home runs. He has continued to excel at the plate since that series two weeks ago. In his last eight games, Moylan is 10-for-25 (.400) with 2 HR, 6 RBIs, and five runs scored, to go along with a .531 on-base percentage, .720 slugging percentage and a 1.251 OPS.

LAST TIME OUT: Starting in the rain and enduring a 12-minute rain delay in the top of the fourth inning, Stuart tossed 4.0 innings last Thursday at Brooklyn, allowing two runs on four hits while getting no decision. The right-hander struck out five and walked two, marking his fourth straight start with five strikeouts.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster... promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on 5/23... transferred to the Renegades on 5/24.
- Threw his first quality start of the season on 5/15 vs Jersey Shore: 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K, 1 HR (two-run HR to Bryan Rincon) in front of largest crowd in Heritage Financial Park history (5,619). Stuart retired the first 11 batters he faced before an Otto Kemp single with two outs in the fourth.
- Called up to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to make a spot start on 5/23 (Game 1) vs. Syracuse, threw a complete game: W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 2 K. Joined **Sean Boyle** in 2021 as pitchers called directly up to Triple-A from the Renegades who went on to throw a complete game in a spot start (Boyle threw no-hitter at Worcester on 8/19/21).
- Allowed 10 hits on 7/13 @ Jersey Shore, first HV pitcher to allow 10+ hits in a start since Juan Carela on 4/29/23 @ Greenville.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in FCL... assigned to Tampa Tarpons on April 25... transferred to Hudson Valley on Aug. 2.
- Made his professional debut on April 30 at Jupiter: L, 4.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 5 K.
- In July with Tampa: 1-1, 1.48 ERA, 24.1 IP, 21 H, 8 R, 4 ER, 6 BB, 18 K in four starts. Lowered ERA from 5.59 to 4.00.
- Threw a quality start in three of his final four starts with Tampa before his promotion.
- Threw 100 pitches on 8/15 @ BRK, becoming the second HV pitcher in the 2023 season to throw 100+ in a game (Juan Carela, 7/2 vs Wilmington). His night ended with a 10-pitch walk worked by Jacob Reimer.
- During time with Hudson Valley vs. Jersey Shore: 13.50 ERA (15 ER/10.0 IP) vs. Others: 2.28 ERA (7 ER/27.2 IP).

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Baron Boward Stuart.
- Played collegiately for four years at the University of South Florida (2018-21) and one year at the University of Pittsburgh (2022).
- Signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent on July 21, 2022.
- Was a starting pitcher at USF, but transitioned to the bullpen at Pittsburgh. Led the Panthers with 27 appearances and seven saves, which was tied fifth in the ACC and fourth-most in a single season in program history.
- Helped lead Pitt to the semifinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time since 2018.
- Was a Nursing major at USF, majored in Communications/Cyber Security at Pitt.
- When MLB Draft Tracker Twitter account was hacked before the 2022 draft, the account tweeted out that the first overall pick of the draft was Baron Stuart.
