Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from his first loss of the season last time out. The Mud Hens will counter with RHP **Carl Edwards**. Columbus is 41-30 (.577) versus right handers this year. Edwards has pitched against the Clippers five times in his career, going 0-3 with a 9.95ERA (6.1IP, 10H, 9R, 7ER, 6BB, 3K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus has pulled ahead in the season series vs. Toledo (8-4) after going 10-11 opposing the Mud Hens last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022). The Clippers have scored first in nine of 12 against Toledo this year (7-2), compared to 37 times (20-17) in their other 89G. Individually, **Daniel Schneemann** has hit .349 with 6HR and 19RBI against Toledo in his career (22G).

Ingle is Back

In 12G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 19x50 (.380), drawing 7BB (.456OBP) with 7XBH (2HR, .620SLG). Thursday's 4x5 game pushed his season average over .300, while also qualifying him for rate statistics, as he is one of two players in the IL, along with Iowa's **BJ Murray**, hitting .300/.400/.500. At catcher, Ingle has a 1.329OPS (12HR) in 34G (.613OPS and 2HR in 28G between DH and LF).

Angel Ascendant

Over his last 30G, since 6/18, **Angel Genao** leads the IL in OBP (.478), while ranking 2nd walks (22) and in batting (.378, 42x111) and 9th in OPS (1.037). He owns a 16% walk rate in that time (136PA; 8% in first 35G with Columbus) and his 11K yield an 8% rate (21% in first 35G). Saturday's multi-K game was his first since 5/31 (40G between; 40PA with 0K from 7/8-7/22, 50PA with 0K from 6/23-7/3).

Long Time, No Schneemann

Daniel Schneemann is returning to the Clippers tonight for the first time since 5/31/24, as he is set to appear in his 170th game. Over his final 32G with the Clippers (4/25-5/31/24), he slashed .339/.449/.635 with 7HR and 28RBI (sitting at 99RBI in his Clipper career). That stretch saw the start of his transition to the OF (10G, 20G in career prior), as he would go on to play 100+G in the OF for Cleveland.

Walks Waning

Though Columbus maintains a comfortable lead in the IL in walks (518, +27 on 2nd), the lineup has drawn just 38BB in 9G since the All-Star Break (t-11th). **Kahlil Watson** drew one on Sunday, but has only 8BB in his last 28G with Columbus (30BB in first 31G, ranked 2nd in the IL through 5/9). **Bo Naylor** has walked in each of his last 2G, giving him 3BB in his last 13G (24BB in first 28G with Columbus).

Looking to Rebound

Ralphy Velazquez produced a multi-hit game on 7/19 vs. Indianapolis, a day after his career best 30G on base streak was snapped (.383OBP from 6/3-7/10, t-4th longest in the IL this year), but he is 0x21 in 6G since (longest hitless stretch of the season, average has dipped 31 points). Velazquez has dominated in Huntington Park, with an .863OPS in 23G (.579OPS in 25G on the road).

Serious Growth

Kody Huff clubbed his 14th HR of the season on Saturday, one more than the previous two seasons combined. Having already also established career highs in runs, triples, RBI, walks, and steals, Huff is just eight hits and four doubles from personal bests. He is 6x15 in his last 5G (double, triple, 2HR) and his .912OPS is 5th best in the IL (.682OPS in MiLB career prior; **Cooper Ingle** leads: .990).

In a Slump

After doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** hit .107 (6x56, all singles) with only 6BB and 3RBI in his next 15G. He broke out last Tuesday (double, 2BB, 2RBI; first multi-RBI game since 5/30), but he is 0x9 since. His next RBI will be his 150th as a Clipper (38th, **Juan Brito** is at 147). Valera has not homered since 5/19 vs. Louisville (118AB) and has 2HR in his last 51G (180AB, .283SLG).

Two at a Time

Alfonsin Rosario is only 3x27 (.111) since joining the Clippers last week, but all of his hits have been doubles and all three times he has scored after putting himself in scoring position. Combined between Akron and Columbus, Rosario now has a career best 23 doubles (22 between Lake County and Akron last season) and he is pacing to cross the plate 68 times (personal best of 69 last year).

This Date in Clipper History

7/28/2022

Tanner Tully (5.0IP, 3H, 2K) notched a complete game, thanks to some help from Mother Nature, in a 6-0 shutout at Louisville. At the plate, **Will Benson** extended his hitting streak to 10G with an RBI triple and he also drew a walk. Though Benson would be promoted to the Majors a few days later and a few PA shy of qualifying for rate statistics, he wound up easily pacing the IL with a .426OBP.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,458 to 1,401).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 144-117 (.552) in pitch reviews, with batters going 74-74 (.500) and pitchers/catchers going 70-43 (.619). They have run out of challenges in 41G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .571), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 791, would rank as 6th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 118 through 101G (on pace for 174SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 33CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 152 runs while crafting a .903OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 81 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +71 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 237-148 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,961RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.38 through the first 101G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 192HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 6th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 56G this season (32-24, .571), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 3rd most last at bat wins this year (14, two off the lead) while playing in the 3rd most games decided in the last at bat (26, Memphis has 28). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 100G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-52 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 438-455 (.490), 408-409 with Columbus (.499).

June Swoon:

In his first 10G of the year (March-May), Maltud gave up 15ER in 50.2IP (2.66ERA), holding the opposition to a .195 average (38x186, 4HR). In 5G during June, he gave up 15ER in 17.1IP (7.79ERA), while opposing hitters batted .301 (22x73, 1HR). Maltud rebounded to start July with 4ER in his first 14.0IP (2.57ERA), but then allowed career worsts with 7ER (second time) on 4HR at St. Paul on 7/22 (7HR in 74AB this month).

Undecided:

Through the month of June, Maltud was the only pitcher in the IL with at least 10GS that had not taken a loss and his lone win (4/11 at Worcester) made him the only starter with a single decision. He is 2-1 through 4GS in July, winning back to back starts to start the month and suffering his first loss of the year in his 17th start. Despite a 4.23ERA as a starter and run support of 5.5 per game, Maltud has left with the lead only seven times because the offense is averaging 2.3 runs while he is the pitcher of record, including 11G with two runs or fewer (5G with zero runs).

Efficiency is Key:

Through 87 innings started in 19G, Maltud has retired the side with fewer than 10 pitches on 12 occasions, including a 4-pitch inning on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while turning in 18 innings of more than 20. He has hit 30+ thrice, thanks to an 11-pitch battle vs. Iowa's **Pedro Ramirez** on 4/17 (walk, 34 in the inning) and a 14-pitch skirmish with Buffalo's **Yohendrick Pinango** on 4/23 (groundout, 30 total). He ranks 4th in the IL with 15.5 pitches per inning.

Among the Leader Beans:

Entering today's game, Maltud is 7th in the IL with a 4.31ERA (was in the top five prior to allowing 7ER in 3.2IP at St. Paul on 7/22). From his quality start win on 4/11 at Worcester through his quality start on 5/25 at Toledo, he crafted the 2nd best ERA in the IL, at 2.14ERA (42.0IP, 10ER). Additionally, Maltud's 0.95WHIP in that time ranked 2nd best (1.28WHIP on the season places 7th).

Stepping Up:

With runners in scoring position this season, Maltud has held the opposition to a line of .183/.259/.254, surrendering just 1HR in 71AB. With a runner at first base, he has struggled to a line of .297/.348/.547 while allowing 4HR (64AB) and with the bases empty, the bad guys have hit .258/.310/.419 with 8HR in 198AB.

Pitch to Contact:

Maltud's Triple-A debut on 3/28 at Iowa was the 44th game of his career and marked his 37th consecutive start (reached 41GS before relief appearance on 4/30 vs. Toledo, all 6G in relief have come on starter's rest and been at least 3.0IP). He did not punch out any Cubs in that game (15BF), marking his second straight game without a strikeout (37BFwith 0K from, 9/10/25-4/3/26; had at least 1K in all 42G prior). Among 108 pitchers in the IL that have at least 200BF this year, Maltud has the 18th best walk rate (7.4%; 27BB to 363BF) and the 60th best strikeout rate (20.9%, 76K; had worst rate, 11.9%, prior to 64K in last 14G).

In Relief:

Maltud has pitched twice in relief this season (previous 5G out of the bullpen came among first 7G as a pro), piggybacking **Trenton Denholm** on 4/30 vs. Toledo (3.0IP, 40 pitches) and **Daniel Espino** on 6/2 vs. Omaha (4.0IP, 81 pitches). He has registered a 5.14ERA out of the bullpen (7.0IP, 11H, 4R, 4ER, 2BB, 13K),
