NOTES AND NUGGETS

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

This season, 47 of Omaha's 62 games (76%) have been decided by 4 runs or less, including the Storm Chasers' last 20 games.

Across the last 20 games (since May 18), Omaha is just 6-14 ... 15 of these 20 games have seen a save recorded, including 4 of Omaha's 6 games ... over the Chasers' 13-game, 2-week homestand, 11 games featured a save, including the first 10, between May 27 and June 6.

While the games of recent have been close, only 27 of Omaha's first 42 games (64%) were decided by a margin of 4 runs or less.

1-run games have especially been difficult for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers just 2-9 in games decided by a run ... 2 wins by 1 run is the fewest of any International League team, while 11 total 1-run games is tied for the fewest.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 98 bases this year, and only been caught 15 times ... 98 steals rank 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

98-for-113 in steal attempts is a 86.7% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level ... 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.8%, 44-for-49).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 597 strikeouts this season ... that is both 2nd in the league and at the Triple-A level.

Over 535.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.03 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 597 strikeouts through 62 games, an average of 9.63 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,434 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

The Omaha Storm Chasers lead the International League lead in both sacrifices (13) and sacrifice flies (27) as well.

The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts last year, with 38 ... the 13 sacrifice bunt this year are the most in the league this year, 3rd at the Triple-A level, and 15th in the Minors ... **Tyler Tolbert**, **Harold Castro** and **John Rave** each have 3 sacrifice bunts, tied for the 2nd-most in the league.

27 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and tied for the 4th-most in Minor League Baseball ... **Tyler Gentry's** 6 sacrifice flies lead the IL and are tied for the most at the Triple-A level, one off the Minor League lead.

LET'S OBSERVE MERV

After a slow start at the plate in his return to Triple-A, outfielder MJ Melendez has been one of Omaha's best hitters over the last month.

With a pair of hits Sunday, Melendez has 3 straight multi-hit games and hits in 18 of his last 22 games, with a .321 average (27-for-84) with a .946 OPS since May 16 ... he has 6 homers and 16 RBI in this stretch, with 7 multi-hit games.

Since May 16, Melendez is tied 2nd in the International League in total bases (49) and in homers (6) ... he has the most steals (11) in that stretch as well.

Over his first 19 games with the Storm Chasers, Melendez hit just .156 (12-for-77) with a .468 OPS, between April 22 and May 14 ... he had hits in 10 of 19 games in that stretch.

Underrated in MJ's time with Omaha has been the exit velocities he's produced ... an average exit velocity of 94.0MPH ranks 2nd among 330 Triple-A hitters with at least 100 plate appearances this season ... Worcester's Roman Anthony (recently promoted to the Major Leagues) hits the ball hardest on average, at 95.0MPH.

DIRECT FROM DIEGO

Infielder **Diego Castillo** has been Omaha's best hitter since joining the Storm Chasers in May.

Across 13 games with Omaha, Castillo is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with 10 RBI and a .979 OPS ... he's reached base in all 13 games he's played for the Chasers, with 11 walks in addition to the 14 hits, for a .446 OBP.

Since joining Omaha, Castillo leads the Storm Chasers in RBI (10), walks (11) and doubles (14), while ranking 2nd in hits (14) and total bases (24)

Castillo has a hit in 11 of 13 games with Omaha, drawn a walk in 8 of 13 and driven in a run in 8 of 13 ... he had a hit and drove in a run over his first 6 games with the Storm Chasers, from May 24 to June 1.

TODAY'S START

Wright is making his **nd start with Omaha** this season, his **6th overall start this season ... is with Omaha on a Major League rehab assignment** ... opened the year on Kansas City's 15-Day Injured List, sent to Double-A Northwest Arkansas to begin his rehab on May 2, had his rehab transferred to Omaha on June 3.

Underwent shoulder surgery in October 2023 to repair right shoulder damage.

Playing his 9th professional season this year ... Royals are Wright's 2nd MLB organization, was drafted 5th overall by the Braves in 2017 and pitched with Atlanta until he was traded to Kansas City in November 2023.

Made his 5th rehab start, his first with Omaha ... threw 3.2 scoreless innings, retired 11 of 13 batters faced ... allowed a single and walk with 2 outs in the 1st inning, then retired his final 9 batters, working 2 outs into the 4th inning ... struck out 1 in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd, then struck out 2 in the 4th inning.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

Opened the year on the Royals' 15-Day Injured List with a "right shoulder injury" ... initially assigned to Northwest Arkansas on May 2 to begin his rehab assignment, was recalled from his rehab assignment after 2 starts with shoulder fatigue ... returned to the Nationals 2 ½ weeks later and made 2 more starts for NWA.

Threw 4.0 innings and 60 pitches in his first rehab start, May 2 @ Springfield (STL) ... threw exactly 2.0 innings, did not reach 50 pitches in his next 3 outings in Double-A.

Told MLB.com's Anne Rogers, after his outing on May 7 vs. Wichita (MIN) ... "I kind of felt when I went out for that second inning, I felt like my delt was tired, so I kind of noticed my velo was dropping just a touch, Megan's I was protecting. Just wanted to not do anything dumb. Overall, I felt good. First inning felt good. Just got tired."

2024
Did not pitch professionally ... on Kansas City's 60-day injured list from February 17 to November 1.

2023
Opened the season on Atlanta's Injured List with right shoulder inflammation ... after one rehab outing, struggled to a 5.79 ERA (12 ER in 18.2 IP) over 5 starts from April 11 to May 3 ... went back to the IL on May 4 to heal the same shoulder, stayed there through September 10 ... made 3 rehab starts, but finished the year on the Braves' 60-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain.

2022
Spent the entire year in the Majors with Atlanta with a 21-5 record and a 3.19 ERA (64 ER in 180.1 IP), to go along with 174 strikeouts ... led the Majors with 21 wins ... finished 10th in National League Cy Young Award voting.
19 of 30 starts were quality starts ... made 4 straight quality starts from May 26 to June 12 and again July 9 to 29 ... every start from July 9 to August 31 was at least 6.0 innings.

Ended the season on an 8-game winning streak, posting a 3.14 ERA (18 ER in 51.2 IP) over 9 starts, August 10 to October 1 ... 8 runs of the runs he allowed in the streak came in a no-decision effort on September 6 at Oakland.

2021
Only made 2 starts for Atlanta in the big leagues, one on April 15 at Chicago (NL) and one on June 23 at New York (NL) ... totaled just 6.1 MLB innings, allowed 7 earned runs (9.95 ERA).

His only MLB playoff appearances came out of the bullpen in Games 2 and 4 of the World Series against the Astros ... allowed 1 run over 4.2 innings of relief behind opener Dylan Lee, who allowed 3 of 4 batters to reach.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

After being drafted by Atlanta in the 1st round, began his professional career in 2017 with the GCL Braves (R) ... after 3 outings, joined the Florida Fire Frogs (A+) at the start of August and ended his year in High-A.

Opened the 2018 season with the Mississippi Braves (AA) and ended the year in the Major Leagues for his MLB debut ... over 27 games in the Minors (24 starts) between Mississippi and the Gwinnett Strippers (AAA).

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
