INDIANAPOLIS, IND. – The Omaha Storm Chasers tied this week's series up with a big win against the Indianapolis Indians, 8-2 on Wednesday at Victory Field.  
The Chasers flipped the script in game two of the series and scored in the first four innings ... **John Rave** led the game off with a single, then **CJ Alexander** singled to center field and the pair scored as **Devin Mann** ripped a double to plate the first two runs of the game ... **Nick Pratto** then doubled in Mann for a 3-0 Omaha lead.  
In the top of the 2nd inning, **Drew Waters** plated **Austin Nola** on a sacrifice fly and Rave scored on an RBI single from Alexander for a 5-0 Chasers lead.  
Omaha continued its damage in a third straight inning and extended the score to 7-0 in the top of the 3rd inning as **Cam Devanney** crushed his seventh homer of the season, a two-run shot that plated Pratto ... on his third hit of the night, Rave hit a solo homer to right field to opened the 4th inning and extend Omaha's lead to 8-0. Major league rehabber **Kris Bubic** started for Omaha and retired the first eight batters he faced and struck out 6, including a stretch of 4 in a row, before allowing his first baserunners of the night ... the Indians threatened in the bottom of the 3rd inning with a two-out walk and hit, but a flyout retired the side and stranded the runners on base ... Bubic retired his first two batters of the 4th before being removed, with 7 strikeouts over 3.2 scoreless innings, with just the 1 walk and hit.  
Lefty **Austin Cox** replaced Bubic and recorded the final out of the 4th inning, then erased a leadoff walk in the 5th inning with a double play ... Indy got on the board in the bottom of the 6th inning with a solo home run, double and RBI single as the Indians trimmed the Omaha lead to 8-2 through 6.0 innings ... Cox pitched a total of 2.1 innings, striking out one and allowing the two runs on three hits.  
After a double play got Cox the final two outs of the 6th inning, he and three more Omaha relievers combined to retire the final 10 Indians batters of the game ... **John McMillon** earned his second straight win with a 1-2-3 7th inning, before **Evan Sisk** worked a perfect 8th inning with two strikeouts, then **Will Klein** offered a 1-2-3 bottom of the 9th inning to close out the game.  
Omaha's pitching staff combined to strike out 12 in the win over Indianapolis, the 23rd time this season the staff combined to strike out 10+ batters in a game.  
After scoring in the first four innings, the Storm Chasers offense came to a halt for the rest of the game as they mustered just two hits off of Indy relievers, while drawing four walks over the last five innings of the game.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League and the team is 17 games over .500 at 34-16 (.680).  
34 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season ... of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .680 winning percentage is the 3rd-best, just behind the MiLB-Best Modesto Nuts (30-14 / .682 / Mariners Single-A).  
20 wins in the month of May is the most of any team Minor League Baseball.

#### IT'S GONNA BE MAY

The month of May the Storm Chasers have produced this year is arguably one of the greatest single months in the modern era of the club.  
With the team's 20th win of the month last night, May 2024 marks the 4th time since 2005 the Triple-A Omaha franchise has won 20+ games in a month, the first time since June 2012 ... since 2005, the most games the team has won in a month is 21, when the August 2005 Omaha Royals went 21-9.  
A .769 winning percentage this month is the best the team has won in a month since 2005 (min. 20 games), the 4th time with a winning % above .700 in a month.  
The .213 opponents' average against Omaha in May 2024 is the best in a single month since 2005 (min. 20 games played), while a 24.69% strikeout rate is 4th-best.  
Offensively, the .479 slugging percentage the team has posted this month ranks as the 5th-best in a month and a rate of 6.3 runs/game rank is tied for the 4th-best.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 5 straight series and 20 of its last 25 games ... 17 of those 25 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 14 of the team's 20 wins in this stretch.  
Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, but 12 of 20 wins this month have had a save awarded (from 6 pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors in May ... **Will Klein** has 5 saves in that span, while **Walter Pennington** has 2.  
In total, 34 of Omaha's 50 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (68%), including 12 of 16 losses this season.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 304 to 236 this season, a +68 run differential.  
A +68 run differential ranks as not just best in the International League, but the top mark at the Triple-A level and 5th in Minor League Baseball ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +104 (302 to 198).

#### YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.  
When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 17-3 record, compared to 16-14 when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.  
When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 23-4, while the team is just 11-13 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starter.

### TODAY'S START

- Champlain is making his **9th start** of the season and his **2nd start with Omaha** ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Champlain made 7 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha last Monday, May 20.
- Ranks 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in 2024 in strikeouts (53), is 2nd among qualifiers in WHIP (0.93), tie 2nd in opponents' batting average (.203) and 3rd in ERA (3.64), while tied 7th in innings pitched (42.0 IP).
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the **No. 11 Royals prospect** ... Ranked by Baseball America as the **No. 8 Royals prospect**.

### LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, MAY 23 VS. COLUMBUS

Made his Triple-A debut and threw his third consecutive quality start, going back to his final two in Double-A ... allowed 3 straight hits to open the top of the 1st inning: a leadoff single, 2-run homer and another single ... faced 2 over the minimum the rest of the way, got a double play to work out of the 1st and threw 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd, 5th and 6th ... 2-out walk was caught stealing to end the 3rd, walk and single scored a run in the 4th ... retired his final 7 batters of the game after the 4th inning single.

### 2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 1-0 with a 9.00 ERA (2 ER in 2.0 IP).
- Struggled in his season debut on April 7 vs. Tulsa, tied a career-high with 8 runs allowed in just 2.2 innings, but threw at least 5.0 innings and did not allow more than two runs in each of his final 6 Double-A starts, including three quality starts.
- At the time of his promotion to Triple-A, ranked 4th in the Double-A Texas League in strikeouts (48) and 2nd among qualifiers in WHIP (0.92) ... ranked 2nd on the Naturals staff in ERA (3.50), opponents' average (.203) and strikeouts (48).
- Worked career-best 12.1-inning scoreless streak that spanned his last two starts in Double-A, May 9 vs. Springfield and May 15 @ Arkansas, a stretch where he allowed 6 hits and 1 walk while striking out 17.

- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), combined to go 11-8 with a 3.33 ERA (50 ER in 135.1 IP) and 125 strikeouts over 25 starts.
- Totaled 13 quality starts of his 25 starts across two teams in 2023, the most of any Royals Minor League pitcher and tied for the 3rd-most among all Minor League pitchers ... the closest in the organization was **Brady Singer's** 9 quality starts in the big leagues.
- Opened the year in High-A and made 6 quality starts of his 11 with the River Bandits, including 7.0 shutout innings on June 16 at Beloit (MIA), his final outing before being promoted to Double-A on June 20.
- Fired a pair of scoreless starts with NWA, including 6.0 hitless innings on July 27 at Arkansas (SEA) ... combined no-hit-effort continued into the 9th before a leadoff single ended the bid ... recognized as the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for this start.
- Produced an 11.0-inning scoreless streak between July 21 and 27, spanning two starts ... were his second and third of 6 straight starts of 6.0 innings or more.
- Threw a season-high 8.0 innings with 8 strikeouts on August 2 at Springfield (STL), holding the Cardinals to 2 runs on 98 pitches.
