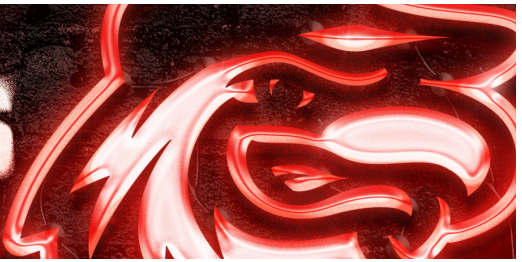

PLATE(S) DISCIPLINE: Playing as the Plates for the first time in 2026, Rochester came out on top against the Scranton/WB RailRiders, 3-1...LHP **ANDREW ALVAREZ** led the way for Rochester, striking out 10 while scattering just one hit across 5.0 strong innings of work...offensively, LF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** notched two more hits, giving him at least one knock in each of the first five games...Rochester and Scranton/WB will play a scheduled seven-inning doubleheader today, making up Tuesday's postponed Red Wings home opener...LHP **MITCHELL PARKER** will take the ball in game one against New York Yankees top pitching prospect RHP Carlos Lagrange, and LHP **ZACH PENROD** gets the nod in the back half of the twin bill against RailRiders RHP Adam Kloffenstein...

The Red Wings have now started the season 4-1 for the first time since the 2022 season.

THE YO-HANDY MAN CAN: 3B **YOHANDY MORALES** went 1-for-3 with an RBI in the contest last night, extending his RBI streak to all five games to start the season...he joins Reece Hinds (LOU, 6 G) as the only players in Triple-A to have an RBI in at least five-straight games to start the season and the first Red Wing to do so since at least 2004...

Since his Triple-A debut on 5/24/2025, YoYo ranks among Rochester team leaders in hits (1st, 98), walks (1st, 48), runs (1st, 67), doubles (2nd, 21), RBI (3rd, 54), XBH (3rd, 35), and homers (4th, 12).

MERRY CHRIST(IAN)-MAS: LF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** went 2-for-3 with a walk and a run scored last night, extending his team-leading hitting streak to all five games...across those five games the Kansas native is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with a double, five runs scored, and a pair of stolen bases...

Dating back to the beginning of 2025, Franklin ranks second in the International League with 83 walks, one behind former Iowa teammate Jonathon Long.

ABIMELECTRIC LOVE: DH **ABIMELEC ORTIZ** extended walk streak to five consecutive games last night, tied for the longest active streak in the IL and putting his total at seven on the year, tying him for third in the IL...his single in last night's game was the hardest hit baseball by a Red Wing so far this season, coming off the bat at 111.7 MPH... and ninth in the league with an OBP of .545...

The first Red Wing to work a walk in five consecutive games since **ANDRES CHAPARRO** had an eight-game streak from 07/23-08/1/2025.

IF THE SHU FITS: RHP **SETH SHUMAN** entered out of the bullpen in the ninth inning last night, and logged the first save of his professional career, in what was his 100th career appearance...the Georgia native allowed one earned on one hit with a strikeout and two walks, and is the third Red Wing to log a save in 2026, joining RHP **JACKSON RUTLEDGE** and RHP **ORLANDO RIBALTA**.

PIECE DE ALVA-REZ-ISTANCE: LHP **ANDREW ALVAREZ** struck out 10 with just one hit in 5.0 innings in Thursday night's contest...the left-hander became one of four Rochester pitchers since at least 2004 to strike out at least 10 in 5.0 innings or fewer, the first since Michael Soroka on 5/2/2025 against LHV, and the only pitcher to do so twice (9/22/24 vs. IDW)...he's the first IL pitcher to strike out double-digit batters and allow one hit in 5.0 innings or fewer since Allan Winans did so with SWB on 4/23/2025, and first Red Wing to do so since at least 2004.

PITCH PERFECT: The Plates' pitching staff limited the RailRiders to two hits last night for the fourth time since at least 2004, the fewest allowed in a game against the New York Yankees' top affiliate since 7/13/2018...with the win, it is the first time the Red Wings have knocked off Scranton/WB in their first two matchups of the season since 2022.

THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...2008: On this day 18 years ago, the Rochester Red Wings opened their 2008 season with a 9-5 win at Richmond...Red Wings Hall-of-Famer **GARRETT JONES** picked up three hits including a double, drove in two runs and scored three of his own...speedy CF **DENARD SPAN** picked up a pair of hits out of the leadoff spot, going 2-for-5 with a run scored.

Entering sixth season in professional baseball, all in the Nationals organization after being selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft...Named a MiLB Organization All-Star in 2021 and 2022, and earned Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on 5/30 and 6/13 of 2021 with Single-A Fredericksburg.

- Slated to make his second start of 2026 in game one on 4/3.
- Played the entire 2025 season with Washington, appearing in 33 games (30 GS)...posted an ERA of 5.68 (104 ER/164.2 IP) with 103 strikeouts, 58 walks, and one save...tied Jake Irvin for most wins among Nationals pitchers.
- Recorded the longest save in Nationals history (3.2 IP) which was also his first career save, preserving a one-run lead to defeat New York-NL in his first career relief appearance on Sept. 21.
- Went 1-0 with a save and a 1.42 ERA (1 ER/6.1 IP) in his three relief appearances.
- Opened the season by going 3-1 with a 1.39 ERA (5 ER/32.1 IP) and 20 strikeouts in his first five starts.
- Threw a career-high 8.0 innings on 4/22 against Baltimore...struck out four while allowing just one hit and two walks, earning the win.
- Struck out MLB career-high eight batters on 6/18 against Colorado...went 6.0 innings with one earned, no walks, and six hits allowed.
- 2025 pitch mix; 4-Seam FB - 92.9 MPH, 55% usage; Splitter - 85.4 MPH, 11% usage; Slider - 85.0 MPH, 12% usage; Curve - 81.1 MPH, 22% usage.

Entering his 14th professional season, second with the Nationals organization after he was claimed off waivers from Los Angeles-NL on 8/17/2025...originally signed with Colorado as an international free agent on 7/2/2012...named a Mexican League Mid-Season All-Star in 2024 with El Aguila de Veracruz...earned Northwest League Mid-Season All-Star honors in 2016 with Boise (COL).

- Made 35 appearances (4 starts) with Triple-A Oklahoma City (LAD) in 2025, logging a 3-0 record with a 3.05 ERA (14 ER/41.1 IP) with 49 strikeouts and 15 walks, while holding opponents to a .240 batting average...appeared in one game with Los Angeles-NL on 7/7 at MIL, after having his contract selected earlier that day...optioned to OKC on 7/8, and designated for assignment on 8/15...claimed by Washington on 8/17 and assigned to Triple-A Rochester.
- Across final 14 appearances (2 GS) with Oklahoma City since 6/27, allowed one earned run across 15.1 innings (0.59 ERA) with 22 strikeouts and five walks, with a 0.72 WHIP...over that stretch, ranked second in the Pacific Coast League (min 10.0 IP) in ERA and BAA (.118), third in WHIP, and is tied for the sixth-fewest hits allowed (6).
- Made his Red Wing debut on 8/20 against Toledo...collected his 300th minor league strikeout on 8/27 at Jacksonville...struck out the side against BUF on 9/11, collecting his 150th Triple-A strikeout.
- Has appeared in 10 MLB games since his debut with Colorado in 2021 (9/5 vs. ATL).

Entering his 14th season of professional baseball and his fourth with the Nationals organization across two stints...signed with Washington as a Minor League free agent on 1/20/2026...originally drafted by San Diego in the sixth round of the 2013 MLB draft...named a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star with Double-A Arkansas (LAA) in 2015...named a California League Mid-Season All-Star in 2014 with High-A Lake Elsinore (SD).

- Spent the 2025 season primarily with Triple-A Tacoma (SEA, 22 G), with a brief stint with Arizona Complex League Mariners (2 G, rehab assignment)...logged a 7.40 ERA (17 ER/20.2 IP), 19 strikeouts, and eight walks across both levels.
- Placed on the 7-day Injured List on 3/28...sent on a rehab assignment to ACL Mariners on 5/3...activated on 5/10.
- Did not play in 2024 due to injury (Tommy John surgery).
- Appeared in 30 games with Seattle in 2023, posting a 4.03 ERA (13 ER/29.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and eight walks.

- Notched 400th MiLB career strikeout on 3/29/2026 at Jacksonville, going 4.0 innings out of the bullpen and striking out four.
- Opened the 2025 season with Rochester...started four games before being put on the 7-day Injured List on 4/21.
- Sent on rehab assignment to High-A Wilmington on 6/8, posting an ERA of 0.79 (1 ER/11.1 IP), with 10 strikeouts and four walks.
- Activated and assigned to Double-A Harrisburg to continue his rehab assignment on 6/23...recalled by Washington on 7/2 as the 27th man in a doubleheader against Detroit, and made his MLB debut in game one with 3.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts.
- Optioned back to Harrisburg on 7/3, and recalled back to Washington on 7/13...optioned to Triple-A Rochester on 8/6 for the remainder of the season.
