✖ **YAKS MAKE HISTORY:** In just five games this week, Salem has scored 59 runs, setting a new franchise record for the most runs scored in a single six-game series since the format began in 2021. The previous record was 56 runs, set from June 29-July 4, 2021, at Fredericksburg. The Yaks' 59 runs also mark just the sixth time in franchise history that Salem has scored 50+ runs in a six-game series:

✖ **BEST OF THE BEST:** After the 15 run offensive explosion last night, the Yaks have now scored the second most runs by any club in the Carolina League this season. Salem has scored 663 runs and only trail the Fredericksburg Nationals (700) in total runs scored. Better yet since June 18 the Yaks have led the league with runs scored over that stretch scoring 335 runs over their last 53 games

✖ **RUN PARTY AGAINST WILSON:** Across the 23 meetings between Salem and Wilson this season, the Yaks have scored 162 (average 7.04 runs/game) runs while 12 of the 23 meetings the winning team has scored 10+ runs. The 162 runs are the most runs any team has scored against the Warbirds this season:

✖ **SALEM'S FIRE WEEEEK:** So far just five games into this series, the RidgeYaks have outscored the Warbirds 59-31. The 59 runs this week leads all of Single-A as does Salem's .352 batting average this week and their 63 hits. The Yaks are also hitting 28-for-68 (.285) with runners in scoring position this week

✖ **PRIMERA IN AUGUST:** Since the calendar flipped to August, **Franklin Primera** has been posting video game numbers. The catcher is leading the Carolina League with a .429 batting average (24-for-56) across 16 games in August with a league leading 1.293 OPS and hits in 21 of his last 25 games dating back to July 17. Over that same stretch since July 17, Primera leads the League in batting average (.420), hits (37), and ranks second with total bases (60) and OPS (1.235)

✖ **HOMERING YAKS:** Salem has belted 99 home runs through its first 116 games this season, the second-most in a single season since 2005, the start of the modern era. The Yaks have 14 games remaining and need five more home runs to break the modern-era record of 103, set in 2021

✖ **LIGHTS OUT WUILLIAMS:** RHP **Wuilliams Rodriguez** has been a staple out of the Yaks bullpen. Over his last seven outings since July 18, Rodriguez has thrown 12.2 innings allowing just 11 hits and two earned runs pitching to an impressive 1.43 ERA over his last seven

✖ **BIG STREAKS:** **Andrews Opat** has hit safely in nine straight games dating back to August 8, batting .407 over that span. With a hit in one more game, Opat would tie Starlyn Nunez (May 8-20) and Franklin Primera (July 29-August 12) for the longest hitting streak by a Yak this season. Additionally, **Louis Andujar** has reached base in 18 straight games dating back to July 22 and needs one more game to tie Primera's 19-game streak from July 11-August 12

✖ **RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY:** Last night's one-hour, 48-minute rain delay was Salem's longest rain delay of the season. It was also the first time since August 24, 2025 against Carolina that Salem saw a rain delay in the middle of a game and returned to finish the contest later that same night

Salem has scored 59 runs this week, setting a new franchise high for a six-game series. Since six-game series became the norm in 2021, Salem had never scored more than 56 runs in a week before this week

✦ **YAKS AT HOME:** In the month of August, Salem has won seven of their ten home games while outscoring opponents 98-53 in those games. Salem took four out of five meetings against Fayetteville and have now won two of four against Wilson

✦ **HOME RUNS AT HOME:** Salem has hit 45 home runs at Carilion Clinic Field this season, the second-most in a single season in ballpark history. The Salem record is 46 home runs at home, set in 2022. With one more home run, the 2026 RidgeYaks will tie the record, while two more will give them the most home runs at home in a single season in franchise history

✦ **SECOND-HALF SURGES:** Since the start of the second half on June 19, The Yaks have three of the top seven hitters in the Carolina League. **Kleyver Salazar** leads the league with his .350 average over his 38 second-half games. Over his 35 games in the second half, **Franklin Primera** is third in the league with a .344 batting average. **Louis Andujar** also ranks seventh with a .312 second-half average across his 37 games

✦ **41 GAME SUCCESS:** Salem has won 23 of its last 41 games dating back to July 2. Over that span, the RidgeYaks lead all of Single-A with a .285 batting average. The Yaks also lead the Carolina League and rank third in Single-A with 286 runs and 394 hits over their last 41 games

✦ **THE STRIKEOUT STAFF:** After 117 games this season, Salem pitchers have combined to strike out 1141 batters, for the most in the Carolina League. After last night's 12 punchout game the Yaks leapfrogged over Hill City (1140) For the top stop. Salem is averaging 9.75 strikeouts per game

✦ **BIG INNINGS:** Two of Salem's three biggest innings this season have come this week against the Warbirds. Thursday night Salem tacked on eight runs in the seventh inning as well as a seven spot in the third inning on Tuesday

✦ **ANDUJAR BREAKS THROUGH:** After recording just one RBI and batting .095 through his first 20 games in Single-A, **Louis Andujar** has flipped it into gear as of late. Over his last 33 games since June 27, Andujar is fourth in the Carolina League with a .331 average (42-for-127) with 26 RBI, seven homers, and a 1.021 OPS. Andujar has recorded a hit in 25 of his last 33 games after collecting hits in just five of his first 20 games

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

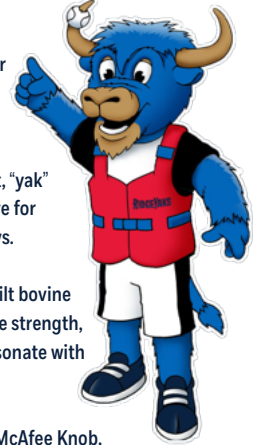
The name "RidgeYaks" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Opened last season in Phoenix with the Arizona Complex League Giants, pitching in eight games and posting a 1-0 record with a 2.00 ERA across 18.0 innings prior to last June's Rafael Devers blockbuster trade
- Acquired by Boston from the Giants along with Kyle Harrison, Jordan Hicks, and James Tibbs III in exchange for Rafael Devers on June 15, 2025
- After joining the Red Sox organization, appeared in five games (one start) with the Florida Complex League club, going 2-0 with 16 strikeouts over 14.1 innings
- Earned a promotion to Single-A Salem in late July last season
- Has watched the ERA drop each of his three seasons of pro ball, pitched to a 3.55 ERA in 2023 across 33 innings, a 2.93 ERA last year between the DSL and FCL and at the time of his promotion a 2.51 ERA across 13 games in the ACL and FCL
- June 15 marked the one-year anniversary of the blockbuster trade that sent Rafael Devers from Boston to San Francisco. In return, the Red Sox acquired LHP Kyle Harrison, RHP Jordan Hicks, **RHP Jose Bello**, and OF James Tibbs III. One year later, all five players have taken very different paths:

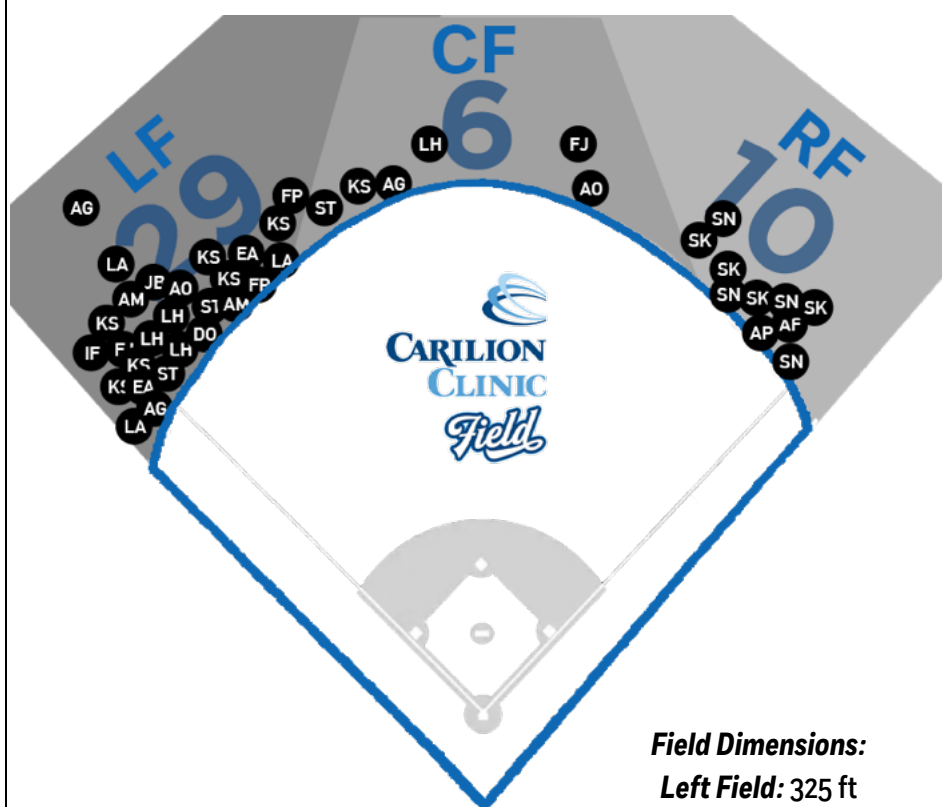

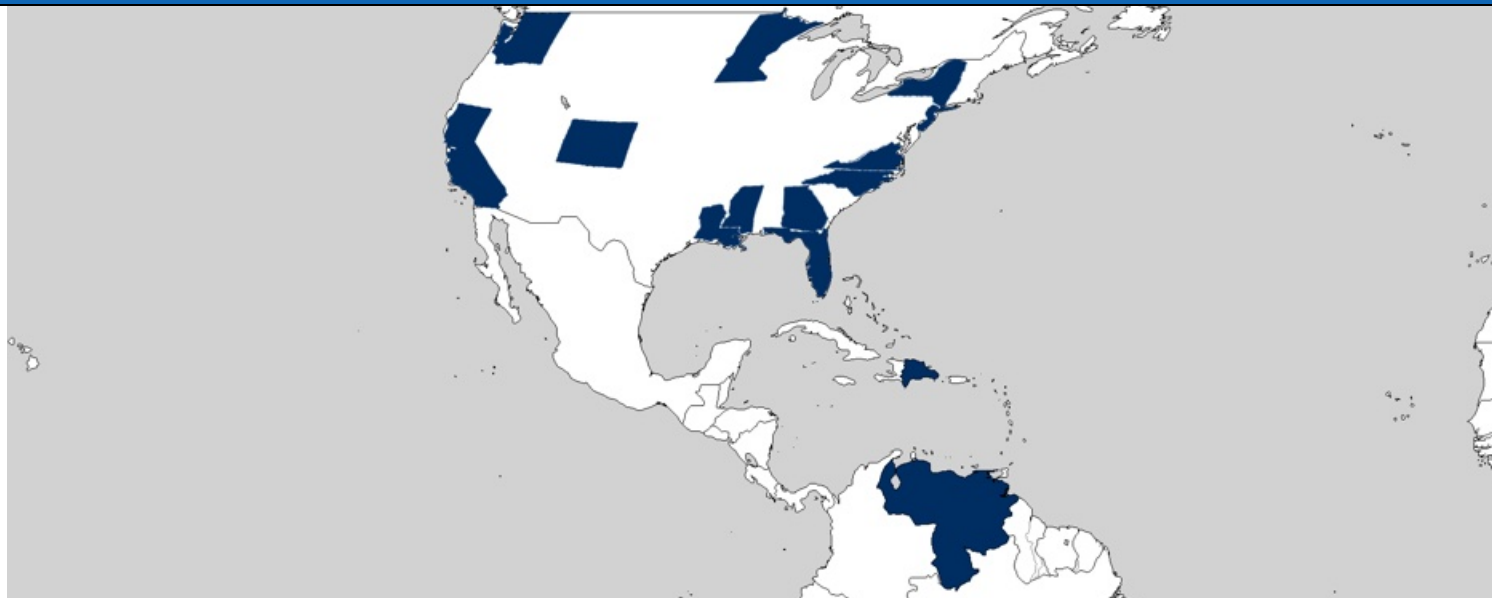
