Happy Sunday

Today, the Reading Fightin Phils finish a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the sixth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with the Patriots holding the 3-2 edge. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

Saturday Night Dub

Last night, the Fightin Phils were vicorius in a 6-5 defeat of the Somerset Patriots. Reading fell behind early, but re-took the lead thanks to a tworun home run from Madison Stokes, his first of the season. Reading added three more in the fifth and one in the sixth. Nick Podkul stayed red-hot with a two-run triple in the big fifth inning. The bullpen combined for five shutout innings in the victory.

Shutout Streak

Through 37 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-three teams in double-A and one-of-15 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. The other Eastern League team to not be shutout was Altoona, but the Curve were no hit at Bowie Friday night. The R-Phils have also not thrown a shutout as a pitching staff yet in 2023.

Gettin' On Base

A couple of R-Phils hitters own on-base streaks north of ten right now. Oliver Dunn has reached base in his last 14 games, dating back to May 3, while Nick Podkul has reached in his last 10, which dates back to April 20. Logan O'Hoppe owned a 21-game on base streak in 2022.

Bullpen Dominance

Reading's bullpen has a dominant outing last night at Somerset. Matt Seelinger, Braden Zarbnisky, Max Kuhns and Taylor Lehman combined to throw five shuout innings, with only one-hit allowed. It also featured three-straight strikeouts from Kuhns with runners on second and third, with no outs. Reading's bullpen, and pitching as a whole, has been much better following losses, than wins. After a loss, Reading has a 4.75 ERA and 10-13 record, while the R-Phils own a 6.28 ERA and 3-9 record in games following a win.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies had a dominant 12-3 victory over the Cubs yesterday to even this weekend's series. They finish the series today at 1:35 p.m. Both Lehigh Valley and Jersey Shore were postponned last night at Worcester and vs Wilmington respectively. Clearwater snapped its homewin streak with a 3-1 loss to Bradenton, but still own a Florida State League best record of 28-10.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 21, 2017: At Reading, Scott Kingery exhibits a phenomenal blend of speed and power, hitting 2 homers to go with a bunt single, an infield single and 4 runs scored in an 8-7 loss to New Hampshire. The 2-HR game is his second in 3 days.

'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 23-14 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

The Patriot Pitcher

Righty Blane Abeyta gets the start for Somerset this afternoon. He is 2-1 with a 6.33 ERA over six starts this season. Abeyta has 23 strikeouts and 20 walks over 27 innings. At Portland last Sunday, he went six innings, allowing three runs on seven hits, with a walk and 10 strikeouts. Abeyta spent all of 2022 in high-A Hudson Valley, going 5-8 with a 4.47 ERA over 23 games and 20 starts.
