Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series at the first half East Division champion Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Lugnuts won the opener, but the Dragons have won each of the last three nights to overtake the season series, 7-6.

Last Night: Dragons 6, Lugnuts 3. Ryan McCrystal broke a 3-3 tie in the 7th inning with a two-run double, Jacob Friend followed with an RBI double, and the Dragons doubled up the Nuts in front of 7,736 at Day Air Ballpark. Nate Nankil went 3-for-5 in the losing cause for Lansing.

Starting Spotlight: Texas A&M Aggie Nathan Dettmer makes his ninth start for Lansing after opening the season with Class-A Stockton; Dettmer faced the Dragons twice in 2025, including a notable six-inning, one-hit gem in Dayton on June 8 (the one hit was an Ariel Almonte home run). JeanPierre "J.P." Ortiz takes on the Lugnuts for a second time; Ortiz picked up the win in Game 1 of a doubleheader on April 29, allowing two runs in five innings at Lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts wrap things up with the Dragons tomorrow, and then continue their two-week Ohio road trip to Lake County. The next home game: 15 days away.

Retrospective:

- The last time that the Lugnuts played the Dragons on July 4 was 2021, a wild game in Lansing that saw the Dragons score three runs in the 9th to overcome a 7-5 deficit. The Nuts responded with a run in the bottom of the 9th to force extra innings, only to see the Dragons score four in the 8th for a 12-8 win. Dayton finished with 17 hits while the Lugnuts committed four errors. The game took four hours and 31 minutes to play in front of 10,109.
- On July 4, 2016, Jordan Romano tossed four scoreless innings and the Nuts routed the Dragons 12-5 in front of 10,639.
- The last time that the Nuts played in the Gem City on July 4, it was 2005. The Dragons scored four runs in the 2nd inning and led 7-4 after the 4th inning, but the Lugnuts scored four unanswered runs between the 5th and 7th innings for an 8-7 win in front of 9,010.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Zane Taylor), No. 22 (Nate Nankil) and No. 29 (Nathan Dettmer). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and Nathan Dettmer at No. 21.

Hello, Philadelphia! 2025 Lugnuts shortstop Leo De Vries was named to the American League All-Star Futures Game roster alongside fellow Athletics prospect / Midland RockHounds southpaw Jamie Arnold. The game will be held Sunday, July 12, at Citizens Bank Park. De Vries competed in the Futures Game last year, too, when he was in the Padres' organization... and struck out against Lugnuts alum Gage Jump.

Welcome to High-A: Following Midwest League debuts on Tuesday (Logan Sauve), Wednesday (Bryan Arendt) and Thursday (Jake Reinisch), Ben Hansen tossed a hitless, scoreless fifth inning last night to become the 1,005th all-time Lugnut. Hansen was acquired via trade Wednesday morning from the Red Sox for 2021-22 Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris.

Roll Call: With Hansen joining the team, the Lugnuts have now utilized 21 position players and 24 different pitchers this season (plus position player Gunner Gouldsmith, who tossed a scoreless inning on May 8 at South Bend).

- In his last six games, OF Nate Nankil is 10-for-25, .400/.483/.720 with two doubles, two home runs and four walks.
- SS Ali Camarillo is 9-for-17 with four walks in this series (.529 avg., .619 OBP) and has 2+ hits in five of his last six games.

JULY 4 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: In front of 10,639, J.C. Cardenas's three-run homer capped a five-run bottom of the sixth and the Lugnuts roared back from a 3-2 deficit to a 12-5 rout of the Dayton Dragons. The Lugnuts improved to 7-0 against Dayton in the season series, on their way to winning the first eight meetings before the Dragons snapped the spell.

2019: 9,798 celebrate the 4th of July with the Lugnuts – who lost 8-1 to Great Lakes at Cooley Law School Stadium. Gabriel Moreno's homer supplied the Nuts' only run. The game included a 58-minute rain delay in the middle of the third inning, which caused the City of Lansing's fireworks show to occur over the right-field wall throughout the eighth inning and into the top of the ninth.
